06-15-18¹ VELASQUEZ RULING

RULING NO. 01

Jockey JESUS VELASQUEZ who was scheduled to ride **LUCKY SHOES TO WIN** in the second race on Sunday, April 15, 2018 at Golden Gate Fields is hereby fined the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Agreement).

The above ruling was issued after Velasquez appeared after not riding for a couple of months. He failed to ride his last scheduled mount at Golden Gate Fields and now wishes to resume riding on the fairs.

05-15-18² **THIRD RACE – VOIDED CLAIM**

The claim submitted by trainer Allen Rogers for the gelding THE BOLD ONE was deemed void when State Veterinarian Forrest Franklin declared the horse unsound. THE BOLD ONE was returned to the barn of Natalie Houle.

06-16-18¹ **CEDILLO RULING**

RULING NO. 02

Jockey ABEL **CEDILLO** who rode **JUST NIK** in the third race at Oak Tree at Pleasanton on Friday, June 15, 2018 is hereby fined the sum of four hundred dollars (\$400)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (use of Riding Crop – used more than three times without giving the horse a chance to respond). (4th offense in 60 days).

The above ruling was issued after Cedillo called and accepted the penalty. He has had a little difficulty conforming to the crop rule recently and promised to try harder.

06-16-18² **RUSSELL RULING**

RULING NO. 03

Jockey **CHRIS RUSSELL** who was scheduled to ride **AUTISM IS HERE** in the fourth race on Friday, June 15, 2018 at Oak Tree at Pleasanton is hereby fined the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Agreement).

The above ruling was issued after jockey Chris Russell contacted the Stewards and explained he missed his flight from Los Angeles and had to catch a later flight. He missed his mount in the fourth race, but made it in time to ride the eighth race.

06-16-18³ **MONROY RULING**

RULING NO. 04

Jockey **FRANCISCO MONROY** is hereby fined the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100)* for failure to report his proper weight at the Oak Tree at Pleasanton meeting on Friday, June 15, 2018, a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1682 (Weighing out).

The above ruling was issued after Monroy appeared and accepted the penalty after he forgot to report his weight to the Assistant Clerk of the Scales.

06-16-18⁴ **5TH RACE INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION**

The inquiry sign was posted to review the start of this five furlong race concerning second place finisher #6 LITTLE MOO (Frank Alvarado) and fourth and fifth place finishers #4 LUCILLE (Abel Cedillo) and #5 DRIVEROFF THEDECK (Francisco Duran) respectively.

After talking to the riders and Patrol Judge and a thorough review of the replays #6 was unanimously disqualified from 2nd and placed 5th behind #5.

Tapes show #6 break directly to its inside bumping and impeding #5 who in turn inconveniences a slow breaking #4. The interference to #5 was severe enough to effectually eliminate him from any chance at a better placing.

06-16-18⁵ **8TH RACE – STEWARDS REVIEW**

The Stewards reviewed the actions of #7 PURE PERFECTION near the ¼ pole where his rider, Frank Alvarado, appeared to check off the heels of #1 HYPHY (Pedro Terrero). After review it was determined #7 was actually getting out on its own causing its own problem. No reason for an inquiry.

06-16-18⁶ **NINTH RACE – INQUIRY – ACCIDENT – NO CHANGE**

The inquiry sign was posted to review the start concerning jockey Catalino Martinez being unseated from his mount #6 MULTIPLE SUNS. After review it was determined #6 reared at the start and Martinez lost his balance. No change. Neither jockey nor horse were reported injured. Accident report attached.
