Report for the period Wednesday, July 2, 2014 through Sunday, July 6, 2014.

Wednesday**07-02-14¹ POST TIME CHANGE APPROVED**

Eleven races were drawn for Friday, July 4. Post time was originally scheduled for 2:15 p.m. which would have the last two races here at Pleasanton going off after Los Alamitos has finished. Oak Tree Director of Racing Larry Swartzlander requested that the Board approve first race post time be moved up to 1:45 p.m. Approval from Executive Director Rick Baedeker was received via e-mail on Sunday, June 29, 2014 at 5:18 p.m.

07-02-14² ENTRIES FOR SATURDAY – SCRATCHES FOR FRIDAY

Steward Darrel McHargue was on duty this dark day. A few jockey changes and one scratch were submitted for Friday. Ten (10) races were drawn for Saturday consisting of one Quarter Horse stakes, two Arabian stake races and seven Thoroughbred races, including a stake race.

Thursday**07-03-14¹ RULING NO. 9 – SANCHEZ**

Jockey **DIEGO SANCHEZ** is hereby fined fifty dollars (\$50)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1680 (Reporting to Jockey's Room – Late to Report) on Sunday, June 29, 2014 at the Alameda County Fair (Pleasanton).

The above ruling was issued after Sanchez was contacted and admitted to being late without approval.

07-03-14² SAFETY STEWARD CONCERN

Safety Steward Vic Stauffer came to the steward's office and was advised to consider filing a complaint with the CHRB concerning almost being hit by a track water truck following the last race on Sunday. Details of the incident were omitted in our conversation due to the possibility of a future hearing.

07-03-14³ **CAL-BRED REPORT**

Purse \$15,000 for California bred or sired three year old fillies, claiming price \$10,000-\$9,000, five furlongs failed to draw any entries and was called off.

07-03-14⁴ **CARR WARNED**

Jockey Dennis Carr was in to review the stretch drive of Sunday's 6th race in which his mount drifted slightly. Mr. Carr was cautioned to keep a straight course.

07-03-14⁵ **ROBERTS HEARING – CASE #14GG0063**

A complaint was heard concerning an argument between trainer Don Roberts and exercise rider Ronald Glover which was observed by CHRB Investigator Louis Quesada. Although no physical assaults were observed or reported, Mr. Roberts was armed with a golf club. Testimony was taken and a decision to follow.

07-03-14⁶ **GLOVER HEARING – CASE #14GG0062 (REF: 07-03-14⁷)**

Exercise rider Ronald Glover failed to appear to answer charges alleging violation of CHRB rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct) relating to an argument with trainer Don Roberts.

07-03-14⁷ **HORSE OWNERSHIP DISPUTE**

Arabian horse CV BURNING DESIRE is entered and scheduled to race in tomorrow's (07-04-2014) second race under the ownership of John Qualtrough. The horse is trained by Osman Villalta. Past performances indicate CV BURNING DESIRE raced in Delaware on June 5th and 9th, 2014 under the ownership of John Qualtrough and trained by Mark Powell. This morning the stewards were presented with a lease agreement signed in January 2014 in Utah by John Qualtrough leasing to Mark Powell. More to follow.

07-03-14⁸ **RACE #4 – INQUIRY – NO CHANGE**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign to review the stretch drive in which #5 CRESTATORRE (Frank Alvarado) took up briefly between horses. After review it was determined that #5 had obtained his maximum placing while being passed by #1 EDDIE BETTER (Maicol Severino) and #4 ROUGE STATUS (Pedro Flores). No change.

07-03-14⁹ **RACE #7 – NO SHOW WAGERING**

Two late scratches reduced the field to four wagering interests. In accordance with CHRB Rule #1954 (Pari-Mutuel Pools) show wagering was cancelled.

07-03-14¹⁰ **CLAIM REPORT**

The six horses claimed today all passed veterinary inspection.

