ESWAN FLORES

Jockey ESWAN FLORES was suspended for failing to appear on a complaint filed by the CHRB to address case 14SA224 for alleged violations of CHRB rules 1500.1(Random Drug Testing) and 1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Agreement). Ruling:

Ruling DMTD # 002

Jockey ESWAN FLORES, having failed to respond to a complaint alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1500.1 (Random Drug Testing) and rule #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Agreement), is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of ESWAN FLORES are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine), Mr. FLORES is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

FILM REVIEW

Jockey MARTIN GARCIA was in to review yesterday's seventh race in which he drifted in slightly mid-stretch causing contact to the horse just inside of him. We felt Mr. Garcia could have made a better effort to maintain a straight course. The incident wasn't worthy of a suspension, but indeed worthy of a warning. Mr. Garcia agreed to make a better effort in the future.

INQUIRY/ NO CHANGE

We posted the inquiry sign immediately after the running of the first race to review an incident that had occurred at the 1/8th pole (polytrack) where two horses were forced to steady. The horses involved were the second place horse

#2 When I'm Calling U (D. Van Dyke), third place horse #3 Among the Stars (J. Vargas, Jr.), the fourth place horse #4 Golden Celestial (A. Delgadillo), and the sixth place horse #1 L T Reckless (F. Perez). After speaking to the riders and the patrol judges and reviewing the films, we unanimously decided to let the original order of finish stand. In our opinion #4 did shift in slightly and #2 came out slightly causing the #1 and #3 to steady. However, neither horse was cost the opportunity for a better placing. Therefore, no change was made to the original order of finish.

FINANCIAL SETTLEMENT (refer to 5/29/14³)

The financial case 14SA155 (reference to stewards' minutes 5/29/14³) filed by jockey agent DANIEL THOMAS HIGH against jockey KENT DESORMEAUX for unpaid jockey fees has been settled for the amount of \$832.41.

JOCKEY OBJECTION/NO CHANGE

The objection sign was posted following the running of the eighth race when jockey KENT DESORMEAUX (3rd place) aboard #7 Marla Hooch, claimed a foul against the 2nd place #5 horse "New Nature" (T. PEREIRA) for an incident that occurred approaching the 5/8's pole. After reviewing the video and speaking with the patrol judges and the riders involved, it was unanimously decided to make no change to the original order of finish. In our opinion, the severity of the contact was minor, and it occurred relatively early in the race. We felt that the incident wouldn't have altered the outcome of the race. Therefore no change was made to the original order of the finish.

JOCKEY OBJECTION/NO CHANGE

The objection sign was posted after the eighth race when jockey TYLER BAZE (4th place, #1 Boyett) claimed of foul against the 2nd place horse #9 Rangi (GB) (K. Desormeaux), alleging interference at the eighth pole (turf). After speaking with the jockeys involved, taking into account the reports from the patrol judges and reviewing video of the stretch run, we voted unanimously to make no change to the original order of finish. The video showed that #9 did come over and cause #1 to steady slightly, however in our opinion, the #1 wasn't cost the opportunity for a better placing.

REINSTATED

The following ruling was issued to reinstate owners KAYLEETA ROBINSON and BEN DAVIS (DBA PACIFIC COAST THOROUGHBRED, LLC). The Board of Stewards at Los Alamitos had suspended them on 7/21/14 (ruling LAQL #133 & LAQL #134) for failure to appear. The cases 14LA0168 and 14LA0169 have been rescheduled for a later date at Los Alamitos. The following ruling was issued:

DMDT Ruling #003

Owners KAYLEETA ROBINSON and BEN DAVIS (DBA PACIFIC COAST THOROUGHBRED, LLC), having appeared before the Board of Stewards and rescheduled their hearing, are restored to good standing. LAQL rulings #134 and #135 dated July 21, 2014, are set aside.

FILM REVIEW

Jockey KENT DESORMEAUX was in our office to review yesterday's ninth race in which he was involved in a jockey's objection. He crossed over when entering the stretch (turf) causing the horse just inside of him to steady slightly. After reviewing the films, Mr. Desormeaux agreed that he did cut it a little too close, and would not make the same error again. The majority felt the incident did not warrant a suspension. Steward Chaney voted for a three day suspension.

Jockey TIAGO PEREIRA was in to review yesterday's sixth race, in which he was involved in a jockey's objection at the 5/8's (polytrack). Periera shifted out, making hard contact with the horse just outside of him. He stated that his horse was difficult to manage and was trying to avoid clipping heels with the horse in front of him. We felt Periera was trying to push his way out to make some racing room for himself, and also that he could have used better judgment to avoid the incident. Mr. Periera was issued a three day suspension. The following ruling was issued:

DMTC#004

Jockey TIAGO PEREIRA, who rode New Nature in the sixth race at Del Mar Race Track on July 23, 2014, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days, (July 30,31 and August 1, 2014) for riding his mount into a space without sufficient clearance. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules- Careless Riding).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

INQUIRY/ DISQUALIFICATION

Immediately after the eighth race we posted the inquiry sign to review the start, when the #11 Mambo Man had charged the gate causing the starting gate doors to open earlier than the other doors. After reviewing the films and speaking to the starter we unanimously voted to disqualify the #11 and place him last. The films shows the #11 had charged the front doors causing the doors to open a split second before the rest of the field, allowing him to gain an unfair advantage.

