**LOGMAN VISIT**

Visiting Del Mar today was Governor Gavin Newsom's appointed Deputy Cabinet Secretary Sonya Logman. Ms. Logman has served as Deputy Secretary of Business and Consumer Relations at the California Business, Consumer Services and Housing Agency (BCSH) since 2015. BCSH is charged with overseeing eleven state departments comprised of over 5,500 state employees and \$2.3 billion dollars in annual expenditures. Deputy Secretary Logman works closely with those Departments that administer programs to license more than 250 types of professionals, the alcohol beverage industry, horse racing wagering facilities and the evolving California cannabis industry.

Ms. Logman was given a tour of the morning and afternoon racing operations. She met with the Stewards and discussed their duties. DMTC President Josh Rubinstein later escorted her to the Stewards' stand to view a race and questions were asked and answered.

**DEPALMA HEARING CASE 19DM0008**

The CHRB filed a financial complaint (1876) on behalf of trainer Jorge Periban against owner Ms. Rene DePalma in the amount of \$1,565.00 for training services. Prior to the hearing Mr. Periban informed the Stewards he had received a \$795.00 payment on the bill in question this reduced the total to \$770.00. Ms. DePalma questioned the charge on the bill for twenty days of post op care given to the horse after surgery. After much deliberation the BOS deducted three days of after care and informed her she had ten days to pay the remainder owed (\$650.00). This decision will be issued in ruling form tomorrow.

**SISE FORMAL HEARING CASE 19SA0144**

A complaint was filed by the CHRB against trainer Clifford Sise Jr. for violation of CHRB rules 1843 (a)(d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances), 1843.1 (b) (Prohibited Drug Substances), 1844 (f)(9) (Authorized Medication) and 1887 (a) (Trainer or Owner to Insure Condition of Horse).

Present for the hearing before the BOS were, Clifford Sise Jr., representing the CHRB Investigator Phil Miyazaki and recording the proceedings court reporter Michelle Derieg. The Sise trainee Hot Decision who raced on March 29, 2019 in the eighth race at Santa Anita and finished first tested positive for the drug methocarbamol. This is a class 4 category C penalty drug.

Mr. Sise testified the administration of the drug given to the horse in question was terminated five days prior to race day. He also stated the overage was confusing as the horse was given half of the normal prescribed dose of this medication. Decision to follow