- 07-04-14¹ **HORSE ALLOWED TO RACE (REF: 07-03-2014⁷)**
A determination was made that the lease presented on the horse CV BURNING DESIRE was not properly registered in California and the horse will race under the original owner John Qualtrough at this time. Mr. Powell's attorney was informed of our decision.
- 07-04-14² **CAL-BRED REPORT**
Purse \$15,000 for California bred or sired three year olds, claiming \$10,000-\$9,000, five furlongs failed to fill with three entries.
- 07-04-14³ **RULING NO. 10 – ROBERTS (REF: 07-03-2014⁵)**
Trainer **DONALD ROBERTS** is hereby fined one hundred dollars (\$100)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – Aggressive Behavior Toward Another Person) on May 10, 2014 at Golden Gate Fields.
The above ruling was issued following yesterday's hearing.
- 07-04-14⁴ **RULING NO. 11 – GLOVER (REF: 07-03-2014⁶)**
Exercise Rider **RONALD K. GLOVER** having failed to appear before the Alameda County Fair Board of Stewards to answer a complaint alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct) is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).
During the term of suspension, all license privileges of **RONALD K. GLOVER** are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board Rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine) subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.
The above ruling was issued for failure to appear.
- 07-04-14⁵ **RULINGS NO. 12 & 13 – RUBIO**
Jockey **FRANCISCO RUBIO**, who was scheduled to appear for film review in the steward's office at the Alameda County Fair (Pleasanton) on June 27, 2014, is hereby fined one hundred dollars (\$100)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations – Failure to Attend Film Review).
Jockey **FRANCISCO RUBIO**, who was scheduled to ride SASSY J DASH in the first race on July 3, 2014 at the Alameda County Fair (Pleasanton), is hereby fined one hundred dollars (\$100)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Agreement).
The above rulings were issued for Rubio's failure to take care of business in a professional manner.
- 07-04-14⁶ **JOCKEY IN**
Jockey Maicol Severino appeared to review his ride aboard #1 EDDIE BETTER in yesterday's 4th race. Severino was very understanding of our instruction to make a quicker reaction to his mount's drifting. Warning issued.
- 07-04-14⁷ **RACE #1 – INQUIRY - DISQUALIFICATION**
The inquiry sign was posted to review this 350 yard mule event. Jockey Joe Crispin, aboard sixth place finisher #5 BAR JF EASY MONEY, also filed an objection against second place finisher #6 LIL SARAH and jockey Jesus Arriaga for alleged interference halfway through the event. Patrol Judge Dee Dee Robinson also reported possible interference between #5 and #6. After talking to the riders and thorough review, #6 was disqualified for coming in and impeding the progress of #5. Jockey Arriaga was ordered to the stewards.

Original Order of Finish: 7 – 6 – 1 – 3 – 2 – 5 – 4Official Order of Finish: 7 – 1 – 3 – 2 – 5 – 6 – 407-04-14⁸ **RACE #8 – INQUIRY – NO CHANGE**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign to review the start of today's Oak Tree Sprint concerning #3 COACH BOB (Juan Sanchez). After review and talking to starter Todd Stephens, it was unanimous that #3 was a starter. Tapes show #3 lunge at the gate, almost simultaneous with the actual start, creating its own problems.

07-04-14⁹ **RACE #10 – OBJECTION – NO CHANGE**

Jockey Silvio Amador aboard #1 MS. SWEET FREEDOM lodged a claim of foul against #2 CREATION'S GIFT and jockey Catalino Martinez for alleged interference near the ¼ pole. Tapes revealed that tight quarters existed but no interference was detected.

Purse \$11,000 for California bred or sired maiden fillies and mares, claiming \$12,500, six furlongs failed to fill with two entries.

07-05-14² **LOPEZ HEARING (CASE: 14GG0069)**

A hearing was conducted concerning stable foreman Jorge Robledo Lopez being intoxicated while leading a horse to the paddock. CHRB Senior Special Investigator D.A. Tadlock presented the case. In addition, Lopez was present with trainer/attorney Brian Pitnick. Winners Foundation representative Nora Lee was also present. The proceedings were recorded by Connie Parchman of Niccoli Reporting. Safety Steward Vic Stauffer sat in for Steward Darrel McHargue who was delayed in arriving this morning for personal reasons. Lopez admitted to drinking "some" beers before someone asked him to paddock a horse. His recent history shows no violations but Winners Foundation Representative Nora Lee remembers and his license history verifies problems in California about 11 years ago. Mr. Lopez feels he can control his problem with help from Winners Foundation and horsemen like Mr. Pitnick to support him. Decision to follow.

