ENTRY DAY

Racing Secretary David Jerkens and his staff were in the Del Mar racing office compiling a racing card for Friday, August 5, 2017. Steward Scott Chaney was in the Stewards' office as entries were under his watch today. Eight (8) races filled and sixty three (63) horses are scheduled to start.

KILPACK VISIT

National Thoroughbred Racing Association (NTRA) Security/Integrity consultant Michael Kilpack visited the Stewards' office this morning. This former CHRB Supervising Investigator is at Del Mar following up on the Del Mar Thoroughbred DMTC/NTRA application for accreditation.

KENT DESORMEAUX FILM REVIEW

Jockey Kent Desormeaux appeared in the Stewards' office in order to review his ride in the seventh race Sunday, July 30 aboard #4 Force (IRE) who finished fifth in this race. Jockey Desormeaux swung out for racing room at the ¼ mile marker in this 1 1/16th mile turf event. The Stewards' thought sufficient clearance may have been questionable on July 30. Today Jockey Desormeaux was excused after a short film review made it clear that the Stewards' over analyzed this event last Sunday.

SIERRA BOECKEL- BARR COMPLAINT (CASE #17SA196)

Physical Therapist Sierra Boeckel-Barr appeared in the Stewards' office to answer an allegation that she violated CHRB Rule 1889 (Entry to Area Assigned to Trainer). In addition to Ms. Boeckel-Barr, present at today's hearing were CHRB Investigator Kevin Kitishima. CHRB Safety Steward Luis Jauregui and Trainer Michael McCarthy.

The fourteen (14) page complaint packet reads as follows: On June 27, 2017 Physical Therapist Sierra Boeckel-Barr entered Barn#59 (Trainer Michael McCarthy) Stable to treat a horse "Roksana" with pulsed electromagnetic field treatments. (P.E.M.F.) Sierra Boeckel-Barr had treated the horse in the past. The horse "Roksana" was under the care of another trainer at the time. She entered Barn #59 (Trainer Michael McCarthy stable to treat "Roksana" at the request of the owner. Physical Therapist Sierra Boeckel-Barr did not have permission from the trainer Michael McCarthy to enter his shed row. See Santa Anita Security Report #17-311 for additional info.

Physical Therapist Boeckel-Barr told the Stewards she had permission from the owners of the horse in this matter to treat their horse. She also checked the horse's legs and fed the horse a peppermint. Trainer McCarthy testified that he never gave Ms. Boeckel-Barr permission to treat his trainee. He was understandably upset when his employee's told him about the treatment.

The Stewards felt the physical therapist was conceivably put in a tough situation by the owner's of this horse, who allegedly didn't convey to Trainer McCarthy that they wanted this person to treat their horse. Following this hearing the Stewards informed a visibly concerned Ms. Boeckel-Barr that an Official Warning would be added to her CHRB license history.

COREY NAKATANI FILM REVIEW

Jockey Corey Nakatani was scheduled for a film review today in the Stewards' office. The Stewards' wanted to review Jockey Nakatani's use of the crop aboard #5 Newsman (IRE), who finished second in the seventh race on Sunday, July 30. Unfortunately Jockey Nakatani failed to appear in our office. He called the Stewards before the races to apologize for his absence. The Stewards conducted a film review without Jockey Nakatani. Film review shows him use his riding crop six (6) consecutive times without giving his mount a chance to respond. In two (2) unanimous decisions the following rulings were issued.

DMTD Ruling #019

Jockey COREY NAKATANI is fined THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – third offense in the last sixty days), during the seventh race at Del Mar Race Track on July 30, 2017, (last offense July 29, 2017).

DMTD Ruling #020

Jockey COREY NAKATANI is fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)* for violation of the California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers – failure to attend film review on August 2, 2017).

COMMITMENT PHOBIA

Jockey Agent Derek Lawson was in the Stewards' office on Sunday, July 30 explaining a business dealing he has had with Trainer Vladimir Cerin. Mr. Lawson, who represents Jockey Flavien Prat, told the Stewards he gave Trainer Cerin 'a call' on the Cerin trained Pioneer of the West, who is scheduled to start in the seventh race, Thursday, August 3. While the races were being drawn, Agent Lawson opted to ride the Jerry Hollendorfer trained Ike Walker instead. Trainer Cerin was not happy, to say the least, and told the Stewards he wanted Jockey Prat to ride 'his (Cerin's) horse' or sit the race out completely. The Stewards unanimously voted for another option which is memorialized in the ruling below.