INQUIRY/NO CHANGE

We posted the inquiry sign to review the start of the ninth race when the #5 Jan's Spirit (tr. J. Fanning) refused to break from the starting gate. After speaking to the patrol judges and the Starter GARY BRINSON we decided to make no change to the original order of finish. The films show that the #5 gates had

opened properly and the assistant starter had released him when the gates opened. In our opinion the #5 horse refused to break out of the gates. Therefore, the horse was deemed a starter.

RULING ISSUED

Trainer GEORGE PAPAPRODROMOU was issued the following ruling for failing to have his runner in yesterday's fifth race "Run Rosie Run" properly shod (second offense). Mr. Papaprodromou's horse came to the receiving barn wearing toe grabs on his hind shoes. Luckily the horse shoe inspector Victor Tovar was able to grind the toe grabs off, allowing him to run. The following ruling was issued.

DMTD Ruling #005

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations), trainer **GEORGE PAPAPRODROMOU** is fined **TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)*** for having his horse "Run Rosie Run" improperly shod in the fifth race at Del Mar Race track on July 24, 2014.

FILM REVIEW

Jockey KENT DESORMEAUX was in our office to review yesterday's fifth race to explain why his horse had shifted in entering the stretch (turf). Mr. Desormeaux stated that his horse was difficult to make switch leads and when attempting to do so, caused her to angle in slightly. We warned Mr. Desormeaux

that he has a habit of this, and he should be more cautious in the future. We felt this incident was minor, but worth reviewing it with him.

Jockey STEWART ELLIOTT was in our office to review yesterday's ninth race in which his horse had shifted in three paths at the 1/16 pole causing the horse just inside of him to steady. Mr. Elliott agreed he could have corrected his mount sooner not allowing his horse to make contact with the horse inside of him. Elliott was issued a three day suspension for failure to maintain a straight course. Ruling to follow.

DMTD Ruling #006

Jockey STEWART ELLIOTT, who rode "RACING FOR CHASEN" in the ninth race at Del Mar Race Track on July 24,

2014, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days, (July 31 August 1 and 2, 2014) for failure to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules- Careless Riding).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

MORAN SETTLEMENT HEARING

We held a formal hearing this morning to decide whether or not to approve a settlement between owner MARK MORAN, owner/trainer SHANE MORAN and the CHRB to resolve case number 13DM0013. This complaint was filed some time ago and involved alleged violations of CHRB Rules 1902 (Conduct Detrimental to Racing) and 1902.5 (Animal Welfare). The CHRB was represented by DAG Elisabeth Frater and the Moran brothers were represented by attorney Roger Licht. Both sides agreed to a settlement in this case and we approved the terms. Ms. Frater will send us a copy of the final settlement next week which we will memorialize in two rulings. The hearing was then closed.

INQUIRY/ACCIDENT/NO CHANGE 1st RACE We posted the inquiry sign after the first race to review an incident at ¼ pole (polytrack) in which the #1 horse Delaney's Joy(E. Trujillo) clipped heels and unseated his rider. After reviewing the films and speaking to the patrol judges and the riders involved, the majority (Jauregui dissented) ruled to make no change to the original order of finish. The films at the location of the incident failed to show if the #1 horse ran up on heels or the number #7 horse had shifted in causing the #1 to clip his heels.

Jockey E. Trujillo was examined by the track physician and cleared to ride his remaining mounts. Accident report attached.

INQUIRY 6TH RACE (TURF)/ACCIDENT/NO CHANGE

The inquiry sign went up immediately after the running of the sixth race to review an accident approaching the 3/8's pole (turf) where the #6 horse "Yes She's Unusual" (B. Blanc) went wrong and fallen, causing the #1 "Antiquity" (D. Van Dyke) and #2 Bosserette (T. Baze) to unseat their jockeys. After speaking to the patrol judges and reviewing the video, we unanimously voted to make no change to the order of finish. The films show that the #6 horse went wrong on his own, unfortunately, causing the #1 and #2 horses to lose their jockeys.

Jockey T.Baze was examined and cleared to ride by the track physician. Apprentice jockey D. Van Dyke was taken off his remaining mounts by the track

physician. Jockey Brice Blanc was taken to Scripps Memorial Hospital in La Jolla for an evaluation. Accident reports for all three riders are attached.

INQUIRY 7th RACE/NO CHANGE

Following the finish of the seventh race the inquiry sign was posted to review the breakdown of #2 horse “Longview Drive” (W. Antongeorgi) while passing the stretch the first time (1 ½ mile). Upon review of the replay, it appeared the horse went wrong on his own accord and in our opinion, no change was appropriate to the original order of finish.

We posted the inquiry sign to review an accident just past the 1/8 pole (turf) during the running of the fifth race. The #13 horse "Lil Swiss Echo" with apprentice jockey Drayden Van Dyke aboard, suffered a catastrophic injury causing Mr. Van Dyke to be unseated. After reviewing the films and speaking to the patrol judges, we unanimously voted to make no change to the order of finish. It was confirmed by the video that #13 horse had suffered his injury on his own, therefore no change was made.

Apprentice jockey Van Dyke was taken to the local hospital for an evaluation. Accident report attached.

We posted the inquiry sign to review the ninth race approaching the 3/8's pole (turf) in which the #3 horse "J Kat" under jockey Corey Nakatani suddenly went wrong and was quickly pulled up. After reviewing the films, we determined that no other horses contributed to the incident. Therefore, no change was made to the order of finish.
