Proceedings of the Board of Stewards for the period of Monday, February 24, 2014 through Sunday, March 2, 2014. Steward Grant Baker was the Reporting and Duty Steward for the enclosed period.

The racing office was open today accepting entries for Friday, February 28th. Fourteen (14) races were drawn with one hundred ten (110) horses scheduled to start.

02/24/14 (2) **Dark Day**

02/25/14 (1) **Entry/ Scratch Day**

Scratch time for Friday, February 28th took place today in the racing office. There were twenty four (24) driver selections/ changes and one (1) scratch was also submitted. All changes were activated after the 9:00AM deadline. Fourteen (14) races were filled and drawn for Saturday, March 1st. One hundred seventeen (117) horses are scheduled to start.

The racing office was open today accepting scratches and changes for Saturday, March 1st. There were no scratches. Seventeen (17) driver selections/changes were made. All changes were activated after the 9:00AM deadline.

Newly appointed Executive Director Rick Baedeker introduced himself to this Board of Stewards in the Cal Expo Steward's office. All four (4) of us shared our personal and racing history with each other. A healthy back and forth took place for ninety (90) minutes. Mr. Baedeker gave us a snapshot of his expectations of the Stewards.

02/28/14 (2) **Mike Jarvis Meeting (Ref: 12/19/13 (1))**

Trainer Mike Jarvis appeared in the Stewards office to discuss CHRB Case# 13SW0068 with the Stewards. Trainer Jarvis received a Proposed Decision from the CHRB (Sharyn Jolly) on Tuesday, February 25th. The Cal Expo Stewards will be putting out a ruling in this matter after conferring with Trainer Jarvis today. More to follow.

02/28/14 (3) **Official Changes**

Clerk of the Course, Patty Peterson fills in tonight for Paymaster of Purses, Glen Harris who is off for personal reasons. Alan Renner will replace the aforementioned Glen Harris, who also serves as mutuel manager tonight.

02/28/14 (4) **Sixth Race Inquiry/ Disqualification**

The Stewards posted the inquiry sign following this race in order to view an incident coming out of the first turn (after ¼ mile pole). Original eighth (last) place finisher #7 "Southwind Kean" (Steve Wiseman) made a break in stride at this juncture and the Stewards were looking into reasons for the break. Race replays show original sixth place finisher #3 "Early Boy" (Gene Vallandingham) pop out into a two-wide position at nearly the same time as #7 "Southwind Kean." The majority ruled the actions of #3 "Early Boy" caused interference to #7 "Southland Kean" and forced him to break stride. #3 "Early Boy" was subsequently disqualified and placed eighth (last). The minority (Steward Baker) felt replays were inconclusive. Both drivers were spoken to following this race. Gene Vallandingham was ordered to film review.

02/28/14 (5) **Thirteenth Race Wagering Change**

03/01/14 (1) **Tim Maier Hearing (Case No. 13SW0074)**

An informal hearing was held today in the Stewards office. The CHRB filed a complaint against Trainer Tim Maier for two (2) alleged violations of CHRB Rule #1843 (A) (D) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances), Rule #1844 (Authorized Medication) and Rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse). A blood sample taken on November 15, 2013 (Second race – ‘Show Runner’) allegedly contained high levels of ‘Ketoprofen’ (27.3). A blood sample from Maier trained ‘Cherry Tree Nicole’ (Fourth race – November 23, 2013) showed levels of 52.7 ng/ml. Both of these readings were reported by Dr. Scott Stanley who is the Chief Chemist at the University of California David Equine Analytical Chemistry Laboratory. The authorized level for ‘Ketoprofen’ is 10 nanograms or under. Both of the horses involved in this matter had been treated before Trainer Maier had been informed there was an alleged overage in the ‘November 15, 2013 (‘Show Runner’) test result. This hearing was originally scheduled for yesterday, February 28th. Present today were Trainer Tim Maier, CHRB Veterinarian Clifford Zucco, and CHRB Investigator Carol Nolan who presented a thirty (30) page complaint packet in this matter. Testimony was given and documents entered into evidence. Decision to follow.

