- 04/27/18 (1) **Qualifying Races**
 Entries were taken this morning for the qualifiers to be held prior to the regularly scheduled races on Saturday with one (1) race scheduled at 6:15PM. Six (6) of the seven (7) participants met the qualifying standards.

After review of the video replay and examination of the photo finish, it was determined that the horse was on a break at the wire and lapped on by two (2) horses. “SHARK FESTIVAL” finished third and was placed fifth.
