The BOS did not feel the incident was penalty worthy, but he was informed he needs to be more vigilant leaving the gate. He agreed and stated he would do so.

Drayden Van Dyke joined the Stewards to review the stretch run in the fourth race. Mr. Van Dyke's mount drifted out under a left handed crop causing a horse to his outside to drift as well. Another horse on the outside, who was closing quickly, had to veer out. Mr. Van Dyke was warned he needs to be aware of his drifts; he agreed and stated he would do so.

Edwin Maldonado also met with the Stewards. He was late to the paddock for the third race as the field was on the track by the time he mounted his horse in the tunnel. He stated it was his fault as he couldn't find his silks that were right in front of him. Ruling to follow.
