IVIE HEARING CASE #15TL0001

The CHRB filed a complaint against owner Anne Ivie for an alleged violation of CHRB rule #1489(c) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License). In attendance, representing the CHRB, was supervising Investigator Rick Amieva. Ms. Ivie was present as well. Ms. Ivie, on her original owner's application, failed to disclose a conviction for disorderly conduct: intox drug/ alcohol which occurred in 1971. While replacing her lost license this year the CII report showed a non- disqualifying conviction. Ms. Ivie was informed that she can reapply with the correct information for her owner's license without penalty.

DRABINSKI HEARING CASE 15LT0002

The CHRB filed a complaint against owner Joseph Drabinski for an alleged violation of CHRB rule #1489(c) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License). Supervising Investigator Rick Amieva represented the CHRB for this hearing and owner Joseph Drabinisky was also present. Mr. Drabinisky failed to report his arrest (1979) on his original owner's application. He was arrested for disorderly conduct, harassment and resisting arrest in New York. He did not appear in court and currently there is an outstanding bench warrant on his CII record. Mr. Drabinisky stated he has to appear in person in New York to remove the warrant, which he is unable to do at this time. A decision will follow as to his eligibility to be licensed in California.

NAKATANI RULING

The following ruling was issued after confirmation that Mr. Nakatani violated the new crop rule:

RULING DMTD #037

Jockey COREY NAKATANI is fined THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – second offense), during the second race at Del Mar Race Track on August 5, 2015.

ASCANIO HEARING CASE #15DM003

The CHRB filed a complaint against Jockey Agent Matthew Ascanio for a violation of CHRB rule #1489(a) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License-felony conviction-inflict corporal inj spouse/cohab) In attendance for the hearing were Winners' Foundation representative Bob Fletcher, respondent Matthew Ascanio (currently under house arrest) and his counsel John Tyre. The BOS were asked to consider Mr. Ascanio's eligibility to hold a CHRB license. Due to Mr. Ascanio's conviction and pursuant to CHRB rule 1489, his eligibility to hold a CHRB license could be denied. The rule does allow the Board the option to grant a license. Mr. Fletcher testified as a character witness. He stated he felt Mr. Ascanio could participate in the industry without harm. Mr. Ascanio testified the incident that led to his conviction was an isolated incident and he described his version of what happened. He wants to be able to earn a living in this industry to support himself and to provide for his son. There was no recommendation given by the CHRB. Decision to follow.

BELL HEARING CASE #15LT004

The CHRB filed a complaint against trainer Tom Bell for an alleged violation of CHRB rule 1629 (Penalty for a Late Declaration) and rule #1698 (Failure to Start and Run). Mr. Bell had a horse treated twice with Phenylbutazone on July 1, 2015 to race on July 2, 2015 at Los Alamitos Race Track. Official Veterinarian Tim Grande interviewed both practicing veterinarians, Keith Latson and Vince Baker, about the medication given to the same horse on the same day as listed on their confidential reports. They both confirmed their confidential reports were correct. This necessitated the late scratch of Mr. Bell's runner. Both Veterinarians, when interviewed by Investigator Jim Hamilton, stated that Mr. Bell had them both treat the horse in question. In the hearing Mr. Bell stated he held the horse for Dr. Latson and did not ask Dr. Baker to treat his horse. Before a decision is made, the BOS will have all parties meet and testify before the Board. More to follow.

RUIZ RULING

The following ruling was issued after an informal hearing was held to discuss a citation given to exercise rider Martin Ruiz for galloping too close to the rail. He felt if he was doing a two minute lick, two paths off the fence was sufficient. He was informed that he needs to be at least twenty five feet off the rail and to abide by directives given by the outriders.

RULING DMTD #038

Exercise rider MARTIN RUIZ is fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers -galloping close to rail).

BELL RULING ref 08-06-15³

The following ruling was issued after an informal hearing was held with trainer Ray Bell and practicing veterinarian Vince Baker. Dr. Baker stated that Mr. Bell asked him to administer the medication (phenylbutazone) and told him the horse was in stall 19. Mr. Bell remarked if he did make that remark, he does not remember. The two parties agreed to share the penalty, but the ruling will be in Mr. Bell's name and Dr. Baker will give him credit in the amount of two hundred dollars.

RULING DMTD #039

Trainer THOMAS 'RAY' BELL is fined FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$400.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1698 (Failure to Start and Run) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration – runner double treated with phenylbutazone), resulting in the late declaration of “KEEGERS” from the fifth race at Los Alamitos on July 1, 2015.

INQUIRY DISQUALIFICATION SECOND RACE (5 1/2 furlongs)

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review an incident at the top of the stretch involving #1 Rock N Bunny (T. Pereira 1st) and #2 Warrensdollar signs (E. Maldonado 2nd). After a review of the videos, conversation with the Patrol Judges and both jockeys involved, in a majority decision (Ward dissent) the #1 horse was disqualified from first and placed second. The majority felt that the #2 horse had secured a position inside #1 when that one drifted in slightly causing #2 to take up, lose momentum and shift to the outside, denying him an opportunity for a better placing. The minority felt that while there was interference, it did not alter the original order of finish.
