Proceedings of the Board of Stewards for the period of Monday, October 18, 2010 through Sunday, October 24, 2010. Steward Will Meyers was the Reporting and Duty Steward for the enclosed period.

10/18/10 (1) Entries for Thursday

Eighty six (86) horses are entered for Thursday's eleven (11) race card. No Cal-Breds were used.

One (1) scratch and four (4) driver changes were made for Thursday's card.

One (1) non-betting and fifteen (15) wagering races filled for Friday with one hundred fifteen (115) horses scheduled to compete.

Saturday's fifteen (15) race card filled with one hundred nine (109) horses entered. Two (2) non-wagering sire stakes will be contested Saturday.

One with four (4) horses and one with five (5).

10/21/10 (1) **Luke Plano Ruling**

Ruling # 38

Driver Luke Plano, who drove “Sandra Hotspur” in the Tenth Race on Saturday, October 16, 2010, is hereby fined the sum of Two Hundred (\$200) Dollars for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1721 (J) (Driving Rules – Bore Out, Causing Interference – Resulting In a Disqualification). Incident occurred in deep stretch.

The above ruling was issued after Luke Plano appeared and reviewed the race with the stewards. Plano could not deny the interference, but felt the blame lay on his horse.

10/21/10 (2) **Third Race – Inquiry/No Change**

The inquiry sign was posted to review possible interference between the winner #2 “She Is So Glad” (Richard Wojcio), and #3 “No Storm Damage” (Troyce Thomas) around the final turn.

After review it was determined no interference occurred as #2 pulled from the pocket.

10/21/10 (3) **Eleventh Race – Inquiry/Disqualification**

#3 “Barney Ryan” (Steve Wiseman) went off stride in deep stretch and through the finish, ending up finishing fourth (4th).

#3 was ‘lapped on’ with fifth (5th) place finisher #2 “Split The Bill” (Keith Willey). #3 was placed fifth (5th) for the violation.

Friday10/22/10 (1) **Fourth Race – Inquiry/No Change**

The inquiry sign was posted to review an incident entering the final turn, involving #1 “High Maintenance” (Luke Plano, 3rd) and #5 “Cheyne’s Train” (David Siegel, 1st).

After review and talking to the drivers involved, it was determined that while the circumstances were unusual, no interference occurred. No change.

Tapes show #1 racing a little wide and Driver Siegel is having trouble holding his mount (#5) in the pocket. Rather than go to the outside, which is a normal passing move, Siegel elects to drop to the inside to pass and skims the pylons. While this type of maneuver is considered unethical amongst the drivers, it is not a violation unless interference occurs.

Saturday10/23/10 (1) **Rick Plano Ruling****Ruling # 39**

Trainer Rick Plano is fined the sum of One Hundred (\$100) Dollars for failing to make three (3) equipment changes at the proper time on October 22, 2010 at Cal Expo, California; A violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations).

The above ruling was issued after Plano reported equipment changes on three (3) stake horses after the four o’clock deadline.

10/23/10 (2) **Vickie Desomer Ruling****Ruling # 40**

Trainer Vickie Desomer is fined the sum of Fifty (\$50) Dollars for failing to make an equipment change on “Dine N Wine” at the proper time on October 22, 2010 at Cal Expo, California; A violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations).

The above ruling was issued after Desomer reported an equipment change on a stake horse after the four o’clock deadline.

- 10/23/10 (3) **Qualifiers**
 Twenty one (21) out of twenty eight (28) horses made the grade in today's five (5) qualifiers.
- 10/23/10 (4) **A Plethora of Racing**
 Five (5) qualifiers, two (2) non-wagering sire stakes and fifteen (15) wagering races are being conducted today.
 Five (5) qualifiers, three (3) non-wagering, and forty one (41) wagering races were contested in this three (3) day week.
- 10/23/10 (5) **Rain Dampens Spirits**
 The two non-wagering stakes races and the first three wagering races were conducted on a good track in light rain. The rain began to pour, and from the fourth race through the rest of the card, the track was listed sloppy. Drivers reported that it was hard to see and requested the track crew to scrape the surface or they would not drive. Management was alerted to the situation and after a race was run, the track crew capitulated and the races were run without further incident.
- 10/23/10 (6) **Tenth Race – Inquiry/Disqualification**
 #1 “Iverman” (Scott Cisco) went off stride for almost a quarter of a mile around the 1st turn. “Iverman” was in traffic and Cisco did not take back or lose ground until after being offstride for approximately 20 strides, which is one of three requirements to comply with the breaking rule. In fact, in the early stages of breaking, #1 actually gained ground and Driver Cisco failed to try and bring him back on stride, which is another violation of the breaking rule. “Iverman” went on to finish third (3rd) but was disqualified and placed last for the violation.
