Report of the Board of Stewards for the week of Tuesday September 1, 2009 through Wednesday September 9, 2009.

TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 1, 2009

1 **KORINER COMPLAINT**

Trainer BRIAN KORINER contacted the stewards by telephone to answer case number 09DM081 which involved a complaint initiated by the Official Veterinarian for being late to the receiving barn with one of his horses. Mr. Koriner had not previously been sanctioned for this type of infraction; therefore the stewards issued a warning.

2 **HARTMAN COMPLAINT**

Trainer CHRIS HARTMAN contacted the stewards by telephone to discuss case number 09DM079 which alleged that one of his horses had been late to the receiving barn. While Mr. Hartman was fined previously for the same infraction, those rulings were issued four years ago. Mr. Hartman was therefore warned with respect to the current violation.

3 **CHEW WARNING**

Trainer MATT CHEW contacted the stewards by telephone in advance of his hearing for an alleged bute overage involving his horse "Deceptively" during the running of the fourth race on August 6, 2009 at Del Mar. The horse finished first and the complaint was filed as case number 09DM089. While Mr. Chew did not really have an explanation (the level was low), fortunately the penalty guidelines allow a warning in this case because Mr. Chew has no medication violations in the last three years.

WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 2, 2009

1 NTRA SAFETY CERTIFICATION

Big Event coordinator PETE LANG met with the stewards as a representative of the NTRA to interview us regarding backside safety and security at Del Mar. As part of the safety certification process, Mr. Lang prepares a report with recommendations with respect to how to improve backside safety and security. He asked the stewards for our opinions in this area.

2 FILM REVIEW

Apprentice jockey CHRISTAIN SANITAGO REYES met with the stewards to discuss his ride in the third race Sunday. The stewards cautioned him to make less drastic moves when securing position in a race. We also discussed Mr. Reyes' habit of taking horses behind the gate to be resaddled. Originally brought to our attention by the starter, we asked Mr. Reyes to talk to his valets and explain how he wants his horses saddled in order to decrease the need to make changes on the track.

3 O'NEILL WARNING

Trainer DOUG O'NEILL contacted the stewards by telephone to discuss case number 09DM082 which involved a late to the receiving barn complaint. Mr. O'Neill was issued a warning because it was his first infraction of this nature.

THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 3, 2009

1 LOPEZ RULING

Trainer JASON LOPEZ was suspended for failure to appear at a hearing based on a complaint filed by the CHRB alleging violation of CHRB rule 1876 (Financial Responsibility) and rule 1877 (Checks). The complaint alleged that Mr. Lopez owes JC Feed & Supply \$574.18 and Carter’s Hay and Grain \$322.00. (Mr. Lopez also owes exercise rider Salvador Paez \$600.00 from a previously adjudicated case that resulted in a financial agreement). The following ruling was published:

DMTD Ruling #64

Trainer Jason Lopez, having failed to appear before the Board of Stewards to answer a complaint alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule # 1876 (Financial Responsibility), and # 1877 (Checks), is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule # 1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of Jason Lopez are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule # 1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to fine or suspend), Mr. Lopez is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

2 GONZALEZ HEARING AND RULING

Trainer SALVADOR GONZALEZ met with the stewards this morning in an informal hearing to discuss case number 09DM108 which involved an alleged bute overage after one of his horses worked for removal from the Veterinarian’s list. Mr. Gonzalez explained that his barn staff had inadvertently treated the horse twice. The following ruling was published:

DMTD Ruling #65

Trainer Sal Gonzalez, who worked the horse Monica CC on August 23, 2009 for removal from the Veterinarian’s List, is fined ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS * (\$1,000.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse), #1844 (C), (1) (Authorized Medication – Phenylbutazone, in excess of permitted level - 29.81 UG), and rule #1866 (Veterinarian’s List).

3 TATCH RULING

Owner MARK TATCH was reinstated as a result of his appearance before the Board of Stewards. The original hearing, alleging disorderly conduct, has been reset for Fairplex.

DMTD Ruling #66

Having appeared before the Board of Stewards at Del Mar Thoroughbred Club, the license of Owner Mark Tatch is reinstated to good standing. Ruling # 33, issued at Del Mar Thoroughbred Club is set aside.

