#### **PRE-MEET**

Steward Grant Baker attended to pre-meet duties today at the Alameda County Fair in Pleasanton. The judge's stand, steward's office and racing office were visited. A new large (42") flat screen television monitor is now attached to a wall in the steward's office and has been mounted for better film review with jockeys, trainers and owners.

Many other front side improvements were noted during the day. The lower-level trackside apron has been entirely resurfaced. The winner's circle enclosure has been enlarged and beautified. The director's room, on the way to the judge's stand, has been enlarged in addition to new furniture, carpeting, artwork and resurfaced/remodeled food and beverage areas. In order for this enlargement to take place the Pleasanton press box has been removed. The timer operator, Equibase personnel and newspaper reporters will now work from an open air restricted area in the grandstand.

#### **ENTRY DAY**

The racing office was open today accepting entries for opening day which is Thursday, June 19<sup>th</sup>. The Oak Tree Racing Association is conducting this meet at the Alameda County Fair

Also stopping by was Pleasanton Mutuel Manager Bryan Wayte. He brought the stewards up to speed on the new twenty-cent (\$0.20) Gold Strike Super High 5 wager that will be implemented for the last race every day at this year's Oak Tree at Pleasanton meet.

#### **C. GREGORY BRENT RETIRES**

Greg Brent, considered by many to be one of the finest racing official's in Northern California history, retired last Sunday, June 15<sup>th</sup>. Brent, 65, was honored in a winner's circle ceremony last Friday, June 13<sup>th</sup> at Golden Gate Fields.

Brent grew up in Southern California and attended UCLA, later moving north to Alameda County and eventually graduating from the University of California. His forty-one (41) year career in horse racing began when he sold newspapers outside of Golden Gate Fields. Shortly thereafter he became a clerk in the racing office working for many racing secretaries such as Lou Elkin, Harry Krovitz, Gene Barsotti, Robert Umphrey and Daniel Eidson. He worked his way up the ladder working various racing official positions before becoming an Assistant Racing Secretary and Racing Secretary at Bay Meadows and Golden Gate Fields. He was also Director of Racing at several Northern California Fairs. We wish him a happy and healthy retirement. He will be missed.

06-19-14<sup>4</sup>

#### **MORNING ACCIDENT**

Assistant Starter Tony Garcia was involved in an incident at the starting gate during morning training hours today. Garcia was kicked hard and was reported to have broken some ribs while attempting to school a horse. It was reported that Garcia will spend the night at a local hospital for observation.

06-19-14<sup>5</sup> **TIMER PROBLEMS**

There were no electronic times for today's first (350 yards) and second (300 yards) races. Larry Swartzlander (Director of Racing, Oak Tree at Pleasanton) was notified and said he would address the issue as soon as possible.

06-19-14<sup>6</sup> **CLAIM VOIDED**

In the fourth race Trainer Andy Mathis won a three way shake when he claimed #4 DREAM OF DAISY from Trainer Cliff Delima for \$10,000. However, CHRB Veterinarian Don Dooley informed the stewards following the race that this horse was unsound. Claim voided.

06-19-14<sup>7</sup> **BAZE OFF MOUNTS**

Jockey Russell Baze was excused from his last three (3) mounts of the afternoon following a phone call from track physician Dr. Nazarino. Baze twisted his knee after getting unseated in the paddock prior to the fifth race. Accident report attached.

06-19-14<sup>8</sup> **RACE #2 – STEWARD'S INQUIRY**

The stewards posted the Inquiry sign following the running of this three hundred (300 yard) Quarter Horse race. The incident involved sixth place finisher #8 HIGH AND SPECIAL (Martin Arriaga) and seventh place finisher #7 CHIHUAHUA GOLD (Carlos Villalobos). These horses made contact at the midway point of this race. The stewards felt the actions of both horses played into the incident and there was no reason to change the original placing. Unanimous decision. No change.

**Friday**06-20-14<sup>1</sup> **ROCCO INCHAURREQUI VS. GEORGE ANTHROP**

Rocco Inchaurrequi came to the steward's office today accompanied by Terrance Merriam and Shirley Powell. Inchaurrequi was told be here for a 10:00 a.m. hearing by CHRB enforcement. This matter involves a financial complaint that Inchaurrequi had filed against Standardbred trainer George Anthrop last spring at the Cal Expo harness (WatchAndWager.com LLC) meeting.

Trainer George Anthrop was suspended on June 2, 2014 (WatchAndWager.com LLC Ruling #54) for failing to appear at a formal hearing at Cal Expo. Today's hearing was the third hearing involving this matter. Today's hearing was requested by Trainer George Anthrop, who is still suspended. He failed to appear for today's hearing.

06-20-14<sup>2</sup> **RACETRACK INSPECTED**

The entire Pleasanton racing surface was inspected this morning. Track Superintendent Jim Burns, CHRB Safety Steward Paul Nicolo, CTT Representative Charlie Daugherty and CHRB Safety Steward Tom McCarthy took surface depth measurements around the one (1) mile oval. The track surface received a very good review from the four (4) individuals involved.

