

COMPLAINT

CASE NUMBER: **13GG0157**

The CHRB hereby files a complaint against **Saul R. Acosta** for violation of CHRB Rule **1653, 1843(a)&(d), 1843.1(a), 1844(c)(1), 1844(c)(7), 1887(a)**. The person named in this complaint holds a license as a **Owner**, license number **289746 Exp. 6/2015**. The offense alleged occurred on or about **October 12th, 2013** and is as follows:

On October 12th, 2013 Trainer Elmer G. January started the horse "Knight Ought" who finished 5th in the 3rd race at the Fresno County Fair in Fresno, CA. The official blood sample #F10962 contained Phenylbutazone (2.5 ug/ml). The official urine sample #F10962 contained 555 ng/ml of Procaine. Mr. Elmer G. January chose not to take a split sample. (Mr. January's Investigative Case Numer is 13GG0144.)

During the course of the investigation, it was determined that the owner of the horse, Saul R. Acosta, had allowed the horse to be used in a match race and that he was the person who had administered the Phenylbutazone while at the fair.

Pursuant to Business and Professions Code Section 19420, 19440, and CHRB Rules, the stewards are empowered to impose penalties for violation of any provision of the CHRB Rules. Such penalties may consist of suspension of any license, fines, and exclusion from all racing enclosures under the jurisdiction of the Board or by any combination of these penalties.
