07-12-19<sup>1</sup> **DAVID MARTIN - RULING NO.01**

Jockey **DAVID MARTIN** is hereby fined the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Agreement) on July 7, 2019 in the fifth race at the Alameda County Fair.

The preceding ruling was issued after Mr. Martin met with the Stewards and failed to offer a valid reason for failing to fulfill his riding commitment.

07-12-19<sup>2</sup> **JAMES P. HOWARD, D.V.M – VISIT**

Veterinary Medical Board of California, Board Inspector James Howard D.V.M., met with the Stewards to introduce himself and inform us of his assignment to monitor racing activities for the current meeting.

07-12-19<sup>4</sup> **NO SHOW WAGERING – 2<sup>ND</sup> RACE**

The scratch of #2 TWICE AS WINDY in the second race reduced the field to four wagering interests. In accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1954 (Pari-Mutuel Pools) show wagering was cancelled.

07-12-19<sup>5</sup> **AFTERNOON RACING PROGRAM**

The eight races on the program progressed smoothly without incident.

07-12-19<sup>6</sup> **VOIDED CLAIM – EIGHTH RACE**

A claim deposited by trainer Marcia Stortz for #4 TITO'S SODA was deemed void by the Stewards after Official Veterinarian Forrest Franklin D.V.M. reported the horse was lame on the left front and would be entered on the Vet's List. TITO'S SODA was returned to the barn of J.B. Josephson.

**Saturday**07-13-19<sup>1</sup> **FILMS – JOCKEY WARNING**

Jockey William Antongeorgi III was called in and given a warning regarding his actions yesterday near the 1/16<sup>th</sup> marker in the fifth race. The recordings show he allows his mount to drift out several paths while under a left-hand cropping. Mr. Antongeorgi's action did not warrant a sanction, however he was cautioned to make a better effort in

the future.

07-13-19<sup>2</sup> **ACCIDENT – INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION – THIRD RACE**

Following the running of the third race the Inquiry sign was posted to review two separate incidents.

The first incident took place at the break when #3 PARK HILL DIAMOND (Ricardo Gonzalez) stumbled and unseated his rider. No other horses were involved. Mr. Gonzalez was taken to First Aid, evaluated by the track physician and cleared to ride his remaining mount.

The second incident happened in the stretch involving #4 MORTON GLORY (Kyle Frey) first and #5 BOMBAY ALL DAY (William Antongeorgi) second. After interviewing the riders involved, and reviewing the video, the Stewards unanimously decided to disqualify #4 MORTON GLORY from first to second. The video shows #4 MORTON GLORY bears out nearing the 1/16<sup>th</sup> marker, bumps and impeded #5 BOMBAY ALL DAY preventing the latter a chance of a better placing.

07-14-19<sup>1</sup> **JESUS ARRIAGA – RULING NO.02**

Jockey **JESUS ARRIAGA** who rode **GOODUNDERTHEHOOD** in the first race at the California State Fair on Saturday, July 13, 2019 is hereby fined the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (use of Riding Crop – used more than three times without giving the horse a chance to respond [third offense in the past sixty days]).

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Arriaga phoned the Stewards and acknowledged using the crop more than three times without giving his mount the opportunity to respond.

07-14-19<sup>2</sup> **SEAN MARCY – RULING NO.03**

Jockey **SEAN MARCY** who rode **IMAGE OF TOMAHAWK** in the first race at the California State Fair on Saturday, July 13, 2019 is hereby fined the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (use of Riding Crop – used more than three times without giving the

horse a chance to respond).

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Marcy met with the Stewards and reviewed the video of the first race from July 13, 2019. Mr. Marcy offered no argument to his violation of the crop rule and accepted the penalty imposed.

07-14-19<sup>3</sup> **KYLE FREY – RULING NO.04**

Jockey **KYLE FREY** who rode **MORTON GLORY** in the third race at the California State Fair on Saturday, July 13, 2019 is suspended five (5) racing days (July 21, 25, 26, 27 & 28, 2019) for failure to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from first to second; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (c) & (e) (Riding Rules – Careless Riding [second offense in the past sixty days]).

The preceding ruling was issued after Mr. Frey met with the Stewards and acknowledged failing to correct his mount in a timely manner.

07-14-19<sup>4</sup> **FILM REVIEW**

Jockey Silvio Amador and the Stewards reviewed the video of the sixth race from July 13, 2019. Mr. Amador’s mount was drifting out in the stretch although no rivals were inconvenienced. Mr. Amador was warned a better effort is expected to maintain a straight course.

07-14-19<sup>5</sup> **LATE RIDER CHANGE – FIRST RACE**

A replacement rider was named on #3 AURA MAKARINA (Tr. A. Borg) after jockey L. Godoy was unable to get within the maximum overweight of seven pounds.

07-14-19<sup>6</sup> **STEWARDS REVIEW – FOURTH RACE**

The Stewards conducted a review of the start of the fourth race for the benefit of the wagering public. #3 KNOW PEPPER (Tr. B. Dillenbeck) turned her head as the starting gate doors opened and was off to a poor start. In a unanimous decision #3 KNOW PEPPER was considered a starter and the race was made official.
