BAZE MEETING (ref. 08/19/11³ and 08/20/11²)

At 10:30 this morning Tyler Baze, accompanied by his agent Craig O'Bryan, met with the Stewards. Also in attendance were Investigators Bill Westermann and Rick Amieva, Safety Steward Luis Jauregui also sat in.

Mr. Westermann reported to the Stewards that Tyler Baze was drug tested by the CHRB at 7:00 this morning; the results were negative.

After the meeting with the Stewards, Mr. Baze was directed to go to First Aid where he was again drug tested along with a Breathalyzer screening by an outside service (Drug Testing Network Inc.); all of the results were negative. He was then examined by the racetrack physician Philip Sanderson and was reported to be fit to ride.

Mr. Baze returned to the Stewards' office accompanied by Mr. O'Bryan and jockey David Flores. David Flores has volunteered, with Mr. Baze's acceptance, to support him in his efforts to revise his life style to remain in the industry. Investigators Bill Westermann and Rick Amieva returned to the Stewards office and Mr. Baze signed a testing agreement with the CHRB. The Stewards informed Mr. Baze that he would be under strict scrutiny in the future; he acknowledged this and stated he will comply with all requirements.

PHILLIPS RULING

DMTD #050

Owner **MICHAEL PHILLIPS**, having failed to respond to charges alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility-Dr. John Araujo-\$5,140.00), is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547(Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of Michael Phillips are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine), Mr. Phillips is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

This ruling was issued after Mr. Phillips failed to appear for the scheduled hearing.

D'ARCANGELO HEARING CASE #11DM015

The following case involves CHRB rule 1876 (Financial responsibility). Luciano "Cliff" Naretto DVM, who owns and operates Ponzo Equine Center, filed the complaint against owner Carrie D'Arcangelo in the amount of \$6,050.00 allegedly owed on a board bill for the horse "Mister Darkside". Dr. Naretto was available by telephone to testify. Carrie D'Arcangelo, along with her husband, attended the hearing. After much discussion obtaining the facts of the case the Stewards informed those involved that a decision would follow shortly.

HINES MEETING

Owner Nick Hines (Battle Born Racing Stable) met with the Stewards to discuss an incident yesterday after the running of the five-furlong 4th event (turf). The #8 horse Connagher (Tr. T. West) and #9 Spirit to Win (Tr. G. Vallejo) were both pulled up after the race. Mr. Hines' horse (#9) was delivered to the Ted West stable by mistake and Mr. Hines was concerned with the time frame in which his horse arrived at its designated destination. He was informed that what we did know was, the two horses after being quickly unsaddled about a sixteenth of a mile apart, were both dark bay or brown geldings and neither had a head number on. Mr. Hines was also told we would further review the incident to prevent this from happening in the future. He stated he appreciated our involvement and thanked the BOS for their time.

HEADLEY HEARING CASE #11DM0026

This complaint filed by Official Veterinarian Jill Bailey, an alleged violation of CHRB ruling 1852 (Reporting to the Receiving Barn) was signed off

FILM REVIEW

Jockey Rafael Bejarano met with the Stewards to review the first race yesterday. Entering the turn in the seven-furlong event the BOS felt Mr. Bejarano might have been involved in a shift inward making it tight on the two horses to his inside. After listening to Mr. Bejarano's explanation of the configuration he was not held culpable.

INQUIRY NINTH RACE (7/8 polytrack)/NO CHANGE

The inquiry sign was posted to review the start of the race. After an assessment of the video and conversation with the Patrol Judges it was a unanimous decision that there was no gate malfunction or any involvement of other horses and the race was made official. As the field of horses left the starting gate, # 11 Ruling Force, with jockey Chantal Sutherland aboard, stumbled causing Ms. Sutherland to lose her balance and fall off. Accident report attached.
