Proceedings of the Board of Stewards for the period of Monday, November 16, 2009 through Sunday, November 22, 2009. Steward Will Meyers was the Reporting and Duty Steward for the enclosed period.

11/20/09 (1) **Campbell and Jackson Vs Van Tassel – Case #09SW-0098**

A hearing was convened to hear a case involving a small claims judgment awarded to Owner Leona Jackson against Trainer Lisa Van Tassel in the amount of \$959.58. The claim stems from a horse ("Jaccka Invoke N") trained by Van Tassel for Part Owner Jackson. The stewards informed Van Tassel she must honor the judgment or face suspension of her license. The hearing was recorded by Wendy Frazier of Frazier Reporting.

11/20/09 (2) **Van Tassel Vs Campbell and Jackson – Case #09SW-0175**

A second hearing was convened to address a complaint filed by Trainer Lisa Van Tassel against Owners Leona Jackson and Phillip Campbell for alleged training bills owed on the horse "Jaccka Invoke N". Both Van Tassel and Campbell testified. Campbell presented some documents which were accepted on the record. It was apparent that more time was needed to sort through testimony and verify alleged bills paid by Van Tassel and/or Phillip Campbell. The hearing was continued until Saturday, November 28th in order to allow both parties to gather the requested documents. Wendy Frazier again recorded the proceedings.

The above ruling was issued following yesterday's hearing. By documents submitted, the bill was valid for \$394.90 for services rendered by Landers. Mr. Wine's counter claim in the paperwork stemmed from an incident involving Landers allegedly wrecking a golf cart which the stewards believe belongs in outside court.

11/21/09 (2) **Jason Maier Hearing – Case #09SW-0173**

A hearing was conducted today for a high Flunixin reported by U.C. Davis Laboratory on the horse "Bob Lee", trained by Jason Maier. U.C. Davis reported 60 ng/ml while the split sample tested by Industrial Laboratories on behalf of Maier reported 59.6 ng/ml.

Maier's only thought was that he may have given too much Flunixin out of an oral Syringe tube.

Maier understood that he needs to be more careful when administrating his medications.

A decision will be forthcoming.

With board approval, place and show wagering were canceled on tonight's second race. The cancellation did not make the program and announcements were made to inform the public.

Sunday11/22/09 (1) **Maier Ruling [Ref 11/21/09 (2)]****Ruling #33**

Trainer Jason Maier, who started the horse "Bob Lee" in the Ninth Race at Cal Expo on October 09, 2009, is hereby fined the sum of Five Hundred (\$500) Dollars pursuant to California Horse Racing Board Rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1843 (D) (Medications, Drugs and Other Substances – Flunixin (60 ng/ml) in Excess of Permitted Level) Class IV that carries a Class C penalty.

The above ruling was issued following deliberation over yesterday's hearing. This is Maier's first medication violation.