DMTD Ruling #021

Jockey Agent DEREK LAWSON is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations – failure to conduct business in a proper manner) on July 30, 2017 at Del Mar Race Track.

FOURTH RACE STEWARDS REVIEW

The Stewards conducted a 'Stewards Review' into the start of this one (1) mile race on the main track. Of particular interest were the actions of #1 Hollywood Strike (Flavien Prat-Odds 7/2). This horse stumbled badly and lost much ground at the start. After a short review the Stewards found no reason to post the Inquiry sign.

PROSPECTIVE JOCKEY

James Ketner, who has a current jockey's license in the State of Texas, visited the Stewards' office this morning. Safety Steward Luis Jauregui was present. The twenty (20) year old Ketner told the Stewards he has won 'about' twelve (12) races in his career. He told us he was suspended for thirty (30) days last year in Texas after he tested positive for a prescription pain killer. The Stewards sent Mr. Ketner to the enforcement office of the CHRB which is located in the Del Mar stable area. The Stewards want to see a 'clean drug test' before continuing licensing discussions with Mr. Ketner.

EIGHTH RACE JOCKEY OBJECTION

Following the running of the eighth race, which was contested at one (1) mile on the Jimmy Durante turf course, Jockey Tiago Pereira aboard second place finisher #9 Thermopolis lodged a claim of foul against first place finisher #7 Spiritual Warrior (Drayden Van Dyke) for alleged interference inside the 1/16th pole. Both of the horses involved in this objection were trained by Phillip D'Amato. Roughly eighty (80) yards from the finish #7 Spiritual Warrior drifts out and makes contact with #9 Thermopolis. #9 Thermopolis was beaten ¾'s of a length by the winner in this race. The Stewards received a patrol judge report, reviewed all camera angles of the incident and spoke to both jockeys involved. In a unanimous decision the Stewards made 'no change' in the order of finish. Jockey Drayden Van Dyke was ordered to film review.

AUSTIN SOLIS FILM REVIEW

Apprentice Austin Solis appeared in the Stewards' office in order to review the start of yesterday's fifth race. Apprentice Solis was aboard third place finisher #6 Summer's Burst who broke inward at start. Mr. Solis was slow to correct his mount of the start of this 5 ½ furlong main track event. Apprentice Solis was in our office in order to review a similar event last week (REF: 7/30/17 (2)). As was the case last week, in a unanimous decision, he was issued a warning.

NEW APPRENTICE JOCKEY

Exercise Rider Maria Falgione appeared in the Stewards' office today in order to get her apprentice license. This Nebraska native is named on the Mike Machowsky trained Ebony Cat who is scheduled to run in the 8th race on Wednesday, August 9. Safety Steward Luis Jauregui was also present as we all reviewed the jockey protocol in Southern California.

DRAYDEN VAN DYKE FILM REVIEW (REF: 8/3/17 (2))

Jockey Drayden Van Dyke appeared in the Stewards' office in order to review his ride in the eighth race Thursday, August 3. Jockey Van Dyke finished first in this race and survived a jockey's claim of foul in this race. Film review today shows Van Dyke, aboard #7 Spiritual Warrior, drift out while under left handed crop use. This leads to contact with second place finisher #9 Thermopolis (Tiago Pereira). There was 'no change' made in this race. Jockey Van Dyke also survived a jockey's claim of foul here last week at Del Mar(REF: 7/29/17 (2)) and was issued a 'warning' at a July 30 film review. (REF: 7/30/17 (2)). Following today's film review, in a majority decision, Van Dyke was issued a warning (Steward Baker dissent-3 day suspension).

NORBERTO ARROYO RULING (REF: 7/21/17 (1) etc.)

The ruling below was issued after Jockey Norberto Arroyo Jr. failed to ride #3 Onzaway in yesterday's 3rd Race. Arroyo was 'taken off' his mount at 2:28 p.m. Approximate post time for this race was 3:03 p.m. Jockey Arroyo called the Stewards from off track, at 2:39 p.m. and told us he "forgot" about this riding engagement. Jockey Arroyo was also "taken off"

his lone mount on Thursday, July 20, 2017 (8th Race) at 4:46 p.m. when the approximate post time was 5:33 p.m. and he was nowhere to be found. This is the twenty sixth (26) penalty issued against Norberto Arroyo Jr. in 2017.

