11/08/10 (1) **Entries for Thursday**

Seventy six (76) horses are scheduled to start in Thursday's ten (10) race card. No Cal-Bred races were used.

11/09/10 (1) **Scratches for Thursday/Entries for Friday & Saturday**

Two (2) driver changes were made for Thursday.

Friday's fifteen (15) race card drew one hundred seventeen (117) entries.

There are two (2) non-wagering sire stakes on Friday with five (5) and eight (8) horses, respectively. There are two (2) non-wagering sire stakes on Saturday with five (5) and six (6) horses entered.

**Ruling # 44**

*Driver Tony Succarotte, who drove #2 “Skyway Fantasy” in the Eighth Race on November 06, 2010, is hereby fined the sum of One Hundred (\$100) Dollars for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered – Violation of ‘Cal-Expo House Whipping Rule’ – (4)(A) (Any Blatant or Exaggerated Movements of the Whipping Arm Which Will Result From Raising the Elbow Above the Drivers Shoulder Height and/or Allow the Hand Holding the Whip to Reach Behind the Driver During the Use of the Whip).*

The above ruling was issued after Succarotte appeared on his second violation in less than a month.

11/11/10 (2) **Silvestri III Ruling**

**Ruling # 45**

*Driver Ralph Silvestri III, who drove “Adora” in the Twelfth Race on Saturday, November 6, 2010 is hereby fined the sum of Fifty (\$50) Dollars for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule # 1731 (G) (Starting Rules - Failure to Come Up into Position).*

The above ruling was issued after Silvestri appeared and reviewed the film of last night’s 12<sup>th</sup> Race. Silvestri admitted to turning late to the gate, which left him lagging behind at the start.

11/11/10 (3) **Qualifiers**

Thirteen (13) of seventeen (17) horses made the grade in today’s three (3) qualifying races.

11/11/10 (4) **Second Race – Inquiry/Disqualification**

#1 “Mighty Fine Hi Ho” (Tim Maier) went offstride in deep stretch and through the wire while racing in second position. Third (3<sup>rd</sup>) place finisher, #3 “Marlin Hanover” (Liberio Pacheco) was lapped on with #1 at the finish. #1 was placed third (3<sup>rd</sup>) for the lapped on break.

*Driver Richard Bertrand, who drove #4 “Fox Valley Sly” in the Ninth Race on November 06, 2010, is hereby fined the sum of Fifty (\$50) Dollars for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered – Violation of ‘Cal-Expo House Whipping Rule’ – (4)(A) (Any Blatant Or Exaggerated Movements Of The Whipping Arm Which Will Result From Raising The Elbow Above The Drivers Shoulder Height And/Or Allow The Hand Holding The Whip To Reach Behind The Driver During The Use Of The Whip).*

The above ruling was issued after Bertrand appeared and viewed films with the stewards. He agreed his actions violated the rules.

11/12/10 (2) **Wagering Closed Accidentally**

When the horses were dispatched for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Non-wagering Race, the placing judge accidentally locked wagering. The machines were closed for 57 seconds before re-opening. This took place 30 minutes before the first wagering race. No complaints were noted.

11/12/10 (3) **First Race – Inquiry/No Change**

The inquiry sign was posted to review the actions of fifth (5<sup>th</sup>) place finisher, #4 “Vinnys Dance” (Rick Plano), during the running of the 1<sup>st</sup> Race. #4 made several very short breaks before and after the half mile pole. After review it was determined the #4 and Driver Plano complied with the breaking rule. No change.
