The race office was open this morning accepting entries for qualifying races to be contested this evening. The resultant qualifying sheet showed nineteen (19) head competing in three (3) qualifying events commencing at 4:45 pm. Fifteen (15) of nineteen (19) were successful in there qualifying effort.

Mark Kennedy was issued the following ruling,

RULING # 06

DRIVER **MARK KENNEDY**, HAVING ATTENDED AN INFORMAL HEARING IN THE CAL EXPO STEWARDS OFFICE IS HEREBY PLACED ON PROBATION FOR THE DURATION OF HIS LICENSE.

ADDITIONALLY, LICENSEE **KENNEDY** MUST MEET WITH THE BOARD OF STEWARDS PRIOR TO APPLYING FOR A RENEWAL OF HIS LICENSE.

11/26/16 (2) **Off Track**

Tonight's card was contested over a track rated "sloppy" a situation created by the day long showers in the area. A time differential of two (2) seconds was allowed and noted for the complete card.

11/26/16 (3) **Sixth Race / Driver to Film Review**

At the conclusion of the sixth race the Stewards contacted Driver Sean SmithPeters #3 "Cosmos" who finished in sixth place. At issue is a possible violation of the Cal Expo Watch & Wager whipping rule. More to follow.

11/26/16 (4) **Eighth Race/ Inquiry/ Disqualification**

At the conclusion of the eighth race the inquiry sign was lit in order to review the actions of fourth place finisher #5 "Rhi's Western Star" (Steve Wiseman) for violation of pylon rule #1721 - raced inside two (2) pylons before the ¾ mile marker resulting in a disqualification.