4 STUTE WARNING

Trainer GARY STUTE contacted the stewards by telephone to discuss case number 09DM080 which involved a late to the receiving barn complaint. He was issued a warning, as it was his first infraction.

FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 4, 2009

1 FILM REVIEW

Jockey OMAR BERRIO met with the stewards this afternoon to discuss his ride in the eighth yesterday in which we noted that Mr. Berrio was rather aggressive with his whip despite the fact that he was well beaten. Mr. Berrio, after watching the film, did not really offer an excuse but apologized for his actions and assured us that it would not happen again. The majority believed that a warning should be issued whereas Steward Chaney voted for a three hundred dollar fine.

Jockey MARTIN PEDROZA met with the stewards this afternoon regarding his ride in the fourth race yesterday in which we noticed that he might have stood up on his mount prematurely. Mr. Pedroza explained that his mount was getting very tired and that he didn't want to abuse her. While it is clear from the films that the horse is getting tired, we explained that while hitting or even hand riding a horse might not have been the prudent thing to do in this case, Mr. Pedroza should not have stood up before the wire. He agreed and accepted a warning.

2 SANCHEZ HEARING

The stewards contacted trainer HECTOR SANCHEZ regarding the fact that his horse was a no show in the receiving barn in the last race yesterday, necessitating a late scratch. Mr. Sanchez explained that he told his groom that the horse was running in the last who incorrectly believed that there were nine races. The following ruling was issued, which is the standard penalty, but there was some discussion that this fine needs to be increased in the future—possibly at the beginning of the Oak Tree meeting:

DMTD Ruling #67

Hector Sanchez, the trainer of the horse El Mirage Ranger which was entered in the eighth race at Del Mar on September 3, 2009, is fined three hundred dollars * (\$300.00) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule # 1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration – failure to arrive at Receiving Barn).

3 MEDINA REINSTATEMENT

Former trainer SANTIAGO MEDINA contacted the stewards in an effort to have his license restored. He had been suspended for failure to pay San Luis Rey Downs stall rental fees. Mr. Medina has since entered into a financial agreement with SLR, with which they were satisfied; therefore the following ruling was issued:

DMTD Ruling #68

Having entered into a financial agreement with the San Luis Rey Downs Thoroughbred Training Center, the California Horse Racing Board license of trainer Santiago Medina is reinstated. The ruling of suspension of license issued at Oak Tree on October 21, 2007 is set aside.

SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 5, 2009

1 VARGAS HEARING

Exercise rider EDWIN VARGAS agreed to an informal hearing to answer a complaint (case number 09DM098) filed by the CHRB alleging that he violated CHRB rule #1902.5 (Animal Welfare) by striking his mount in the head with his fist during training hours. Mr. Vargas explained that he had been schooling the dangerous horse in this way and had done the same thing several days in a row. Trainer Jim Cassidy provided evidence regarding the action and believed that it in no way constituted teaching a horse to behave in a better way. Ruling to follow.

2 BEJARANO AND AGENT MEETING

The stewards met with Rafael Bejarano and his agent who wanted to take off all of his mounts today except for the stake races. Mr. Bejarano re-injured a thumb while riding yesterday, got a doctor's clearance that recommended riding only a few races. We explained that our policy is that if you take one mount off, you must take all of them off. To wit, a rider cannot pick and choose what horses to ride during a card. Both agreed that given the policy, Mr. Bejarano would take off all of his mounts today.

3 JOCKEY APPEAL HEARINGS

Stewards Tom Ward and Scott Chaney participated in two jockey appeals of suspensions issued at the meeting. Michael Baze and Christian Santiago Reyes both appealed stewards' rulings, which were heard by Hearing Officer Stephan Imhoff.

MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 7, 2009

1 FILM REVIEW

Jockey BRICE BLANC met with the stewards regarding his ride in the seventh race yesterday in which we felt that he was a little slow in correcting his mount leaving the starting gate. Mr. Blanc explained that the horse initially broke straight and then surprised him with a quick right hand turn. He said that although he could have responded a little faster, but under the circumstances, he believed that his job was satisfactory. We explained that he needed to make a faster effort in the future.

