Proceedings of the Board of Stewards for the period of Monday, February 15, 2016 through Sunday, February 21, 2016. Steward Jim Arlt was the Reporting and Duty Steward for the enclosed period.

02/15/16 (1) **Dark Day**

02/16/16 (1) **Entries and Draw**

The racing office was open for the taking of entries for Saturday, February 20th and Sunday, February 21st, 2016.

The draw for Saturday's card resulted in ninety one (91) horses drawn into twelve (12) races. There were no California bred races scheduled.

02/16/16 (2) **Request for Change of Trainer**

Upon arrival Steward Arlt received a Request for change of Trainer form purported to have been signed by Trainer Nathalie Tremblay and Trainer Frank Petrelli on February 15th. This request for the change of Trainer would be for Young American and Quantum Uptown Boy which had just recently been approved for a change of Trainer from Trainer Marissa Tyler to Trainer Tremblay after Trainer Tyler's Summary Suspension for Cobalt positives. This request for a Change of Trainer was denied unanimously by the Full Board of Stewards on this date pursuant to California Rule 1843.3 (i) and (j). It should be noted that Trainer Petrelli has been advised more than once that the CHRB Rule 1843.3 (i) and (j) precludes his becoming the Trainer for all horses previously assigned to his Stepdaughter Trainer Marissa Tyler during her suspension.

02/16/16 (3) **Cobalt Disqualification Hearings**

At 1pm Steward Oke, Steward Sheward, and Steward Arlt convened in the Steward's office to conduct a Disqualification Hearing under CHRB Rule 1859.5

that was recorded by Frazier Reporting. This Disqualification Hearing pertained to five (5) different reports of a Positive Test Finding for horses trained by Marissa Tyler that were all at a high enough level to be classified as Class 3. Besides the Panel of Stewards listed above, and Ms. Frazier, this hearing was attended by CHRB Staff Attorney Phil Laird, CHRB Investigator Carol Nolan, CHRB Safety Steward Tom McCarthy, Trainer Marissa Tyler and Trainer Frank Petrelli. Trainer Tyler had requested that her stepfather, Trainer Petrelli, attend the meeting with her and assist in representing her.

At the beginning of the hearing Trainer Tyler and Trainer Petrelli wanted it placed on the record that they objected to this hearing occurring on this date. Trainer Tyler and Trainer Petrelli did state that an attorney had not been retained yet by Trainer Tyler. CHRB Staff Attorney Phil Laird presented the CHRB case in this matter and presented information to the Stewards that this hearing should proceed as CHRB Rule# 1859.5 only requires that there is an official test sample taken from a horse participating in any race which contained a prohibited drug substance which is determined to be in class levels one (1), three (3) and that the disqualification shall occur regardless of culpability. The Stewards unanimously decided that the hearing should proceed.

CHRB Attorney Laird introduced items of evidence pertaining to Case #16SW0001, #16SW0003, #16SW0006, #16SW0007, and #16SW0008.

Packet items of evidence were received, accepted and given item numbers by the Stewards over the noted objections of Trainer Tyler and Trainer Petrelli. The Complaint for Case#:16SW0008 was moved by CHRB attorney Laird to be amended to reflect a total Cobalt amount of 294 ng/ml instead of the 80.1 ng/ml listed originally on this complaint. This amendment was approved by the Board of Stewards.

After receiving the items of evidence and testimony from Investigator Nolan, and the noted objections of the Trainer Tyler and Trainer Petrelli, the Stewards closed this hearing.

This matter will be discussed by the Board of Stewards and a decision will be forthcoming.

02/16/16 (4) **Trainer Tyler Request for a Stay of the Board of Stewards Ruling #20**

The Board of Stewards was advised by CHRB Staff Attorney Phil Laird that Ms. Tyler had requested a Stay of Ruling #20's requirement that Ms. Tyler vacate all stalls assigned to her, and removal of all equipment and horses that were still designated with her as Trainer by February 17th at 5pm. The stay requested that this ruling to vacate the grounds be extended to February 23rd. The CHRB Cal Expo Board of Stewards did review this possible delay. By majority vote the Board of Stewards elected to stay with the original date of February 17th. Steward Oke voted to allow the date postponement to February 23rd as requested by Trainer Tyler.

Succarotte Hearing

The Board of Stewards at Watch and Wager LLC-Cal Expo conducted a hearing in the Stewards office at Cal Expo at 1pm. This hearing was requested by the California Horse Racing Board for the purpose of hearing a complaint that Driver Succarotte had submitted someone else's urine sample for drug testing as part of his yearly physical requirements. This hearing was transcribed by a court reporter.

