INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION

Following the running of the first race, we posted the inquiry sign to examine an incident in the stretch involving the first two horses. Films revealed that the winner #7 Cayambe (A. Quinonez) drifted in and caused second place finisher #3 Winsome Charm (V. Espinoza) to check. #3 Winsome Charm ran on again to finish second beaten a half of a length and in our unanimous opinion was cost the opportunity at a better placing. Therefore the winner was disqualified and placed second:

Original Order of finish: (7)-3-1-5-4-8-2-6

Corrected order of finish: 3-(7)-1-5-4-8-2-6

RANCHO SAN MIGUEL filed a complaint (case number 11DM0027) against trainer JEFF MULLINS alleging unpaid board and care bills for horses. Unfortunately, the farm failed to appear in support of its complaint (Respondent did appear) and the case was therefore dismissed.

HEAP HEARING

Trainer BLAKE HEAP appeared at a formal hearing this morning (case number 11DM0016) into a complaint alleging a bute overage in a post workout sample taken from a horse attempting to be removed from the Veterinarian's list. Mr. Heap explained that the positive could have been attributed to some bute the horse was given for a spider bite. He was issued a warning based on his lack of medication rulings in the last three years in accordance with the CHRB rules.

SPAWR HEARING

Trainer BILL SPAWR called the office this morning before his scheduled hearing and explained that everything in the complaint was correct and that he would accept whatever penalty we deemed appropriate. Nevertheless, because it involved an alleged medication positive, we held a formal hearing into case number 11DM0024, which alleged a methocarbamol positive discovered in the post race test sample of one of trainer Spawr's runners. The record was opened, the complaint packet was entered into evidence and the matter was closed. The following ruling resulted:

BAZE RULING

Based on the failed breathalyzer test approximately ten days ago and pursuant to the testing agreement, we asked the private testing company that contracts with Del Mar to perform a breathalyzer test on jockey TYLER BAZE before his riding engagements this afternoon. Unfortunately, when informed of the test, Mr. Baze chose not to appear, which, based on the testing contract, we treat as a positive. We therefore issued a ruling suspending Mr. Baze's license pending a formal fitness for license hearing into the events over the last two weeks. Subsequent to the issuance of the ruling, we were informed that Mr. Baze had been in a car accident and had driven himself to the hospital for evaluation. Apparently, he believed that this would suffice as an excuse as to why he had failed to appear for the breathalyzer. We knew this not to be the case because we observed Mr. Baze leaving the track when informed that he would be required to test.

DMTD #070

Jockey **TYLER BAZE**, having failed to abide by the terms of a signed testing agreement with the California Horse Racing Board, is suspended pending a formal hearing into his fitness for license.

During the term of suspension, all license privileges of Tyler Baze are suspended and in accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1528(Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine), Mr. Baze is denied all access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

BAZE MEETING

Jockey TYLER BAZE came to the office this morning for a meeting he requested to discuss the circumstances that led to the ruling suspending his license yesterday. Also present at the meeting were Mr. Baze’s agent, Craig O’Bryan, two CHRB investigators, and Bob Fletcher from the Winners’ Foundation. Mr. Baze failed to appear for a breathalyzer yesterday (ref.09/01/11¹). He later claimed that he had been in a car accident and had gone to the hospital and that is why he had failed to appear. We had done some research and presented him with some evidence that indicated that he was actually on the grounds when the test was requested and that the car accident was a fabrication. In light of this, he admitted the deception. We encouraged Mr. Baze to seek help for what we believe to be an alcohol problem and offered Mr. Fletcher’s services to that end. However, the ruling remains in force at least until a formal fitness for license hearing is held and we make a formal decision at that time.