03/01/14 (2) **Mike Jarvis Ruling (Ref: 02/28/14 (2))**

RULING #23

TRAINER **MIKE JARVIS**, WHO STARTED THE HORSE “**GLIDING BOHEME**” IN THE FIFTH RACE ON NOVEMBER 2, 2013, AT CAL EXPO CA, IS SUSPENDED FIFTEEN (15) DAYS, FROM SUNDAY MARCH 2, 2014 THROUGH SUNDAY MARCH 16, 2014, AND FINED ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED (\$1,500.00)* DOLLARS PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1887(A) (TRAINER TO INSURE CONDITION OF HORSE) AND RULE #1859.5 (DISQUALIFICATION UPON POSITIVE TEST) FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1843.6 (TOTAL CARBON DIOXIDE TESTING – 38.0 MILLIMOLES PER LITER).

The ruling above is the result of a hearing that was held here at Cal Expo on December 19, 2013. The penalty stated above was recommended by the Cal Expo Board of Stewards and subsequently adopted by the California Horse Racing Board in executive session at their meeting in Arcadia, CA February 21, 2014. This ruling was then remanded back to this office on February 24, 2014.

03/01/14 (3) **Gene Vallandingham Film Review (Ref: 02/28/13 (4))**

Driver Gene Vallandingham appeared in the Stewards office to review his drive in last evening’s (February 28) sixth race. Vallandingham was aboard #3 “Early Boy” who was disqualified and placed eighth (last) for interference to #7 “Southwind Kean” (Steve Wiseman) for interference entering the backstretch. Driver Vallandingham was given a warning in this matter.

03/01/14 (4) **Track Condition**

The track rating for tonight’s entire fourteen (14) race card was ‘fast.’

03/01/14 (5) **Fifth Race Inquiry**

The Stewards posted the inquiry sign after viewing sixth place finisher #5 “Silverlode” (Steve Desomer) switch from a trotting gait to a pacing gait in the stretch. Following this break in stride it was determined #5 “Silverlode” complied with CHRB Rule #1722 (Breaking) and the Stewards let the results stand as originally posted. No change.

03/01/14 (6) **Eighth Race Inquiry**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign in order to review the actions of fourth place finisher #1 “Hollywood Star” (Lemoyne Svendsen) just past the ¾ mile marker. After film review it was determined #1 “Hollywood Star” was only ‘rough gaited’ and he was not carded with a break.

03/01/14 (7) **Eleventh Race Accidents/ Inquiry/ Disqualification**

The Stewards posted the inquiry sign in order to review an accident as the field was entering the stretch. There was also a separate accident following the running of this race. While racing in fourth position coming out of the final turn and entering the stretch, eventual first place finisher #6 “Larry Horse” (Gerald Longo) shifts outward. At this juncture the front leg of #1 “Fox Valley Largo” strikes the

sulky wheel of #6 “Larry Horse.” This incident caused three (3) drivers to be dislodged from their horses. They were Patrick Galbraith (#1 Fox Valley Largo), Paul Welence (#8 Hi Ho Legacy) and Lemoyne Svendsen (#9 Hi Ho Hi Ho). Driver Welence was launched into the air and landed hard on the racing surface. His mount, #8 “Hi Ho Legacy”, was the only horse to make strike the ground and he was vanned off after the first accident. On track human ambulance personnel attended to injured drivers. Additional ambulances arrived on the track shortly after.

In another accident a driverless #1 “Fox Valley Largo” ran into the sulky of original fifth place finisher #4 “Asgoodasioncewas” (Gene Vallandingham). This occurred past the finish line entering the clubhouse turn. Driver Vallandingham laid motionless on the track for a period of time following this incident. For interference to three (3) rivals entering the stretch #6 “Larry Horse” was disqualified and placed unplaced. This decision was unanimous. Driver Gerald Longo was order to film review with the Stewards. Accident reports are attached to these minutes.

In addition to the distribution described above, a copy of each report shall be attached to the stewards' minutes in accordance with Rule 1536, Stewards' Minutes.

As the field was pulling up at the conclusion of the eleventh race #1 "Fox Valley Largo", who had been involved in the accident at the head of the stretch, and who was running loose on the racing surface struck Driver Gene Vallandingham #4 "Asgoodasioncewas" from behind unseating him.

Jockey/Driver condition: Transported by ambulance to U.C. Davis. Bruises and contusions plus a concussion. Prognosis good.

Horse condition: Uninjured
