SUNDAY

07/31/11¹ **CLAIM VOIDED**

Sunday morning it was brought to the BOS' attention that trainer Jeff Metz filed three claims in yesterday's tenth race. The # 8 "Lordgivemealift" (Tr. M. Mitchell, owner Tommy Hutton's Dream Stable, LLC) was claimed with Drew Fulmer listed as trainer for owner Bam Racing LLC. The owner of Bam Racing, Mr. Blyth Myers, signed the claim card. Mr. Metz had two claims in for the # 2 horse with two separate owner interests and listed himself as trainer. About one hour after the race Drew Fulmer, who also trains for Tommy Hutton in Arizona, contacted Jeff Metz and informed him of the problem. At this point, Mr. Metz returned the horse to Mike Mitchell's barn around 9:00 PM Saturday night. Jeff Metz met with the BOS Sunday morning and admitted he had filed the three claims for himself using Drew Fulmer as trainer for # 8 "Lordgivemealift". After all parties involved, including paymaster Bridgett Crawford and Steward's Aid Lucy Vaillancourt were interviewed, the following ruling was issued:

DMTD #014

The claim of the horse "LORDGIVEMEALIFT" from the tenth race at Del Mar Thoroughbred Club on July 30, 2011, is rescinded in accordance with California Horse Racing Board rules #1652 (g)(Prohibited Actions with Respect to Claims-file more than two claims) and #1665 (Recission of Claim) and the horse is ordered returned to the former owner, Tommy Hutton's Dream Stable, LLC.

07/31/11² **FILM REVIEW (ref. 07/30/11⁶)**

Jockey Edwin Maldonado met with the Stewards to review the disqualification of his mount in the fifth race yesterday. His horse drifted out, herding a horse to his outside. It was the Stewards' opinion that Mr. Maldonado made some effort to adjust and his fatigued horse was held partially culpable, therefore he was not penalized.

07/31/11³ **SUTHERLAND RULING**

DMTD #015

Jockey **CHANTAL SUTHERLAND** is fined **TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)*** for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations) for failure to review video when ordered to do so.

This ruling was issued after Ms. Sutherland was informed of the penalty.

07/31/11⁴ **SUTHERLAND RULING**

DMTD # 016

Jockey **CHANTAL SUTHERLAND** is suspended for **THREE RACING DAYS** (August 5, 6 and 7, 2011) for failure to make the proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch, causing interference while riding "Little Unusual" in the third race at Del Mar Thoroughbred Club on July 29, 2011. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules-careless riding). Term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races).

This ruling was issued after Ms. Sutherland met with the BOS to review the third race on Friday (1 mile turf). In mid stretch her mount drifted out under a left-handed whip; when she quit hitting, the drift stopped. Ms. Sutherland hit her horse left handed a second time and the drift continued affecting again three horses to her outside. Ms. Sutherland was very candid admitting she had made a poor decision to use the stick on the left side a second time.

07/31/11⁵ **KORINER HEARING CASE #11DM0003**

A financial complaint (CHRB rule 1876 (Financial Responsibility)) was filed by Chuck Erb Horse Transportation against trainer Brian Koriner in the amount of \$ 314.48. This case was signed off after Mr. Kornier paid the amount due in full.

07/31/11⁶ **RUDD RULING**

DMTD #017

Exercise rider **JEFFREY RUDD**, having appeared as ordered, is restored to good standing. Ruling DMTD #007, issued at Del Mar Thoroughbred Club on July 31, 2010, is set aside with the provision that Mr. Rudd sign a testing agreement with the California Horse Racing Board.

This ruling was issued after Jeffery Rudd appeared with Winners' Foundation representative Bob Fletcher and it was verified that Mr. Rudd had complied with all requirements to make his license valid. Mr. Rudd stated he is taking a bus to New York on Tuesday with hopes of acquiring a job working with horses. He was tested and the results were negative (ref. 07/30/11⁵).

07/31/11⁷ **REYES WARNING**

Jockey Christian Santiago Reyes was given a warning for failing to get permission to be late to the jockey quarters yesterday. He had been in the Steward's office earlier but had forgotten to ask at that time. He was told next time he will be penalized.

07/31/11⁸ **INQUIRY FIRST RACE (5 ½ Furlongs-Polytrack)/NO CHANGE**

The inquiry sign was posted to review an incident that occurred near the 1/16 pole. Involved were # 4 "Vicki Victoria" (2nd R. Bejarano) and #6 "Warren's Mo Money" (4th J. Talamo). In a four horse spread, # 4 was inside, next out was # 6 and the two horses to their outside, (# 5 (1st) # 1 (3rd)) stayed straight and were not involved in the incident. The # 4 drifted out taking the path of # 6, causing him to make an adjustment. The # 6 horse was in fourth position when this occurred. After

conversation with the patrol judges and all jockeys involved the Stewards felt Talamo's final placing was not compromised; therefore a disqualification was not warranted.

