JOCKEY FILM REVIEW

Edwin Maldonado met with the Stewards to review the start of the fifth race Sunday. His mount broke sharply inward and this BOS felt Mr. Maldonado could have reacted sooner to correct the direction of his horse. After discussing the event he finally stated he could have done a better job; warning.

Jamie Theroit joined the Stewards to review the sixth race on Sunday which involved an inquiry (ref 7-31-16⁴). Mr. Theroit shifted out turning for home when a horse in front of him stepped out. He then found himself on another horse's heels to his outside and he swung out farther to avoid those which affected three horses to his outside. In a unanimous decision he was issued a warning.

Fernando Perez came into review the first race on Saturday to discuss the start. Mr. Perez's mount broke out sharply leaving the gate and at the same time the horse to his outside broke in. Mr. Perez was late to react because he was knocked off balance after the initial contact. He did say he would try to do better in the future, warning. Also Mr. Perez will receive a penalty for missing the film review on Sunday, this will be issued tomorrow.

JOCKEY FILM REVIEW

Fernando Perez met with the Stewards to review the first race yesterday. After the start of the race, Mr. Perez aboard #3 drifted inward without sufficient clearance causing two horses to take up. After a review of the DVD all agreed Mr. Perez was careless in his actions and the following ruling was issued as well as the ruling for missing film review with the Stewards (ref 8-2-16¹) yesterday:

RULING DMTD #021

Jockey FERNANDO PEREZ is fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)* for violation of the California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers – Failure to attend film review on July 31, 2016).

RULING DMTD #022

Jockey FERNANDO PEREZ, who rode SENZA FINA in the first race at Del Mar Race Track on August 3, 2016, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (August 10, 11 and 12, 2016) for failure to maintain a straight course leaving the starting gate and causing interference. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules – careless riding).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

Rito Almanza joined the Stewards to review the start of the eighth race yesterday in which he drifted inward leaving the gate from the #8 post position going into the first turn causing four horses to his inside to shift and/or take up. During this action he also overused his crop on the horse's shoulder and the Stewards unanimously agreed to distribute the following two rulings:

RULING DMTD #023

Jockey RITO ALMANZA, who rode HEROES FOR GHOSTS in the eighth race at Del Mar Race Track on August 3, 2016, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (August 10, 11 and 12, 2016) for failure to maintain a straight course leaving the starting gate and causing interference. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules – careless riding).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

RULING DMTD #024

Jockey RITO ALMANZA is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of the California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(B)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense in the last sixty days), during the eighth race at Del Mar Race Track on August 3, 2016.

Martin Pedroza notified the Stewards and accepted the penalty for misuse of the crop in the second race yesterday. The following ruling was issued:

RULING DMTD #025

Jockey MARTIN PEDROZA is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of the California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(B)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense in the last sixty days), during the second race at Del Mar Race Track on August 3, 2016.

Norberto Arroyo met with the Stewards to discuss his use of the crop in the third race yesterday. Mr. Arroyo said his mount was lazy and he forgot about the rule after his horse started to respond. Hopefully the following ruling would help remind him in the future.

RULING DMTD #026

Jockey NORBERTO ARROYO, JR. is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)* for blatant violation of the California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(b) (6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – multiple violations in one race), during the third race at Del Mar Race Track on August 3, 2016.

INQUIRY DISQUALIFICATION THIRD RACE 3/4 mile- dirt

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review an incident near the 3/16's marker. Involved were #2 Redneck Crazy (Martin Pedroza 3rd), #3 Gathering Evidence (Chad Lindsay 6th), #4 Moose Skowron (Santiago Gonzalez 5th), #6 Quorum of Joy (Mario Gutierrez 2nd) and #7 Captain Akers (Kent Desormeaux 1st). After talking to the Patrol Judges, all jockeys involved and a review of the videos, in a unanimous decision, #7 was disqualified from first and placed sixth behind #3. In a final analysis, all agreed that #7 was the main contributor to the incident. Coming off the turn outside of one, inside of three, #7 ran into and through a small opening, in doing so he stepped out in front of #3 causing that one to clip his heels and lose the opportunity of a better placing. This also caused a shift of the other horses to the outside.

DE LA FLOR RULING CASE 16DM0001

Per CHRB rule 1876 (Financial Responsibility), KC Horse Transportation filed a complaint against owner Francesca De La Flor for \$738.81. After the Respondent failed to appear for the hearing, the following ruling was issued.

RULING DMTD #027

Owner FRANCESCA DE LA FLOR, having failed to respond to a complaint alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility – K C Horse Transport \$738.81) is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear.)

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of FRANCESCA DE LA FLOR are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend and Fine). MS. DEL LA FLOR is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

JOCKEY FILM REVIEW

Kent Desormeaux joined the Stewards to discuss the disqualification of his horse yesterday in the third race, ref 08-04-16². In a review of the race, Mr. Desormeaux stated in a five horse spread coming off the turn the horse in front of him and to his inside, stepped out which caused him to “redirect” around that one into the path of the horse that clipped his heels. This BOS could not confirm that theory per video review, although we did agree a horse on the outside did lean in. However, this did not exonerate Mr. Desmoreaux from the incident and the following ruling was issued.

