Double Draw

The racing office was open today accepting entries for Thursday, December 3 and Friday, December 4. Ten (10) races were drawn for December 3. Seventy eight (78) horses are scheduled to start.

Fifteen (15) races are slated for December 4. One of these races is 'The California Sire Stakes Two (2) Year Old Trotters'. One hundred seventeen (117) horses are scheduled to start.

Scratch Time/Double Draw

Scratch time was held this morning in the racing office for December 3 and December 4. Eleven (11) driver changes for December 4 were activated after the 9:00 a.m. deadline.

Entries for Saturday December 5 and Sunday December 6 were taken this morning in the racing office. Sixteen (16) races are scheduled for December 5. One of these races is 'The California Sires Stake – Two Year Old Colts and Gelding Division'. One hundred twenty six (126) horses are slated to start.

Ten (10) races are scheduled for December 6. Eighty (80) horses are scheduled to start.

Scratch time for Saturday December 5 and Sunday December 6 was held this morning in the racing office. Eleven (11) driver changes were made for December 6. All these changes were activated shortly after the 9:00 a.m. deadline.

12/03/09 (1) **Qualifying Races**

Two (2) qualifying races were held prior to tonight's ten (10) race pari-mutual card. Of the fourteen (14) competitors, eleven (11) made the grade.

12/03/09 (2) **Tom and Jill Wine Meeting**

Trainer Tom Wine and his wife/assistant trainer Jill Wine came to the steward's office for an informal meeting. Trainer Tom Wine has a formal hearing scheduled next week (December 11) for an alleged overage of Bute that was reported to be in the system of one of his horses. Assistant Trainer Jill Wine made a request to transfer twenty three (23) horses into her name earlier this week. The duty steward (Baker) recommended that she and her husband meet with all three (3) stewards before the races tonight.

The stewards are inquiring whether any portion of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1843.3 (2i & j) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances) would be in question by approving the aforementioned trainer transfer. More to follow.

12/03/09 (3) **Frank Petrelli Ruling**

Ruling # 38

Trainer Frank Petrelli, who started "Special Edition N" in the Ninth Race on Sunday, November 29, 2009, is hereby fined the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100) for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered – Late Arriving in Paddock – 2nd Offense).

The ruling above was issued after the stewards received a phone call from Horse Identifier Carl Sobey, informing the stewards that the Petrelli trained "Special Edition N" was late to the paddock for the ninth race.

12/03/09 (4) **Third Race – Inquiry/Double Disqualification**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign to view two (2) incidents in the stretch. Second place finisher #4 "My Sierra Doll" (Rick Plano) goes on an extended break in the final 1/16 of a mile. For violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1722 (Breaking), the stewards unanimously voted to disqualify #4 "My Sierra Doll" and place him ninth (last).

In a second incident, original fifth place finisher #2 “Manaloha” (Trent Tharps, Jr.) goes on a ‘break’ in deep stretch and at the finish. Sixth place finisher #6 “Trot on Water” (James Kennedy) was ‘lapped’ on the hind quarters of #2 “Manaloha”, therefore the stewards enforced California Horse Racing Board Rule #1723 (Lapped-on Break), disqualifying #2 “Manaloha” and placing him sixth.

The results of the double disqualification:

Original order of finish: 3-4-9-7-2-6-8-5-1

After 1st Disqualification: 3-9-7-2-6-8-5-1-4

After 2nd Disqualification (official): 3-9-7-6-2-8-5-1-4

12/03/09 (5) **Seventh Race – Inquiry/Disqualification**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign after viewing fourth place finisher #1 “Pussy Cat” (Troyce Thomas) go on an extended break in the final 1/16 of a mile and crossing the wire. Fourth place finisher #6 “Only In California” (Luke Plano) was also ‘lapped on’ the hind quarters of #1 “Pussy Cat” at the finish.

In a unanimous decision, #1 “Pussy Cat” was disqualified and placed fourth for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1722 (Breaking).

12/03/09 (6) **Driving Milestone**

Veteran Driver Tim Maier recorded win number 2000 in tonight’s eighth race. Tim Maier reined and trained #1 “Little Kiera”. California Harness Horsemen Association (CHHA) Representative Alan Horowitz was in the winner’s circle to present a nice plaque from the Horsemen’s Association commemorating this significant milestone.

12/04/09 (1) **Eighth Race – Inquiry**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign after viewing tenth (last) place finisher #8 “Check Raisin” (David Siegel) ‘race up’ on eight place rival #6 “My Real Love” (Lemoyne Svendsen), making contact on that rival from behind.