07/31/11⁹ **JOCKEY ALTERCATION**

Assistant Clerk of Scales Charles McCaul reported to the Stewards that jockeys Martin Pedroza and Christian Santiago Reyes were involved an altercation in the jockey quarters following the 6th race. They were allowed to ride the rest of their mounts, but were warned not to transfer their temper onto the race track. They will both be in to see the BOS Wednesday morning.

08/03/11¹ **REYES HEARING (ref. 08/31/11⁹)**

Jockey Christian Santiago Reyes met with the Stewards to discuss the fight in the jockey quarters on Sunday with jockey Martin Pedroza. Mr. Reyes was afforded the opportunity to give his version of the event and Mr. Pedroza will be in tomorrow to support himself.

08/03/11² **FILM REVIEW**

Jockey Rafael Bejarano met with the Stewards to discuss his ride in the first race on Sunday which involved a Steward's inquiry (reference 07-31-11⁸) It was the Steward's opinion that Mr. Bejarano did make an effort to correct his mount when it stepped out and he was excused with a warning.

08/03/11³ **INQUIRY AND DISQUALIFICATION THIRD RACE (5/8 turf)**

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review an incident near the 1/16 marker. Involved were #7 Cactus Flyer (2nd R. Bejarano), #8 Sugar Spike (4th D. Flores) and #9 Warren's Creampuff (6th V. Espinoza). After a review of the videos and conversation with the Patrol

Judges and all jockeys involved it was a unanimous decision to disqualify #7 from second and place him sixth behind #9. The videos verified that #7 drifted outward, pushed #8 out into #9, who had to take up sharply and in the opinion of the Stewards was cost the opportunity of a better placing.

08/04/11¹ **FILM REVIEW (ref. 08/03/11²)**

Jockey Rafael Bejarano met with the Stewards as directed to review the third race yesterday. The majority opinion was that Mr. Bejarano corrected his mount as soon as he was able when it ducked out after having been hit one time left handed. Steward Chaney dissented with the belief that Mr. Bejarano could have made a stronger effort, and therefore believed that a three day suspension was appropriate.

08/04/11² **O'RILEY HEARING CASE #11DM004**

This case was filed under CHRB rule 1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers) and 1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations). In attendance were groom/massage therapist Michael O'Riley, his counsel Clay R. Sides, Official Veterinarian Jill Bailey and Representing the CHRB was Investigator Rick Amieva. After a discussion off the record it was decided to re-schedule the hearing for a formal setting. This case will be heard Thursday August 11, 2011 at 11:30 AM.

08/04/11³ **METZ RULING (ref. 07/31/11¹)**

Trainer **JEFF METZ** is fined **FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)*** for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1652(g)(Prohibited Actions with Respect to Claims-filed more than two separate claims in one race).

This ruling was issued after Mr. Metz was informed of his penalty.

08/04/11⁴ **REYES RULING (ref. 07/31/11⁹)**

DMTD #019

Jockey **CHRISTIAN SANTIAGO REYES** is fined **FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)*** for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct-fighting in jockeys' room following the sixth race at Del Mar Thoroughbred Club on July 31, 2011).

This ruling was issued after all testimony involving the incident was heard. Although Mr. Pedroza admitted he initiated the incident, this BOS feels any participant in this sort of conduct is culpable. He was drug tested and the results were negative.

08/04/11⁵ **PEDROZA RULING (ref. 07/31/11⁹)**

Jockey Martin Pedroza met with the Stewards to discuss the altercation with Christian Santiago Reyes last Sunday. Mr. Pedroza admitted he lost his temper with Mr. Reyes and started the fight. Mr. Pedroza was drug tested and the results were negative. The following ruling was issued:

08/04/11⁶ **INQUIRY SECOND RACE (1 1/16 Polytrack)**

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review the start of the race. After an assessment of the videos it was apparent that # 1 North Fork (V. Espinoza) reared at the same time that the doors of the starting gate opened and unseated its jockey. The outrider caught the loose horse on the first turn.

The pre-race duties for the 4:00 PM post time were conducted under normal conditions.

