**6<sup>TH</sup> RACE – STEWARDS REVIEW**

The Stewards reviewed the start concerning #4 FULL OF PEPPER (Kevin Orozco). Video replays were shown for the public’s benefit. Replays clearly show that #4 FULL OF PEPPER stumbles the second jump out of the gate almost unseating Mr. Orozco. No other horses were involved so there was no reason for an Inquiry.

**OROZCO RULING (Ref. (7/3/20<sup>6</sup>))**

**RULING #14**

Jockey **IRVING D, OROZCO** is hereby suspended thirty (30) days July 12, 2020 through August 10, 2020 inclusive and placed on probation for the term of his license (December 31, 2022) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1900 (Grounds for Suspension or Revocation) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1489 (A)(8)(Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License – use of marijuana).

Further, pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1485 (Licenses Subject to Conditions and Agreements) as long as **IRVING D. OROZCO** (hereinafter Orozco) is licensed by the California Horse Racing Board the following conditions will apply to any license he may hold for as long as he holds it:

- 1) Abide by the terms of a Testing Agreement with the California Horse Racing Board.
- 2) A positive test sample will result in immediate suspension of Orozco’s license privileges pending a hearing before the Board of Stewards.
- 3) Orozco must sign and agree to the terms of a contract with the Winners Foundation through December 31, 2022.
- 4) Orozco must report to the California Horse Racing Board Investigators’ office everyday he rides and provide a test sample if requested to do so.

During the term of this suspension all licenses and license privileges of **IRVING D. OROZCO** are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine) subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The above ruling was issued after deliberations over last week’s hearing. Mr. Orozco had tested positive for marijuana on June 11, 2020. The Stewards heard from the Winners Foundation representative Darin Scharer that Mr. Orozco was attending outpatient programs. The Stewards felt a suspension was warranted based on Mr. Orozco’s license history, which also called for strict conditions in the ruling.

The Stewards reviewed the start of the sixth race for the public's benefit. #3 HAPPY ROAD (Kyle Frey) got sandwiched between the #4 MOON OVER MAG BAY (Brayan Pena) who broke in and #2 CONNIE'S PROMISE (William Antongeorgi III) who broke out. #3 HAPPY ROAD ended up beating both of those rivals so there was no reason for an Inquiry. Jockeys Pena and Antongeorgi will review the films with the Stewards in the morning.