This incident also forced ninth place finisher #9 “Aeronaut” (Gilbert Herrera) to race wide down the back side to avert traffic problems.

The stewards spoke to both Drivers Siegel and Svendsen. No change was made due to the fact the offending horse (#8 “Check Raisin”) finished last.

Driver David Siegel was ordered to film review with the stewards.

12/04/09 (2) **Twelfth Race – Inquiry/Disqualification**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign after viewing fifth place finisher #2 “Beach Beach Beach” (Lemoyne Svendsen) go on a ‘break’ about one hundred (100) yards before the finish.

The stewards unanimously ruled that #2 “Beach Beach Beach” failed to abide by California Horse Racing Board Rule #1722 (Breaking) by not losing sufficient ground following the ‘break’. For this incident she was disqualified and placed seventh (last).

12/04/09 (3) **Thirteenth Race – Inquiry/Disqualification**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign after viewing seventh place finisher #6 “Bangers And Mash” (James Kennedy) go off his trotting gait for the entire one (1) mile race.

For violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1722 (Breaking), #6 “Bangers And Mash” was disqualified and placed ninth (last).

Saturday12/05/09 (1) **David Siegel – Film Review**

Driver David Siegel appeared in the steward's office to review his drive in the eighth race last night (December 4). Driver Siegel sat behind tenth (last) place finisher #8 "Check Raisin" in this race.

Race review show Driver Siegel run his horse up on the back of Driver Lemoyne Svendsen, who was aboard eighth place finisher #6 "My Real Love". Driver Siegel stated that he didn't think he made contact with Driver Svendsen. The stewards were of the unanimous opinion that contact did exist in this race before the 1/2 mile marker. Decision to follow.

12/05/09 (2) **Brian Solden Remand Hearing (Case No: 09SW-0172)**

California Horse Racing Board Executive Director Kirk Breed issued an order of remand on November 13, 2009 in the 'Brian Solden matter'. Cal Expo's stewards issued Ruling #25 on November 07, 2009 fining Trainer Brian Solden for violations of California Horse Racing Board Rules #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse), Rule #1843 (D) (Medications, Drugs and Other Substances) and Rule #1866 (Veterinarian's List).

On October 8, 2009 Trainer Solden raced his horse "Mac Jonathan VP" in a qualifying race at Cal Expo with the purpose of having that horse removed from the Cal Expo veterinarian's list. U.C. Davis laboratories reported that a blood sample of Phenylbutazone had a level of 8.12 ug/ml in its system. Cal Expo stewards issued a Five Hundred Dollar (\$500) penalty in this matter (Ruling #25).

Present at the remand hearing today, along with the stewards, were Trainer Brian Solden, his attorney Penny Caryl Davis, California Horse Racing Board Veterinarian Robert Goodbary, Cal Expo Track Veterinarian Henry Cook, and California Horse Racing Board Supervising Investigator Greg Fabbri. Court Reporter Yvonne Fenner (Frazier Reporting) recorded the proceedings.

Attorney Penny Caryl Davis argued that the chain of custody with the test sample in this matter was not adequate.

Some facts in this matter arose today in the formal hearing that did not surface in the informal hearing on December 5. Additionally, a list of the qualifying races that took place on October 8, 2009 was submitted into evidence at this hearing. Three (3) key points of evidence/testimony were presented today.

- A. The 'Acknowledgment of Test Sample' (CHRB-14) was not adequately filled out in this matter.
- B. An incorrect trainer was listed on the Official Veterinarian's Report (CHRB-37).
- C. The stewards did not agree with the number of horses that were ordered to be tested following the running of 'Qualifying Race Four (4)' on October 8, 2009. These three (3) key factors led the stewards to issue a unanimous decision. Case dismissed. The stewards will schedule a meeting with California Horse Racing Board Veterinarian Robert Goodbary to review testing procedures.

12/05/09 (3) **Second Race – Inquiry**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign following this two year old 'California Sires Stakes' (Purse \$15,000). Four (4) horses made breaks in this race. Third place finisher #3 "Online Charger" (Bruce Clarke), fourth place finisher #1 "The Write Stuff" (John Chappell) and sixth place finisher #5 "Bobby Baccala" (Rick Plano).

This was a 'general inquiry' as the stewards wished to research if all horses complied with California Horse Racing Board Rule #1722 (Breaking). All horses complied and no change was made in the order of finish.

12/05/09 (4) **Tote Delay**

There was an eight (8) minute tote delay after the eighth race was declared official. Problems with the calculation of the 'Super High 5' wager was given as the reason for the delay.