07-05-14³ **GARNICA HEARING (CASE: 14GG0059)**

A hearing was conducted on a case concerning groom Julio Cesar Garnica for a second violation of CHRB rules 1874, 1890 (b) and 1489 (h) concerning marijuana use and possession. CHRB Senior Special Investigator Louis Quesada presented the case. In addition, present at the hearing were the board of stewards, defendant Garnica and Armando Calero of Winners Foundation. The proceedings were recorded by Connie Parchman of Niccoli Reporting.

Evidence was overwhelming that Garnica possessed and used marijuana. Mr. Garnica admitted to the charges and appeared willing to work with the Winners Foundation. Decision to follow.

07-05-14⁴ **CAL-BRED / SIRED RACES AT CAL EXPO**

It was noted by this Board of Stewards that the California State Fair condition book did not offer any Cal-bred races in accordance with CHRB rule #1813 (Association to Program California-Bred Races). Racing Secretary Tom "Bomber" Doutrich said the Cal-bred races were inadvertently dropped at the printers and that he will offer an "extra" each day for Cal-bred/sired horses.

07-05-14⁵ **RACE #2 – JOCKEY FALLS – INQUIRY – NO CHANGE**

The second race was the Arabian stake for amateur lady jockeys (H.H. Sheikha Fatima Bint Mubarak Ladies World Championship). At the start, Azhar Al Wardi aboard #1 MY HEMI MAGNUM lost control of her mount and fell. All early reports indicated no injuries to horse or rider. #10 KENTUCKY BAY also had an awkward start due to obvious inexperience by amateur jockey Samara Johnson which took the horse out of competition.

07-05-14⁶ **PATROL JUDGE CHANGE**

Patrol Judge Lisa Jones was replaced by Myra Troske for races 8, 9 and 10 after feeling ill.

07-05-14⁷ **CLAIMS GOOD**

All four horses claimed today passed veterinary scrutiny.

07-06-14¹ **RULING NO. 14 – ARRIAGA (REF: 07-04-14⁷)**

Jockey **JESUS ARRIAGA**, who rode LIL SARAH in the first race at the Alameda County Fair on Friday, July 4, 2014, is suspended three (3) racing days (July 12, 13 and 17, 2014) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from second to sixth. A violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

The above ruling was issued after Arriaga appeared, reviewed the films, and accepted responsibility for failing to grab his mount in a timely fashion.

07-06-14² **CAL-BRED REPORT**

Purse \$11,000 for California-bred or sired three year olds and upward maidens, claiming price \$12,500, six furlongs failed to fill Cal-bred and was used open with seven entries.

07-06-14³ **MEETING WITH PLEASANTON DIRECTOR OF RACING**

The stewards met with Director of Racing Jeanne Wasserman to thank her for her hospitality and review what appeared to be a great meet aided by the Oak Tree contingent.

Two issues that should be addresses before next year were brought to the front.

First, the clocker and Equibase personnel need to be moved away from the crowd and higher into the stands in order to facilitate accurate calls and times.

Second, the running of the amateur jockey races poses an unusual safety concern. At least two of the jockeys in this year's event seemed ill prepared for racing although advised thoroughly by the stewards what to prepare for and possessing dossier's that would indicate some experience. Ms. Wasserman was advised to be cautious providing "amateur" racing in the future due to safety concerns for horses and riders.

07-06-14⁴ **RULING NO. 15 – LOPEZ (REF: 07-05-14²)**

Stable Foreman **JORGE ROBLEDO LOPEZ** is hereby fined two hundred dollars (\$200)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – Leading Horse to Paddock While Intoxicated) at the Alameda County Fairgrounds (Pleasanton) on June 29, 2014.