08/05/11²**INQUIRY AND DISQUALIFICATION FIRST RACE (5 ½ Polytrack)**

Following the running of the race the Stewards posted the inquiry sign to review an incident near the 1/16 pole. Involved were #1a Geniality (3rd P. Valenzuela) #2 Running Isabella (5th M. Pedroza) and #7 Kisses for Kate (2nd M. Garcia). After a review of the videos and conversation with the Patrol Judges and all jockeys involved it was a majority decision (Steward Ward dissent) to disqualify #7 from second and place it third behind # 1a. The majority felt that #1a had sufficient room while advancing into a hole between #2 and #7, #2 moved out a step and #7 drifted in a path causing #1a to take up sharply costing him the opportunity of a better placing.

GARCIA RULING

DMTD # 021

Jockey **MARTIN GARCIA** is suspended for **THREE RACING DAYS** (August 12, 13 and 14, 2011) for altering course without sufficient clearance, causing interference while riding "Excessario" in the fourth race at Del Mar Thoroughbred Club on August 5, 2011. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules-careless riding).

Term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races).

This ruling was issued after a review of the first and fourth race yesterday. Martin Garcia was unavailable due to a riding engagement at Saratoga today, but had his agent Jim Pegram, Jockey Guild Representative Darrel Haire and jockey Joe Steiner represent him in his absence. It was a unanimous decision that in the first race Mr. Garcia was held blameless due to the fact that his movement was minimal and another horse was involved in the incident.

The fourth race was a unanimous decision that Mr. Garcia was guilty of careless riding. The incidents happened between the 5/16 and quarter poles involving two different contacts. Mr. Garcia pushed his way out without sufficient clearance and bumped rivals to his outside twice.

KORINER HEARING CASE CASE #11HP083

This hearing was filed against trainer Brian Koriner for a possible violation of CHRB rule 1865 (Altering of Sex of Horse) involving his trainee "St. Marino". Mr. Koriner was present along with his counsel Don Calabria and the owner/veterinarian of the horse Melinda Blue.

Mr. Calabria argued that Mr. Koriner should not be held accountable because the horse was castrated on the farm, another trainer previously trained the horse and the foal certificate never left the racing office. It was explained that the BOS's position as codified in the CHRB rule is that it is the trainer's responsibility to have their foal certificates properly registered at each meet. This horse was a first time starter. A decision will follow shortly.

VAN BERG FORMAL HEARING CASE #11HP091

This case was filed alleging a violation of CHRB rules 1844 (c) (Authorized Medication) and 1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse). Court Reporter Barbara Weinstein was available to record the proceedings. Trainer Jack Van Berg was available by telephone; Investigator Jim Hamilton represented the CHRB and Investigator Rick Amieva sat in as an observer. Mr. Van Berg stated that his practicing veterinarian gave the injection in the muscle and maybe that caused the drug to remain in the horses system longer. In the veterinarian confidentials it verified that this horse had an injection of Flunixin two days in a row. A decision will follow shortly.

FILM REVIEW

Jockey Martin Pedroza met with the Stewards to review the first race and discuss his mount's movement down the lane. All agreed that he only came out a step and he was warned to be more careful in the future. He stated he would do so.

Jockey Agapito Delgadillo joined the Stewards to review the start of the first race. His mount broke outward into the horse to his outside and this BOS felt that Mr. Delgadillo could have made a better effort sooner to correct his horse. He promised to do so in the future.

Apprentice jockey Eswan Flores met with the Stewards to review the third race yesterday. Mr. Flores sent his horse through a narrow space on the fence turning for home in the 1 1/16 race on the turf. He

was cautioned that he needs more room on the turns before he tries to go through. He seemed to understand and said he would be more aware.

08/06/11⁵ **TRAINER OBJECTION FIRST RACE (7/8-Polytrack)/NO CHANGE**

Following the running of the race Steve Miyadi, trainer of #6 Offlee Wild Boys, lodged a claim of foul against #3 Macho Dorado (2nd C. Sutherland) approaching the 1/16 pole. After a review of the videos and conversation with the Patrol judge and all jockeys involved it was a unanimous decision there would be no change in the order of finish. The #3 horse drifted in, making slight contact with #6 who did step out, and in the opinion of the Stewards the placing of #6 was not effected.

08/06/11⁶ **INQUIRY TENTH RACE (7/8-Polytrack)**

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review an incident at the wire involving # 7 Benny's Benchmark (1st J. Verenzuela) and # 12 Link Suances (2nd P. Valenzuela). After conversation with the Patrol Judges and both jockeys involved it was a unanimous decision not to make a change in the order of finish. The videos verified that the two horses dueled and rubbed in the stretch drive and the last three strides # 7 and # 12 shifted out together.