There had been a little pre-meet concern over the track surface. This concern has been addressed and today's inspection determined that the previous concern has been corrected and the track surface is consistent throughout.

06-20-14<sup>3</sup> **TIMER PROBLEM (REF: 06-19-2014<sup>4</sup>)**

Today's four hundred (400) yard Mule race was hand timed. Numerous timer checks prior to the race with Starter Todd Stephens were unsuccessful. Oak Tree Director of Racing Larry Swartzlander will continue to work on this problem.

06-20-14<sup>4</sup> **VOIDED CLAIM**

In today's fifth race, fifth place finisher #6 CAPTAIN RODNEY was claimed following a two way shake by Trainer Dan Morgan. CHRB Veterinarian Don Dooley informed the stewards that he was placing this horse on his veterinarian's list and the stewards subsequently voided this claim.

06-20-14<sup>5</sup> **RACE #7 – TOTE PROBLEM**

During the loading process of the seventh race, wagering opportunities were stopped when the mutuel system locked for approximately one (1) minute and thirty-six (36) seconds. This was after the official program approximate post time of 5:22 p.m. However it was prior to the actual set post time of 5:24 p.m.

The stewards contacted Tote Operator Michele Arendt and Mutuel Manager Bryan Wayte. After researching the matter, both reported to the stewards that betting was stopped by the judge's console which is operated by a placing judge adjacent to the stewards on the roof of the grandstand. The placing judge told the stewards that the stop betting command was not activated on the judge's console. Procedures for using the placing console were reviewed and we will continue to monitor the situation.

06-21-14<sup>1</sup> **SHYANN GARCIA HEARING (CASE NO: 14GG0061)**

An informal hearing was held this morning in the Pleasanton steward's office. The CHRB

filed a complaint against Jockey Shyann Garcia for alleged violation of CHRB Rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct).

On May 11, 2014, in the stable area at the Alameda County Fairgrounds (Pleasanton), Jockey Garcia was allegedly involved in an altercation with groom Laura Gonzalez. A third person, Apprentice Jockey Freddy Rodriguez, also participated in the disturbance as somewhat of a mediator.

At this informal hearing a twenty-five (25) page compliant packet was presented by CHRB Investigator Louis Quesada. Along with Ms. Garcia, also present at today's hearing were Trainer Hector Rangel and Jockey Agent Ralph Garcia. The stewards reviewed documents and asked several questions of all hearing participants. A decision will be rendered in the near future.

06-21-14<sup>2</sup> **RACE #3 – INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION**

The stewards posted the Inquiry sign following the running of the Jack Clifford Stakes (Purse \$10,000) which was for Quarter Horses going three hundred and fifty (350) yards. The stewards wanted to observe the actions of fifth place finisher #6 CHICKS IS CASH (Luis Godoy) and sixth place finisher #4 DASHETT (Hugo Herrera).

Race replays show #6 CHICKS IS CASH veer in at this race's midway point bumping and impeding both #4 DASHETT and seventh place finisher #5 SNOWY GADDAFY (Carlos Villalobos). The stewards reviewed all race angles and spoke to the jockeys involved. In a unanimous decision #6 CHICKS IS CASH was disqualified and placed seventh (last). Jockey Luis Godoy was ordered to see the stewards tomorrow.

06-21-14<sup>3</sup> **RACE #3 - TIMER PROBLEMS CONTINUE (REF: 06-19-2014<sup>4</sup> & 06-20-14<sup>3</sup>)**

Even though pre-race timer checks were successful, the timing of today's third race was unsuccessful. Once again Larry Swartzlander (Director of Racing Oak Tree at Pleasanton) will be contacted in an attempt to fix this problem.

06-21-14<sup>4</sup> **RACE #7 – INQUIRY AND OBJECTION**

The stewards posted the Inquiry sign and two (2) separate incidents were reviewed following today's seventh race.

The first incident involved three (3) horses racing in tight quarters prior to entering the first turn. The horses involved were: #2 BAMUEL TOI (Pablo Flores – 5<sup>th</sup> place), #3 SILVER CHAMP (Dionicio Navarro – 6<sup>th</sup> place) and #5 ON THE SUNNYSIDE (Cristobal Herrera – 7<sup>th</sup>). There was bumping between these three (3) rivals prior to going into the far (3/8ths) turn. The stewards did not make a change in the placing based on this incident however Jockey Dionicio Navarro was ordered to see the film analyst tomorrow.

Jockey Francisco Duran, who rode second place finisher #4 REDSTONE lodged a claim of foul against first place finisher #9 THUNDERING ROOTS (Pedro Flores) for alleged interference in this race's final eighty (80) yards. #4 REDSTONE drifted out initially and then #9 THUNDERING ROOTS drifts inwards. Jockey Duran on the second place horse steadies slightly at this point. The stewards unanimously felt this incident was minor in nature and there was nothing to warrant a change in the original placings. No change.

