The following ruling was issued after Mr. Young was informed of the penalty.

DMTD RULING #039

Trainer DAVID YOUNG, who worked the horse “YES VIRGINIA” at Los Alamitos Race Track on July 2, 2017 to be removed from the Veterinarian’s List is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843 (a) & (d) (Medications, Drugs and Other Substances), #1866 (Veterinarian’s List) and #1844 (c)(1) (Authorized Medication – Phenylbutazone - in excess of permitted level (5.98 ug/ml) Class 4).

DMTD RULING #040

Trainer FRANCIS MEZA, who was scheduled to start Joshuas Glory in the fourth race on August 16, 2017 at Del Mar Race Track is fined FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$400.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board Rule #1501(Worker’s Compensation Insurance Required) for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration).

BAZE RULING/TALAMO RULING

The following two rulings were issued after both jockeys telephoned the Stewards’ stand yesterday and pled guilty.

DMTD RULING #041

Jockey TYLER BAZE is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – second offense in the last sixty days), during the fifth race at Del Mar Race Track on August 16, 2017, (last offense June 24, 2017).

DMTD RULING #042

Jockey JOE TALAMO is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – second offense in the last sixty days), during the seventh race at Del Mar Race Track on August 16, 2017, (last offense August 6, 2017).

NAKATANI RULING

The following ruling was issued after a review of the seventh race yesterday. Mr. Nakatani felt he gave his mount a chance to respond while using his crop. The Stewards, in a unanimous decision, felt he did not.

DMTD RULING #043

Jockey COREY NAKATANI is fined FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$400.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – fourth offense in the last sixty days), during the seventh race at Del Mar Race Track on August 16, 2017, (last offense July 30, 2017).

Trainer RICHARD MANDELLA, who was scheduled to start Specter in the third race on August 17, 2017 at Del Mar Race Track is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration - Medicated).

OCAMPO RULING

The following ruling was issued after Mr. Ocampo called the BOS today stating he was unable to meet with them as directed. He also stated he was aware there would be a penalty for not being able to do the correct weight he had reported one hour before the first race post. The additional weight reported was announced while the horses were in the paddock for his race. Steward Baker voted for a two hundred dollar penalty.

DMTD RULING #045

Jockey ISRAEL OCAMPO who rode Bullet Express in the fourth race on August 17, 2017 at Del Mar Race Track is fined THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1682 (Weighing Out – Reported Wrong Weight).

JOCKEY OBJECTION NO CHANGE FIRST RACE 6 1/2-dirt

Following the running of the race the objection sign was posted after Santiago Gonzalez aboard #5 Mr. Opportunist (4th) lodged a claim of foul against #7 New Karma (D. Van Dyke 1st) for possible interference in the home stretch. After talking to the jockeys involved, the Patrol Judges and a review of the videos it was confirmed that the video did not substantiate the rider's claim of foul. Actually #3 Blue Anchor (F. Prat) stepped out pushing the horse to his outside out which tightened up a hole causing #5 to check slightly. The final analysis was this slight movement did not affect the final placing and the race was made official.

INQUIRY NO CHANGE FIFTH RACE 1 mile-turf

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review the start that involved #3 Accountability (D. Van Dyke) who acted up in the gate possibly prior to or as the gates opened. After a review of available angles in a majority opinion, the horse was declared a starter and the race was made official. Steward Chaney voted to make the horse non-starter.

JOCKEY FILM REVIEW

Blanc Blanc met with BOS to review the third race yesterday, fortunately for him the available DVD to review races with the jockeys had two second races burned on it and no third. The race was discussed, and all agreed from memory, Mr. Blanc can do better at correcting his horse's drift, warning.

Flavien Prat and Jockey Guild Representative Darrell Haire met with the BOS to review the seventh race yesterday. Mr. Prat was involved in an incident as he raised up at the finish line. It occurred when he relaxed to let his horse gallop out, he drifted outward putting a horse to his outside on heels having to take up sharply. He was instructed to be more aware, he stated he would do so. Warning.

Apprentice Francisco Amparan came to the Stewards' office as directed to review his crop usage in the sixth yesterday. He stated he got excited when racing for a second place finish and forgot the rule. Hopefully the following ruling will help him remember.

AMPARAN DMTD RULING #047

Apprentice Jockey FRANCISCO AMPARAN is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense in the last sixty days), during the sixth race at Del Mar Race Track on August 18, 2017.

