**FILM REVIEW**

Jockey ELVIS TRUJILLO came the office to review his ride in the fifth race yesterday during which we felt that he was keeping his horse in a dangerous position (on the rail, half a length behind the rival to his outside). He agreed and left with a warning.

Jockey RAFAEL BEJARANO came to the office to review his ride in the fifth race during which we believed he could have relieved some of the pressure on the horses to his inside during the run down the backstretch. He recognized his mistake and left with a warning.

**QUEVEDO RULING**

The following ruling was issued when groom SANTIAGO QUEVEDO failed to appear for his noticed hearing:

**DMTD Ruling #011**

Groom SANTIAGO QUEVEDO, having failed to appear for a hearing alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct), is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of SANTIAGO QUEVEDO are suspended, and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine), Mr. Quevedo is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

**MORAN RULINGS**

Pursuant to the formal hearing we held last week involving trainer SHANE MORAN and his brother owner MARK MORAN, we approved the respective stipulated agreements and memorialized them in the following rulings:

**DMTD Ruling #012**

Owner MARK MORAN is fined ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule 1902 (Conduct Detrimental to Racing). Mr. Moran shall relinquish his owner's license before August 8, 2014 and cannot reapply until November 1, 2017.

**DMTD Ruling #013**

Trainer SHANE MORAN is fined ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00)\* and suspended for a period of thirty days (September 1, 2014 to October 1, 2014) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1902.5 (Animal Welfare). Furthermore, Mr. Moran is placed on probation from October 1, 2014 to December 16, 2016 with the following conditions:

- (1) Mr. Moran shall fully cooperate with representatives of the Board in its monitoring of his compliance;
- (2) Upon successful completion of probation, Mr. Moran will be required to apply for a new trainer's license to the Board, who will then make a recommendation with respect to renewal;
- (3) Commencing July 25, 2014, Mr. Moran shall submit a medical report of any horse he trains that has to be euthanized to the CHRB within seven days of euthanasia. He shall also notify the CHRB of any horse under his care that suffers a terminal injury;
- (4) Commencing on July 25, 2014, Mr. Moran shall notify the CHRB of any horse that he gives or donates to any organization within seven days of the said donation;
- (5) Commencing on July 25, 2104, Mr. Moran shall submit his training records to the CHRB on a monthly basis, and produce them to a CHRB representative upon request;
- (6) If, during the probation period, Mr. Moran's horses do not win a race, he will relinquish his trainers' license;
- (7) Prior to November 1, 2014, Mr. Moran shall meet with Equine Medical Director Rick Arthur, and his private veterinarian to establish a program to ensure the health of the horses he owns and/or trains. He shall provide the names of any veterinarians treating his horses upon the request of the CHRB; and
- (8) Should Mr. Moran violate any of the terms of this ruling, his license will immediately be suspended pending a hearing before the Board of Stewards or a Hearing Officer.

**DESORMEAUX RULING**

After careful consideration of the hearing involving jockey KENT DESORMEAUX held two weeks ago, we issued the following:

**DMTD Ruling #014**

Jockey KENT DESORMEAUX is fined ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1874(Disorderly Conduct-alcohol) & #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey

Agreement) for failure to fulfill his riding engagements in the seventh and eighth races at Santa Anita Race Track on June 26, 2014.

Furthermore, Mr. Desormeaux is required to submit to an evaluation by the Winners' Foundation and abide by its recommendations. Lastly, Mr.

Desormeaux must submit to a breathalyzer test with the CHRB on every race day until November 3, 2014.

**FILM REVIEW**

Jockey TYLER BAZE came to the office as directed to review his ride in the sixth race Sunday during which we felt he should have taken his horse back entering the turn rather than his choice of working to remain in a dangerous position on the rail. He agreed. We also wanted to review his use of the whip in the post parade of that same race. He used his whip to

whip the horse near the flanks. He explained that the horse had become studish and he was trying to move his focus from his advances toward the pony, to the task of running. We explained that his actions constituted a rule violation and issued the following ruling:

#### Ruling DMTD #015

Jockey TYLER BAZE is fined THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (b) (Use of Whips – whipping during the post parade) before the sixth race at Del Mar Race Track on August 3, 2014.

Jockey AGAPITO DELGADILLO came to the office as directed to review his ride in the fourth race Sunday during which we felt that he allowed his horse to step in for a stride turning for home. He agreed but explained that he was trying to get his horse to switch leads. He left the office with a warning.

Jockey JULIEN COUTON came to the office as directed to review his ride in the fourth race Sunday during which we believed he was trying to split horses at the head of the stretch and didn't have sufficient clearance to safely make the move. He disagreed and blamed his fellow rider for tightening up the opening. We explained that the safer course of action would have been to wait for a more substantial space to be created and issued a warning.

Jockey MARIO GUTIERREZ came to the office to review his ride in the sixth race on Sunday during which we believed he could have relieved some of the pressure on the two horses to his inside during the run down the backstretch. He disagreed and believed he maintained sufficient spacing. We explained that it was not enough for our standard and to leave more in the future. Warning.