RULING DMTD #028

Jockey KENT DESORMEAUX, who rode CAPTAIN AKERS in the third race at Del Mar Race Track on August 4, 2016, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (August 11, 12 and 13, 2016) for crossing over without sufficient clearance and causing interference which resulted in the disqualification of his mount from first to sixth position. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules – careless riding).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

Apprentice Austin Solis met with the Stewards to discuss the use of his crop in the sixth race yesterday. He stated he knows the crop rule, but got excited in the moment of his long shot mount running well and violated the rule. He was hoping for a warning, but the following ruling was issued.

RULING DMTD #029

Apprentice Jockey AUSTIN SOLIS is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(B)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense in the last sixty days), during the sixth race at Del Mar Race Track on August 4, 2016.

Gary Stevens contacted the Stewards after the fourth race yesterday after he was informed he violated the crop rule. He acknowledged his error and accepted the penalty over the phone. The following ruling was distributed.

RULING DMTD #030

Jockey GARY STEVENS is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(B)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense in the last sixty days), during the fourth race at Del Mar Race Track on August 4, 2016.

Norberto Arroyo met with the Stewards to review the ninth race yesterday going into the first turn

of the 1 1/8 turf race. The video review revealed, coming out of the chute, folding onto the main course, Mr. Arroyo aboard #9, shifted in applying pressure to several horses to his inside. The formation of the horses involved exonerated him of a penalty, but he was informed to be more responsible in the future when he is on the outside of a spread and in control; warning.

SILVA RULING DMTD #032

Exercise Rider JOSE SILVA is fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)* for violation of the California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers – failure to follow instructions of outrider).

CEDENO RULING DMTD #033

Jockey OSMAN CEDENO is fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)* for violation of the California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers – failure to follow instructions of outrider).

RULING DMTC #035

Jockey ALEX SOLIS is fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)* for violation of the California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers – late to film review on August 6, 2016)

ARTIEDA RULING DMTD #036

The following ruling was issued after Mr. Artieda was late in reporting his overweight.

Jockey PETER ARTIEDA is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* for failure to report the proper riding weight for the third race at Del Mar Race Track on August 6, 2016. This constitutes a violation of the California Horse Racing Board rule #1682 (Weighing Out) .

BOULANGER HEARING CASE #16DM013

The CHRHB filed a complaint against jockey Brandon Boulanger for violation of CHRHB rule 1845 (License Subject to Conditions and Agreements). In ruling LAQL #179 (2013), Mr. Boulanger is required to abide by recommendations stipulated by the Winner's Foundation organization. After representative Bob Fletcher reported Mr. Boulanger was not complying with the terms, the complaint was filed by the CHRHB. Winners' Foundation representative Leroy Martinez was available for comment. He reported, since the complaint was filed three weeks ago, Mr. Boulanger has complied with Winners' requirements and he appears to have gained some maturity and awareness to his situation. He was issued an official warning and was told the future is his to fix, if there is another complaint of this nature a suspension would be issued. He stated he understood.

PERIBAN FORMAL HEARING CASE #16SA093

The CHRHB filed a complaint against trainer Jorge Periban for a violation of CHRHB rules #1844 (c)(2) (Authorized Medications), #1887 (Trainer or Owner to Insure Condition of Horse), #1843 (a)(d) (Medications, Drugs and Other Substances) #1843.1 (b) (Prohibited Drug Substances). Present for the hearing before the Board of Stewards were Jorge Periban, Investigator Jim Hamilton

representing the CHRB, and recording the proceedings, court reporter Michell Derieg. Mr. Periban's trainee "Angel's Journey" raced and finished first (through a disqualification) in the fifth race on April 10, 2016, at Santa Anita Race Track. The post-race sample was analyzed by U. C. Davis Laboratory and found to contain the Class IV drug Flunixin (93 ng/ml); a split was sent to Industrial Laboratories and the results were 111 ng/ml. The test did show a level of Lasix in the urine and a Phenylbutazone level in excess of 2 mg/ml but below 0.5 ug/ml. which is below the level for a double NSAID violation. Veterinarian Confidentials show a flunixin injection was given by Dr. Blea on April 8, 2016 and a Phenylbutazone injection was administered on April 9, 2016 at 10:30 AM. Mr. Periban testified he has no idea how the overage occurred, he doesn't have the paste form of the medication in his barn. He said his private veterinarian administers all medication for racing. The complaint package was entered into evidence and the hearing was closed. Decision to follow.

INQUIRY NO CHANGE FOURTH RACE 1 1/16 dirt

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review a possible violation in the stretch run. Involved were #1 Mr. Cartagnea (C. Lindsay 3rd) and #5 Midnight Rumble (I. Puglisi 4th). Late in the stretch run both horses, with little separation drifting out several paths, no contact was made.

After talking to both riders and the Patrol Judges in a unanimous decision the Stewards felt the original placing was not affected and the race was made official.