Gary Stevens and Darrell Haire both represented Danny Sorenson for a possible crop violation out of the gate in the seventh race. At the start Mr. Sorenson lost his right stirrup, after readjusting he slapped his horse four times on the shoulder with his crop to get back into the race. Approximately seventy yards farther down the track he hits his horse on the shoulder again five consecutive times. Ironically before he rode his first race here this season he was handed the "Jockey Protocol", which in detail, describes what the approved crop use is since the new CHRB rule 1688 was implemented. Mr. Stevens argument on behalf of Mr. Sorenson was, he, Stevens didn't feel the use of the crop on the shoulder should count as strikes even though the rule 1688 states: Although the use of a riding crop is not required, any jockey who **uses** a riding crop during a race is prohibited from **using** a riding crop on a horse: (b)(6) more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond before **using** the riding crop again. In the Stewards' opinion anywhere the crop is used on the horse, in any part

of the race without allowing the horse a chance to respond is a rule violation and the following ruling was issued.

SORENSEN DMTD RULING #048

Jockey DANNY SORENSON is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense in the last sixty days), during the sixth race at Del Mar Race Track on August 18, 2017.

Mr. Pedroza met with the BOS to review the use of his crop in the seventh race. The BOS agreed he violated the rule and the following ruling was issued.

PEDROZA DMTD RULING #049

Jockey MARTIN PEDROZA is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense in the last sixty days), during the seventh race at Del Mar Race Track on August 18, 2017.

The following ruling was issued after Mr. Theriot again failed to meet with the Stewards as directed.

THERIOT DMTD RULING #050

Jockey JAMIE THERIOT is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of the California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers) failure to appear in the Stewards' office as ordered on August 19, 2017.

INQUIRY DISQUALIFICATION FIFTH RACE 1 mile-turf

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review an incident in mid stretch. Involved were #1 Aussie Fox (R. Bejarano 5th), #4 Lucky Soul (G. Stevens 6th), #5 Indoctrination (F. Prat 7th) and #6 Cascade Rock (IRE) (J. Talamo 10th). After conversation with the Patrol Judge and jockeys Bejarano and Talamo, in a unanimous decision, #1 was disqualified for interference and placed 10th behind #6. #1 veered out into #6 who was bumped hard and sent outward causing #4 and #5 to the outside to veer out to avoid contact.

DISQUALIFICATION TENTH RACE

Before the tenth race (Del Mar Oaks) was declared official in a majority decision #11 Pacific Wind (C. Nakatani 9th) was disqualified and placed tenth behind #8 Kathy's Song (G. Stevens 9th) for interference in the stretch run. Steward Chaney (dissent) felt when the placing of the two horses did not involve purse money the disqualification was not necessary. It was a unanimous decision there was interference that cost #8 a better placing.

Following the running of the race the Stewards posted a Stewards' Review to look at an incident in the stretch which involved #4 Jabber Now (C. Nakatani 2nd) and #6 Powder (T. Baze 1st). Approaching the 1/8 pole #4 stepped out as #6 was starting to pass on its outside. The latter clipped the heels of #4, jockey Baze got jostled but regained his composure and beat #4. Therefore an inquiry was not necessary.

GUZMAN HEARING CASE #17DM038

The CHRB filed a complaint against apprentice jockey Jimmy Guzman for violation of rules 1874(4) (Disorderly Conduct) and 1489 (a)(8) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License). Present for the hearing, representing the CHRB, Investigator Jim Hamilton, Winners Foundation Representative Darin Scharer and Jimmy Guzman. The issue being, Mr. Guzman who is currently not riding but exercising horses in the AM, was arrested by the San Diego police for 647 (F), drunk in public. He was later tested by the CHRB and was found to be positive for marijuana and alcohol. Mr. Scharer will evaluate Mr. Guzman and report his findings to the BOS. A penalty decision will be made at that time.

JOCKEY FILM REVIEW

Guild Rep. Darrell Haire and Mike Smith met with the Stewards to review a drift in late stretch in the sixth race. The Stewards felt Mr. Smith could have done a better job; the incident was not penalty worthy but was believed it was important for Mr. Smith to review it with the BOS. This Board was disappointed when he said he did the best he could. Warning.