#### **INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION**

We posted the inquiry sign to review the stretch run of the fifth race. Films revealed that fourth place finisher #3 Prospector Alley (app. jockey D. VanDyke) ducked out sharply, making firm contact with the horse to his outside #6 Golden Guy (jockey T. Baze). The horses were separated by a head at the finish so we unanimously voted to disqualify the aggressor and place him sixth.

**FILM REVIEW**

Apprentice jockey DRAYDEN VANDYKE came to the office this morning to review his ride in the fifth yesterday after which his mount was disqualified for his actions in the stretch run. A review of the films indicated that the horse ducked out sharply under the first strike of the whip and the young rider responded quickly. Therefore he left the office without penalty.

Jockey MARTIN GARCIA came to the office to review his ride in the fourth race yesterday during which he shifted his mount out at the quarter pole forcing a rival to steady and nearly clip heels. He explained that his horse moved out further than he intended. The majority voted for a warning, while Steward Chaney strongly believed a three day suspension was appropriate for the careless riding.

**FLORES RULING**

The following ruling was issued after carefully considering the evidence from the hearing held last Saturday:

DMTD Ruling #016

Jockey ESWAN FLORES is suspended for ninety (90) calendar days, from August 3, 2014 through October 31, 2014, pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule 1500.1 (Random Drug Testing –Alprazolam, a metabolite of Xanax;1225 ng/ml) on June 29, 2014 at Santa Anita Race Track. Mr. FLORES must be evaluated by the Winners' Foundation and comply with its recommendations. Furthermore, Mr. FLORES is fined SIX HUNDRED dollars (\$600.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Agreement – three mounts). Prior to reinstatement, Mr. FLORES must participate in a fitness for license hearing before a Board of Stewards.

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of ESWAN FLORES are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine), Mr. FLORES is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

**INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION**

Following the running of the eighth race, we posted the inquiry sign to review an incident as the field entered the far turn. Five horses were abreast and serious bumping ensued among the outside four. Films revealed that spacing was tight and the horse on the outside #13 Mahalo Arturo (jockey F. Martinez) drifted in slightly and started the chain reaction. After speaking with the riders involved as well as the patrol judges, we unanimously voted to disqualify #13 and place him last.

**FILM REVIEW**

Jockey FRANCISCO DURAN came to the office to explain why he missed a mount during yesterday’s card. He explained that neither he nor his agent realized they had a mount and therefore didn’t come to the track at all. He was issued the following ruling:

**DMTD Ruling #017**

Jockey FRANCISCO DURAN is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)\* for failure to fulfill his riding engagement in the fifth race at Del Mar Race Track on August 7, 2014. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Agreement).

Jockey ELVIS TRUJILLO came to the office to review his ride in the third race yesterday during which we felt he came out and interfered with his rivals to the outside in the homestretch. Films showed that he struck his horse three times on the left side and each time the horse moved out a bit. He recognized his mistake but thought the last contact was right at the finish when the riders were easing up. We believed his actions constituted careless riding and issued the following ruling:

**DMTD Ruling #018**

Jockey ELVIS TRUJILLO, who rode JOHN’S SUCCESS in the third race at Del Mar Race Track on August 7, 2014, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days, (August 14, 15, and 16, 2014) for failure to make the proper effort to

maintain a straight course in the stretch, causing interference. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules – Careless Riding).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

Jockey FELIPE MARTINEZ came to the office as directed to review his ride in the eighth race yesterday after which his mount was disqualified for interference approaching the 3/8<sup>th</sup>'s pole. Films showed that he was the furthest out of a five horse spread, angled his horse in and created a significant bumping reaction with the horses to his inside. He thought the blame rested with the inside horses coming out. We disagreed and issued the following suspension:

#### DMTD Ruling #019

Jockey FELIPE MARTINEZ who rode Mahalo Arturo in the eighth race at Del Mar Race Track on August 7, 2014, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (August 14, 15, and 16, 2014) for crossing over without sufficient clearance going into the turn causing interference which resulted in the disqualification of his mount from fifth to last place. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races).

**FILM REVIEW**

Jockey COREY NAKATANI came to the office to review his ride in the sixth race yesterday during which we believed that he crossed over during the backstretch run and caused interference to the two horses to his inside. He explained that he did intend to make the space tighter and possibly encourage one of the rivals to take back, but felt he left enough room. We disagreed and issued the following ruling:

**DMTD Ruling #020**

Jockey COREY NAKATANI is suspended for THREE DAYS (August 15, 16, and 17, 2014) for crossing over without sufficient clearance and causing interference while riding “Frisco Fog” in the sixth race at Del Mar Race Track on August 8, 2014. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races).

Jockey FELIPE MARTINEZ came to the office to review his ride in the eighth race yesterday during which we believed he forced his horse into an opening and caused interference. Films showed that as the field passed the quarter pole, Mr. Martinez guided his horse between a slowing horse and a rival to the inside without sufficient clearance causing the horse to his inside significant interference. He felt that given the set up and his momentum, he had no choice. The majority (Steward Jauregui voted for a warning) issued the following ruling:

**DMTD Ruling #021 (amended)**

Jockey FELIPE MARTINEZ, who rode “He’s a Real Keeper” in the eighth race at Del Mar Race Track on August 8, 2014, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days, (August 17, 20 and 21, 2014) for riding his mount into a space without sufficient clearance. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules – Careless Riding).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.