The State of California Horse Racing Board was represented by Staff Attorney Phillip Laird and Investigator Duane Tadlock. Investigator Tadlock presented the following items to the Board of Stewards:

- (1) Investigator Carol Nolan's report documenting the incident.
- (2) Investigator Tadlock's follow-up report.
- (3) Quest Diagnostic lab reports.

Driver Succarotte accepted responsibility for his actions. The Board of Stewards closed the hearing and a decision will be forthcoming.

- 02/20/16 (1) **Driver Changes**
Because of a family illness Driver Siegel was unable to fulfill five (5) drives this date but he was replaced by other drivers from the driver colony.
- 02/20/16 (2) **Qualifying Races**
Three (3) qualifying races were held that were scheduled to start at 5:10PM. Twelve (12) of sixteen (16) qualified.
- 02/20/16 (3) **First Race/ Disqualification**
An Inquiry was called after the First race to review an incident of possible interference at the top of the stretch. The Stewards reviewed the film of this incident and unanimously decided that Williams Hernandez, driving #3 “LAISSEZMOIPICOLER”, had pulled out late causing interference with #7 “SOUNION” (Tony Succarotte). The #3 “LAISSEZMOIPICOLER” was disqualified and placed from sixth to seventh. Driver Hernandez was called in for film review on February 21st.

- 02/20/16 (4) **Possible Whipping Violation**
In the first race Driver Clevenger was driving #5 “WHATCHAMACALLUM.” Driver Clevenger was called in for film review on February 21st for violating the whipping rule. More to follow.
- 02/20/16 (5) **Inside Pylons Warning**
In the second race Driver Steve Nichols drove #6 “LUST” inside the one of the pylons at the top of the stretch. The #6 “LUST” placed sixth (last) in this race so no advantage was gained and Driver Nichols was warned for driving inside the pylons.
- 02/20/16 (6) **Driver Succarotte Safety Vest Violation**
On February 14th Driver Anthony Succarotte was programmed to drive #4 “HOTEL MOTEL” and went out on the race track without a safety vest. As such Ruling #22 was issued which states:

- DRIVER ANTHONY SUCCAROTTE, WHO WAS PROGRAMMED TO DRIVE #4 “HOTEL MOTEL” IN THE SEVENTH RACE ON FEBRUARY 14, 2016, IS HEREBY FINED THE SUM OF TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00)* DOLLARS FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1689.1 (B) (SAFETY VEST REQUIRED).
- ENTERED THE TRACK FOR THE POST PARADE WITHOUT A SAFETY VEST.
- 02/20/16 (7) **Driver Girard**
Ruling #23 was issued to Driver Pierre Girard for violating the Watch and Wager LLC House whipping rule which states:

RULING #23

DRIVER **PIERRE GIRARD**, WHO DROVE #9 “**LODI DORIAN BLUES**” IN THE NINTH RACE ON SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 14, 2016 IS HEREBY FINED THE SUM OF ONE HUNDRED (**\$100.00**)* DOLLARS FOR VIOLATION OF WATCH AND WAGER LLC HOUSE WHIPPING RULE (DRIVERS MAY NOT USE THE WHIP MORE THAN THREE (3) TIMES IN SUCCESSION WITHOUT GIVING THE HORSE A CHANCE TO RESPOND) AND CHRB RULE #**1530** (CASES NOT COVERED). FIRST OFFENSE IN THE LAST SIXTY (60) DAYS.

An Inquiry was called after the First race to review an incident in the backstretch. The Stewards reviewed the film of this incident and unanimously decided that Williams Hernandez, driving #2 "DELTA BREEZEOFLODI", had run up on #1 "MANLEY STANLEY" (Tim Clevenger). The incident caused an interference break to #8 "GET ZIGGY" (Luke Plano). The Stewards unanimously decided that the #2 "DELTA BREEZEOFLODI" which originally finished fifth be disqualified and placed eighth.

Driver Mike Jarvis who drove #7 "CAPITOL HILL" the eighth race second place finisher was summoned for film review for a possible violation of having his foot out of the stirrup. More to follow.

02/21/16 (7) **Eleventh Race/Inquiry/No Change**

An inquiry was called to review possible interference at the top of the stretch to see if the #4 "DICKIES MOTEL" (Frank Petrelli) pulled out late causing interference with the #6 "RAG DOLL" (James Lackey). Driver Lackey denied being interfered with and the film review was inconclusive. The Stewards unanimously decided no change was warranted.