Darrell Haire and apprentice Laura Werner were present to review the fourth race yesterday. This involved a drift in late stretch when Ms. Werner was next to last and caused the horse behind her to check and change paths. Warning.

Darrell Haire along with agent Matt Nakatani represented Corey Nakatani in a review of the tenth and eleventh race yesterday ref 08-19-17⁴ & ref 08-19-17⁵. In the tenth race, Mr. Nakatani while trying to make his mount change leads directed it inward causing a horse to his inside to take up sharply for seven strides. The offended horse angled inward and was pursuing a better placing when Nakatani again drifted inward, making no effort to correct, causing the same horse to check, taking away its chances for a better placing for a second time. In the eleventh race in the stretch Mr. Nakatani’s mount stepped out causing a horse to his outside to clip his heels. In a majority decision listed in a ruling below, Mr. Nakatani received a five day suspension for the interference in the tenth race, and was not found culpable for the incident in the eleventh race. Steward Baker voted for a three day suspension for the tenth race disqualification and a four day suspension in the eleventh race inquiry. The

difference in the two opinions was either a five day suspension or two suspension rulings totaling seven days.

NAKATANI DMTD RULING #051

Jockey COREY NAKATANI, who rode Pacific Wind in the tenth race at Del Mar Race Track on August 19, 2017, is suspended for FIVE (5) racing days (August 26, 27, 30, 31 and September 1, 2017) for failure to keep a straight course, and causing interference in the stretch which resulted in the disqualification of his mount from ninth to tenth. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules - Careless Riding). Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule # 1766 (Designated Races). The term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

Darrell Haire, agent Tora Yamaguchi and Rafael Bejarano met with the BOS to review the fifth race yesterday in which Mr. Bejarano's mount was disqualified ref 08-19-17². Mr. Bejarano stated the incident occurred when he guided his mount in and then out to change leads and the horse overreacted. In the Stewards' opinion his mount had already changed leads before he threw a cross and the loose reins allowed his horse to veer out making Bejarano responsible for the hard contact to the horse to his outside which in turn caused two more horses farther out to react, and the following ruling was issued.

BEJARANO DMTD RULING #052

Jockey RAFAEL BEJARANO, who rode Aussie Fox in the fifth race at Del Mar Race Track on August 19, 2017, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (August 26, 27 and 30, 2017) for failure to maintain a straight course in the stretch, causing interference resulting in a disqualification from fifth to tenth. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules - Careless Riding). Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races). The term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

Victor Espinoza met with the Board to review the seventh race on Friday to review his use of the crop. Mr. Espinoza felt he gave the horse a chance to respond between strikes and the BOS disagreed in the following ruling.

ESPINOZA DMTD RULING #053

Jockey VICTOR ESPINOZA is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense in the last sixty days), during the seventh race at Del Mar Race Track on August 18, 2017.

Jamie Theriot met with the Stewards to discuss the issue of reporting the wrong riding weight on Thursday. The first over weight was announced one hour prior to first post. When he crossed the scales to weight out for the race he was two pounds heavier than what he had reported, the correction was announced. The penalty is listed in the following ruling.

STEWARDS' REVIEW FIRST RACE NO CHANGE 6 furlongs-dirt

Following the running of the race a Stewards' Review was posted to review the start. Involved were #4 Ramona Lover (T. Pereira 3rd), #5 Bona Fide Lover (M. Pedroza 2nd) and #6 Candee Topper (A. Jimenez 6th). After a review it was agreed the effected horse (#5) beat #4 who was the culprit of the incident and #6 caused his own interference, therefore an inquiry was not necessary and the race was made official.

A Stewards' Review was posted to review the start of the race. Involved were #4 Causeforcomotion (E. Roman 2nd) and #5 Pantsonfire (IRE) (R. Bejarano 4th). At the start #4 broke out into #5 causing that one to stumble and lose ground. The majority believed the incident did not cost #5 a better position. Steward Sawyer voted for a disqualification of #4.

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review an incident in the stretch run. Involved were #2 Om (G. Stevens 3rd) and #1 Vyjack (F. Prat 2nd). While behind the eventual winner #5 Blackjackcat, the jockey of #1 guided his mount outward to pass, bumped #2 which jostled jockey Stevens. After a review of the race, conversation with the Patrol Judge and both jockeys involved, although is it was clearly interference, in a unanimous decision the incident did not affect the final placing and the original order of finish was made official.