2 VARGAS RULING

After considering the evidence against exercise rider EDWIN VARGAS, who struck his horse with a fist, the following ruling was issued:

DMTD Ruling #69

Exercise Rider Edwin DeJesus Vargas is fined five hundred dollars * (\$500.00) for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule # 1902.5 (Animal Welfare – Striking a horse in the head with his fist). Further, the license of Edwin DeJesus Vargas is placed upon probation through term.

3 ERRONEOUS SCRATCH

This morning, the stewards were informed at approximately 11:10 am that a horse had been erroneously scratched from today's card. Racetrack veterinarian Dr. Barrie Grant looked at two horses for trainer David LaCroix this morning. #13 Amore Di Aleya (race 10) was determined to be unsound whereas #5 Summers At Delmar (race 7) was determined to be racing sound. Unfortunately, Dr. Grant called the receiving barn and erroneously recommended scratching #5 Summers At Delmar (race 7). This information was transmitted to the stewards who called out the scratch. Later in the morning, Dr. Grant discovered the error and called the stewards. The horse had been out of the wagering pools for about an hour and fifteen minutes when we learned of the problem. We consulted with the mutuel department about the amount of wagering that had taken place both for the fifth race and on a large pick six carryover in which both horses were involved. We also consulted both veterinarians, Mr. LaCroix, as well as Del Mar management. Given that the horse had been out for about an hour and fifteen minutes, that a significant amount of wagering had already taken place and that management in consultation with their mutuel manager had described trying to put the horse back in the mutuel pools as a "nightmare," the majority decided not to disturb the erroneous scratch (Steward Ward voting to put the horse back in the wagering pools). Clearly, there were two bad options in this case and would have been obviated with a rule in California that allows horses to run for purse money only. To date, this idea has not had much support with the stewards' committee or the commission.

4 STABLE AREA VIOLATIONS

DMTD Rulings #70-78 were for routine stable area violations that have already been paid.

5 IVORY WARNING

Trainer JOHN IVORY was given a warning regarding case number 09DM091 which alleged that one of his trainees was late to the receiving barn here at Del Mar.

6 HARRINGTON WARNING AND RULING

Trainer MIKE HARRINGTON came into the office this morning in advance of his hearing at Del Mar on his own behalf and on behalf of his wife, Patricia Harrington, regarding late to the receiving barn

complaints filed by the CHRB. Ms. Harrington was given a warning as it was her first infraction, however Mr. Harrington was fined in the following ruling as it was not his first infraction of this nature:

DMTD Ruling #79

Mike Harrington, the trainer of the horse Seattle Ruler which ran in the 7th race on August 29, 2009, is fined one hundred dollars * (\$100.00) for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rules #1852 (Reporting to the Receiving Barn – Late) and #1894 (Duties of Trainer).

Racetrack veterinarian BARRIE GRANT met with the stewards regarding the erroneous scratch referenced yesterday. Dr. Grant waived ten day hearing notice as well as a formal hearing and took full responsibility for the mistake. The following ruling was issued:

DMTD Ruling #80

Veterinarian Barrie Grant, DV M is fined five hundred dollars * (\$500.00) for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule # 1561 (Duties of the Racing Veterinarian – Recommending the scratching of the incorrect horse during pre-race examination).

2 **MORA REINSTATEMENT**

Having reached a financial settlement between trainer Steve Miyadi and Bliss Canyon Investments, owner Jose Mora's license was reinstated in the following ruling:

DMTD Ruling #81

Having entered into a financial agreement, reference California Horse Racing Board Case #09GG0276, the license of JOSE MECADO MORA is reinstated.

3 **DAVID FLORES OBJECTION**

Following the running of the tenth race, the stewards posted the objection sign at the request of David Flores, who rode second place finisher #10 Collalto. Mr. Flores claimed foul against the winner, #6 Pat's Legacy ridden by Agapito Delgadillo, for drifting out during the stretch. After reviewing the films and speaking with the riders and patrol judges, the stewards unanimously voted to make no change to the original order of finish because the alleged drift was minor in nature.