**Sunday**06-22-14<sup>1</sup> **PEDRO FLORES FILM REVIEW (REF: 06-21-2014<sup>4</sup>)**

Jockey Pedro Flores appeared in the steward's office in order to review his ride in yesterday's seventh race where he rode first place finisher #9 THUNDERING ROOTS. Flores' mount drifted in slightly in this race's final eighty (80) yards. Flores was reminded, in this informal hearing, to maintain a straight path in the stretch.

06-22-14<sup>2</sup> **RULING NO. 1 – SHYANN GARCIA RULING (REF: 06-21-2014<sup>1</sup>)**

Jockey **SHYANN GARCIA** is hereby fined three hundred dollars (\$300)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – Fighting in the Stable Area) on Sunday, May 11, 2014 at the Alameda County Fairgrounds (Pleasanton).

Further **SHYANN GARCIA** is placed on probation for the term of her license (02/28/17).

Jockey Shyann Garcia was notified of the ruling above following a hearing that was held yesterday at Pleasanton. Ms. Garcia has had several matters in front of the stewards recently.

06-22-14<sup>3</sup> **RULING NO. 2 – LUIS GODOY HEARING (REF: 06-21-2014<sup>2</sup>)**

Jockey **LUIS GODOY**, who rode **CHICKS IS CASH** in the third race at the Alameda County Fair on Saturday, June 21, 2014, is suspended three (3) racing days (June 29, July 3 and 4, 2014) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from fifth to seventh. A violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – careless riding).

Jockey Luis Godoy appeared in the steward's office today in order to review his ride in yesterday's third which was the \$10,000 Jack Clifford Stakes going three hundred fifty (350) yards. Godoy rode #6 CHICKS IS CASH who veered in twice in the race. Prior to the second change in course, CHICKS IS CASH comes inward and makes contact with #5 SNOWY GADDAFY (Carlos Villalobos). The stewards felt the altering of course in this race was caused by the actions of Jockey Godoy and not his mount. In a unanimous decision the stewards issued the ruling above.

06-22-14<sup>4</sup> **CESAR NUNGARAY-GUZMAN (CASE NO. 14GG0043)**

A formal hearing was held today at the Alameda County Fair in Pleasanton. Veterinarian Assistant/Owner Cesar Nungaray-Guzman was charged with alleged violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1489 (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License). On the day of the hearing this complaint was amended to add CHRB Rule #1900 (Grounds for Suspension or Revocation), Rule #1902.5 (Animal Welfare) and Rule #1902 (Conduct Detrimental to Horse Racing).

The complaint reads as follows, "*Nungaray-Guzman was convicted in Contra Costa County Superior Court of PC 597 (b) – Animal Cruelty. He is on probation for three years and cannot own animals.*"

Along with the stewards present at today's meeting were Veterinarian Assistant/Owner Cesar Nungaray-Guzman, CHRB Investigator Dan Dailey (Supervisor – North), and Contra

Costa County and Animal Control Services Sergeant Terry DeCosta. Christine Niccoli (Certified Court Reporter) transcribed the proceedings.

On April 18, 2012 Contra Costa County Animal Control was contacted by a concerned citizen who was horseback riding in the Richmond/El Sobrante Hills in the East Bay. Four (4) horses were soon seized by Animal Control. Pictures at today’s hearing showed obvious signs of malnourishment and/or rain rot that were found on these horses who were on a small ranch in these hills.

Guzman had been working for three (3) veterinarians at Golden Gate Fields as a veterinarian assistant. Guzman stated he was given most of the approximately eight (8) horses at the East Bay ranch that was owned by another individual. He purchased at least one (1) of these horses. He stated that his intent was to “help” these horses, who had problems, but he got too many of them and he couldn’t keep up with the cost of their upkeep.

At the live hearing Sergeant DeCosta said Contra Costa County spent \$35,000 on veterinarian and boarding bills on the four (4) horses that were seized in order to rehabilitate these horses. Three (3) years probation and full restitution was the sentence for the one (1) misdemeanor conviction of PC 597 (b) – Animal Cruelty. Four (4) felony counts were originally filed in this matter. Guzman pled ‘no contest’ to the one (1) misdemeanor.

On April 23, 2014 CHRB Executive Director Rick Baedeker summarily suspended Guzman’s CHRB license. After this date Guzman traveled to Santa Anita Park to apply for a groom’s license at which time he was denied by CHRB enforcement.

The stewards will review all documents presented at the hearing. They will also consider all testimony given. A decision on the case will be made in the near future. More to follow.

06-22-14<sup>5</sup> **RACE #3 – STEWARD’S REVIEW**

The stewards announced that they were conducting a ‘steward’s review’ of today’s third race. Fourth place finisher #3 CANDY FOR DEBBIE (William Antongeorgi III) threw its head at the start and lost much ground. There was no gate malfunction in this race and after the review this horse was deemed a ‘starter’.

06-22-14<sup>6</sup> **RACE #10 – INQUIRY**

The Inquiry sign was posted following the running of today’s tenth race.
