DRIVER ANTHONY SUCCAROTTE, WHO DROVE #4 “MOONSHINEMONKEYS” IN THE EIGHTH RACE ON FRIDAY FEBRUARY 3, 2018 IS HEREBY FINED THE SUM OF ONE HUNDRED (\$100.00)\* DOLLARS FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1734 (d) (WHIPPING – DRIVERS MAY NOT USE THE WHIP MORE THAN THREE (3) TIMES IN A SUCCESSION WITHOUT GIVING THE HORSE A CHANCE TO RESPOND). FIRST OFFENSE IN THE LAST SIXTY (60) DAYS.

unanimously agreed there was interference. 'RICHELLU COWBOY' finished fifth and was disqualified and placed sixth.
