The inquiry sign was hung by the stewards concerning #6 "I Go Blind", driven by Steve Wiseman, for possible violation of the breaking rule after the start. After review, no change was made.

 A hearing for Dr. Audrey Clifton was held in the steward's office at Cal Expo at 4:00 p.m. This involved the late scratch of the horse “Caeser”, trained by Gretchen Smith, in the Ninth Race on Friday, April 24, 2009.
- Senior Investigator Martin Snezek presented the case for the California Horse Racing Board and evidence was presented.
- Dr. Clifton admitted mistakenly giving the wrong medicine to the horse “Caeser” before his scheduled race, thus necessitating the scratch of the horse.
- The hearing closed and the stewards deliberated about the case.

 The stewards hung the inquiry sign concerning possible violation of the breaking rule by #6 “Phipps”, driven by Lou Pena, in the stretch. After review of the tapes, the stewards placed the horse “Phipps” from third (3rd) to sixth (6th).