DMTD Ruling #022

Jockey NORBERTO ARROYO, JR. is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)* for violation of the California Horse Racing Board rule #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Agreement) in the third race on August 3, 2017 at Del Mar Race Track.

DOUBLE JOCKEY FEE

Jockey Chantal Sutherland came into our office last week and told us Trainer Mick Ruis was not going to honor a 'call' he had given her and her agent Tommy Ball. This engagement was regarding the horse One Fast Broad who won today's fourth race (Purse \$60,000). The Stewards felt Trainer Ruis' reason for not honoring the call was not a good one. The Stewards notified Clerk of Scales Charlie McCaul and Trainer Ruis and stated that a 'Double Jockey Fee' was going to be ordered if Trainer Ruis did not fulfill his commitment to Jockey Sutherland. Jockey Corey Nakatani rode #4 One Fast Broad to victory today as Jockey Sutherland 'sat the race out'. Both jockeys received a jockey's fee of \$3,600 from Owner Ruis Racing LLC for the victory.

EIGHTH RACE INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION

Following the running of this 5 ½ furlong main track event the Stewards posted the Inquiry sign in order to investigate the start. Six (6) horses were involved in what can only be described as a truly hectic dispatch. #5 Gypsy Treasure (Apprentice Francisco Amparan) break out very sharply affecting five (5) rivals to varying degrees on her outside. The horse affected the most was twelfth place finisher #7 Angel in Flight (Apprentice Austin Solis) whose rider was nearly unseated at the start. In a unanimous decision #5 Gypsy Treasure was disqualified and placed twelfth (last). Apprentice Jockey Francisco Amparan was ordered to film review.

FRANCISCO AMPARAN FILM REVIEW (REF: 8/4/17 (6))

Apprentice Francisco Amparan appeared in the Stewards' office in order to review his ride aboard #5 Gypsy Treasure who finished seventh in yesterday's eighth race. Blake Nielsen, a Steward from the State of Utah, was also present as an observer. Film review today shows #5 Gypsy Treasure break out sharply and interfere with five (5) rivals to his outside. The Stewards all felt Mr. Amparan should have reacted quicker in an effort to straighten his mount. In a unanimous decision the Stewards issued the following ruling.

DMTD RULING #023

Apprentice Jockey FRANCISCO AMPARAN, who rode Gypsy Treasure in the eighth race at Del Mar Race Track on August 4, 2017 is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (August 11, 12 and 13, 2017) for failure to maintain a straight course and causing interference at the start which resulted in the disqualification of his mount from seventh to last. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1699 (Riding Rules – Careless Riding). Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board Rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

GEOVANNI FRANCO FILM REVIEW

Jockey Geovanni Franco appeared in the Steward's office in order to review his ride aboard #8 Tommy Grossman who finished fourth in yesterday's sixth race which was contested at six (6) furlongs on the main track. The Stewards wanted to review a bump that took place between this horse and third place finisher #6 Artistic Ab (Martin Pedroza) that took place at the 1/16th mile marker. Jockey Franco drifted out while using a left handed riding crop. He switched to his right handed crop use but did not straighten his mount with his reins. After reviewing all camera angles the Stewards, in a unanimous decision, issued a following ruling.

DMTD RULING #24

Jockey GEOVANNI FRANCO, who rode Tommy Grossman in the sixth race at Del Mar Race Track on August 4, 2017 is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (August 11, 12 and 13, 2017) for failure to maintain a straight course and causing interference in the stretch. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1699 (Riding Rules – Careless Riding). Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board Rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

TRAINER NO SHOW

#3 Fishel finished first in yesterday's fifth race. The Steward in the paddock noticed Trainer Jose A. Moreno was not present to prepare his trainee. Two (2) Del Mar valets saddled the horse. In a unanimous decision the following ruling was issued.

DMTD RULING #25

Trainer JOSE MORENO, who was scheduled to saddle FISHEL in the fifth race on August 4, 2017, at Del Mar Race Track, is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1894 (Duties of Trainer – Failure to appear to saddle).