JORGE ROBLEDO LOPEZ must be evaluated and comply with guidelines set forth by the Winners Foundation for the remainder of the term of license. Failure to do so shall result in the suspension of all of his licenses. **JORGE ROBLEDO LOPEZ** must sign a testing agreement with the California Horse Racing Board.

The above ruling was issued following due deliberation over yesterday's hearing. Mr. Lopez understands his license and livelihood are in jeopardy if he does not follow through.

07-06-14⁵ **RULING NO. 16 – GARNICA (REF: 07-05-14³)**

Groom **JULIO CESAR GARNICA** is hereby suspended for fifteen (15) days (July 13-27, 2014) and fined two hundred dollars (\$200)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1489 (h) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License), rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – Use of Marijuana) and rule #1890 (b) (Possession of Contraband).

Prior to reinstatement Mr. Garnica must enter into a contract with the Winners Foundation for a minimum of one year and shall remain in a testing agreement with the California Horse Racing Board. Failure to comply with terms and condition of licensing will be cause for action against Mr. Garnica's license privileges.

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of **JULIO CESAR GARNICA** are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The above ruling was issued in an attempt to make Mr. Garnica aware that marijuana use and possession is not going to be tolerated on the backside of a racetrack.

07-06-14⁶ **RULING NO. 17 – AMADOR**

Jockey **SILVIO AMADOR** is hereby fined the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300)* for misuse of the whip on DASHING during the running of the fifth race on Saturday, July 5, 2014 at the Alameda County Fair (Pleasanton); a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (Use of Whips).

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Amador appeared and reviewed the stretch run of yesterday's fifth race. Amador said he was flagging the horse's ear, but the stewards felt that he hit the horse's head at least once as seen on the tapes.

- 07-06-14⁷ **RACE #1 – MULES – OBJECTION – NO CHANGE**
Jockey Dionicio Navarro aboard #1 DASHING JACK (6th) lodged a claim of foul against #2 SASSY JAZZY (3rd) and jockey Luis Lira for alleged interference in this 400 yard event. After talking to the riders and film review no change was ordered. Tight quarters did exist, but no foul was detected.
- 07-06-14⁸ **RACE #2 – STEWARDS REVIEW**
Replays were shown of the start of the second race under the new Stewards' Review Guidelines. #7 BIZMO reared as the starter released the field creating its own problem. A "Stewards' Review" graphic was displayed and an announcement was made.
- 07-06-14⁹ **RACE #3 – NO SHOW WAGERING**
#1 EMERALD GREEN (Tr. W.E. Morey) was a late scratch reducing the field to four wagering interests in today's third race. In accordance with CHRB rule #1954 (Pari-Mutuel Pools) show wagering was cancelled.
- 07-06-14¹⁰ **RACE #5 – DOUBLE INQUIRY - DISQUALIFICATION**
The inquiry sign was posted to review two separate events.
First, #1 GRYPHON GOLD unseated jockey Frank Alvarado shortly after the start by ducking out as Alvarado steadies him back. No change. Jockey Alvarado was transported to Valley Care Center for precautionary reasons.
Second, #4 TIZ THE SEASON (Maicol Severino, 2nd) races wide around the turn, forcing #3 WHERE'S THE PROOF (6th) and #5 DAY JUR HOOQ (4th) to race wide off of their chosen path. After talking to the riders and in depth film review, it was determined unanimously to disqualify #4 from 2nd and place him 6th. The actions of #4 were enough to cost #3 and #5 the opportunity to finish in a better position.

- 07-06-14¹¹ **RACE #11 – LATE SCRATCH**
#9 JOIE DE VIVRE unseated jockey C.H. Aragon as the horses started to load for the last race and got away from the assistant starter. #9 ran up the stretch and hurdled the gap gate onto the path that leads to the barn area. #9 was declared a late scratch by the stewards. Early reports are that jockey and horse were both unscathed.
- 07-06-14¹² **CLAIMS GOOD**

Jockey Joe Crispin failed to contact the stewards directly for the second straight day. His wife called to report that he has a bad back and she was told to have Joe call himself.
