01/17/14 (1) **Seventeen Race Card**

Tonight's seventeen (17) race card included two (2) non-wagering races. These two (2) California Sires Stake races have purses of \$10,000 and they both have five (5) participants. These two (2) events started at 4:45PM. Tonight's fifteen (15) race pari-mutuel card commenced at 5:20PM.

01/17/14 (2) **Third Race Inquiry**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign in order to view the actions of original second place finisher #6 "Ali De Vie" (Luke Plano). Race replays indicated that #6 "Ali De Vie" may have 'pulled late' in front of fifth place finisher #2 "Lukie Duke" (Robert Roesch) at the ½ mile pole. #2 "Lukie Duke" was beaten 2 ½ lengths for fourth place. Race replays were inconclusive as to the level of interference that took place. In unanimous decision there was no change in the order of finish.

01/17/14 (3) **Big Driving Night**

Driver Luke Plano had a very good evening. He won seven (7) races on tonight's seventeen (17) race card. His first two (2) wins tonight were in California Sires Stake's races with purses of \$10,000 each.

01/18/14 (1) **Qualifying Races**

Two (2) qualifying races were held prior to the sixteen (16) races held that were held for purse money this evening. Of the ten (10) competitors, nine (9) made the grade.

01/18/14 (2) **First Race Wagering Inquiry**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign after Patrol Judge Bill Vallandingham reported that #1 "Asgoodasioncewas" (Gene Vallandingham) had a flat sulky tire before the ½ mile marker. #1 "Asgoodasioncewas" finished eighth (last) in this event. The stewards viewed race replays and wanted to observe the action of his closest rival in this race; sixth place finisher #2 "Grandpa Stevie" (Mike Jarvis) to see if he caused the flat. Race replays were inconclusive as to the cause of the flat tire and after a unanimous vote the original placings were allowed to stand.

01/18/14 (3) **No Show Wagering**

There was no showing wagering offered in tonight's second race which had six (6) wagering interests. Post time favorite #2 'A Stitch In Time' (Lemoyne Svendsen) went on to win this 'California Sires Stakes' race that had a purse of \$10,000.

01/18/14 (4) **Fourth Race Inquiry**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign following this race in order to review the actions of fourth place finisher #4 "Peaceful Path" (Marc Mosher) and seventh (last) place finisher #2 "Rite After Disbeer" (James Lackey) who made a break with about one hundred (100) yards before the finish. Race replays show the wheel discs of these two (2) rivals become very close while several horses were racing in tight quarters in this race's stretch drive. Race replays were inconclusive as to what caused #2 "Rite After Disbeer" to make the aforementioned break in stride. In a unanimous decision the stewards made no change in the order of finish.

01/18/14 (5) **Thirteenth Race Inquiry**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign after viewing an incident just past the ¼ mile marker. The stewards wanted to review the action of first place finisher #2 "Mighty Fine Hi Ho" (David Siegel) who according to Patrol Bill Vallandingham "may have" pulled late on second place finisher #6 "Eternal Overdrive" (James Lackey) coming out of the first turn. Race replays show these two (2) rivals racing towards the 'back of the pack' in this eight (8) horse field. #6 "Eternal Overdrive" pulls to a three-wide position at which time eventual winner #2 "Mighty Fine Hi Ho" pulls to a two-wide position. The minority vote (Steward

Meyers) felt the actions of #2 “Mighty Fine Hi Ho” cost #6 “Eternal Overdrive” an opportunity for a better placing and warranted a disqualification. The majority was of the opinion that that following film review, speaking to the drivers involved and the patrol judge report that the level of interference was inconclusive and the results should stand as posted. Driver David Siegel was ordered to film review with the stewards.