FIFTH RACE INQUIRY

The Stewards' posted the Inquiry sign in order to review an incident involving four (4) horses approaching the 1/8 mile marker. Those horses were first place finisher #12 Jeremy's Legacy (IRE)(Gary Stevens), second place finisher #11 Cordiality (Tyler Baze), seventh place

finisher #6 G Q Covergirl (Flavien Prat) and tenth place finisher #1 Out Of the Ordinary (Jamie Theriot). #12 Jeremy's Legacy (IRE) steps in slightly while going for the lead entering the stretch. This action forces Jockey Tyler Baze to check his mount (#11 Cordiality) and then initiate contact with rivals to his inside #1 Out Of the Ordinary (Jamie Theriot) and #6 G Q Covergirl (Flavien Prat). The stewards told Jockey Stevens that more room should be allowed to inside rivals when his horse 'swap leads' after entering the stretch. Warning issued.

SEVENTH RACE INQUIRY

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign in order to investigate the start of this six and one half furlong main track event which was contested on the main track. This was a 'general Inquiry' as none of the first four finisher numbers were flashing on the totalizator board. Several horses encountered problems at the start of this 2 year old maiden race. The jockey on ninth place finisher #2 King Cause (Jamie Theriot) was nearly unseated at the start. Eighth place #3 Channel Crossing (Flavien Prat) who ducked in at the start, checked sharply thirty (30) yards down the racetrack. Third place finisher #5 Runaway Saturday stumbled very badly at the start, dropped back to last early in this race as his jockey Santiago Gonzalez lost and then later regain an iron after the start. In a unanimous decision, the Steward allowed the original placings to stand. 'No Change'.

GARY STEVENS FILM REVIEW (REF: 8/5/17 (4))

Jockey Gary Stevens appeared in the Stewards' office in order to review his ride aboard #11 Jeremy's Legacy (IRE) who finished first in yesterday's fifth race which was contested at one (1) mile on the Jimmy Durante turf course. Blake Nielsen a Steward from the state of Utah sat in.

Jockey Stevens and his mount stepped in and caused some interference to second place finisher #11 Cordialty (Tyler Baze) entering the stretch of this race. The Stewards told Jockey Stevens to be more cautious when entering the stretch. All of the stewards' felt this ride did not warrant a suspension. Warning issued.

DANIEL VERGARA FILM REVIEW

Jockey Daniel Vergara appeared in the Stewards' office in order to review his ride aboard #1 Flip the Coin Jan who finished fourth in yesterday's seventh race which was contested at 6 ½ furlongs on the main track. With less than 1/8th of a mile to travel in this race Jockey Vergara let his mount wander out while Jockey Vergara employed the left handed crop three (3) times before switching to his ride hand. The Stewards' told Jockey Vergara to guide his mounts with the riding reins instead of the riding crop. Warning issued.

JAMIE THERIOT FILM REVIEW

Jockey Jamie Theriot appeared in the Stewards' office today in order to review two (2) separate issues in the fifth race on Friday, August 4. Jockey Theriot was aboard second place finisher #1 Run Like Rhett in this race. The stewards' felt that this horse's path was needlessly erratic in the stretch run of this one (1) mile turf event. For this he was issued a warning. Further film review shows Jockey Theriot use his riding crop at least four (4) consecutive times in the stretch drive of this race. For this action, in a unanimous decision, the Stewards issued the following ruling.

DMTD RULING #026

Jockey JAMIE THERIOT is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first and second offenses in the last sixty days), during the fifth race at Del Mar Race Track on August 4, 2017.

CHANTAL SUTHERLAND FILM REVIEW

Jockey Chantal Sutherland appeared in the Stewards' office in order to review her ride aboard #6 Beaumarchais who finished fourth in the fifth race on Friday, August 4, 2017. Race replays of this one (1) mile turf event show #6 Beaumarchais open up a three (3) length lead entering the backstretch. Jockey Sutherland used her riding crop eighteen (18) times in this race as her horse dropped back from first to fourth position in the stretch drive. The Stewards unanimously ruled that there were two (2) separate violations as Ms. Sutherland used her riding crop at least four (4) consecutive times twice without giving her horse a chance to respond. The Stewards issued the following ruling.

DMTD RULING #027

Agent Knust told the stewards he didn't realize Jockey Gutierrez had to catch an early evening flight to Vancouver, British Columbia in order to ride on Monday, August 7 in the \$50,000 Pacific Customs Brokers Classic. The professional Mr. Knust was informed of the following sanction.
