JOCKEY FLORENT GEROUX RULING

DFTD #001

Jockey FLORENT GEROUX, who rode I'M ALREADY SEXY in the ninth race at Santa Anita Race Track on November 2, 2014, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (November 9, 13, and 14, 2014) for failure to make the proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch, causing interference which resulted in the disqualification of his mount from fourth to fifth position. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules – Careless Riding).

Pursuant to California Horse rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

This ruling was issued after a review of the ninth race from this past Sunday after which Mr. Geroux's mount was disqualified for interference in deep stretch. Darrell Haire, Western Regional Director of the Jockeys' Guild, represented Geroux.

After a review and discussion of Geroux's ride, the Stewards felt that while the rider only hit the horse one time left handed, he was late in taking hold of the inside rein in order to correct his mount's outward drift.

A complaint filed by Jose Castellano, the owner of Two Friends Ranch, against owner John Pinner was dismissed after hearing testimony from both sides. According to Mr. Pinner's trainer, Danny Velasquez, the horse in question, Dashing Ash, was given away to Gregorio Ruiz, who isn't Licensed by the CHRB, who subsequently sent the horse to Mr. Castellano's ranch. We will attempt to contact Mr. Ruiz in order to settle the matter.

11/08/14³**VOIDED CLAMS**

There were three claims voided on the afternoon racing card. The claim of the horse Do the Danse from the second race by Leonard Powell was returned to the barn of Jerry Hollendorfer as the horse was off in the left foreleg while under observation in the test barn. Elle Street, claimed from the third race by trainer Mark Glatt, was returned to Eric Guillot's care as it was also off in the left foreleg while under observation following the race. A claim deposited by Trainer Robertino Diodoro for Street Serenade, which ran in the fifth race, was voided and the horse was returned to trainer Steven Miyadi as it exhibited signs of lameness in the right front leg during the cooling out period.

11/09/14²**OWNER/TRAINER NESTOR CAPITAIN RULING**

Owner/trainer NESTOR CAPITAIN, is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility – failure to abide by terms of agreement with owner Robert Falb \$300.00).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of Nestor Capitaine are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine), Mr. Capitaine is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

This ruling was issued after the Stewards received notification that Mr. Capitaine failed to live up to the signed financial agreement with owner Robert Falb.

JOCKEY IRVING OROZCO

Jockey IRVING OROZCO is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1680 (Jockeys and Drivers to Report) and #1682 (Weighing Out – failure to report proper riding weight) on November 8, 2014. The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Orozco accepted responsibility for reporting the incorrect riding weight. He said he is having trouble with his weight and did not have time to hit the steam room in order to shed three pounds.

11/09/14⁴

REFUND

A refund was ordered in the first race as #1 Heat Flash flipped in the starting gate, prompting Racing Veterinarian Stead to recommend that the horse be declared. The refund amounted to \$64,917.28. The rider, Fernando Perez, was not injured.

11/09/14⁵

REFUND

There was a refund in the third race as #6 Chuck’s Chuckle unseated jockey William Antongeorgi during the post parade and ran off two miles before being caught. The refund came to a total of \$12,298.26. Mr. Antongeorgi was not injured.

11/09/14⁶

REFUND

A third refund on the card took place prior to the fifth race, as #2 Bench Ruling flipped in the saddling stall and bit its tongue severely. Dr. Stead recommended the scratch, with the resulting refund coming to a total of \$11,355.30.
