**MACHOWSKY RULING**

A ruling was issued when Trainer Mike Machowsky elected not to run his horse (#2 Ria Munk) in the second race. Mr. Machowsky chose not to run without a valid reason. Ruling to follow:

**DFTD RULING #011**

Trainer MICHAEL MACHOWSKY, who was scheduled to start RIA MUNK in the second race on November 22, 2018 at Del Mar Race Track is fined FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$400.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration – Trainer decision).

**RAIL CHANGES**

We granted permission to the Racing Office to change the rail settings for Saturday’s races from 12 feet to 0 feet on the turf to allow the track to be wider. The office felt it would be safer for the two year olds running in the fifth race, the Grade III Jimmy Durante Stakes. The official program will have the correct rail settings.

**FILM REVIEW**

Apprentice Jockey Luis Fuentes was in our office to review Sunday’s sixth race where his mount broke outwards at the start (6 furlong) causing the outside horse to steady slightly. The young rider stated his horse was lugging out and was difficult to correct. We felt the incident didn’t warrant a suspension. Therefore, a warning was issued. Steward Baker voted for a suspension.

**JUDE HEARING (case#18SA0201)**

The CHRB filed a complaint against Jockey John Jude for alleging rule violations of CHRB rule 1874/1930 (Disorderly Conduct and Obedience to Security Officer and Public Safety Officers) where it was reported that he had consumed alcohol prior to riding a horse during training at San Luis Rey Downs Training Center. Security Guard for San Luis Rey stated in his report that Mr. Jude had consumed a beer and attempted to ride a horse during training. Mr. Jude and former jockey and former Guild Representative Twei Reavy stated that Mr. Jude was only joking and did not consume any alcohol. He and the groom were only joking about drinking when the guard witnessed him pretending to drink a beer. He also stated that he can be tested at any time, and asked the guard to breathalyze him. After hearing all his testimony and the complainant not appearing for the case, we dismissed the case.

**TRAINER’S OBJECTION/NO CHANGE**

After the running of the sixth race the trainer (D’Amato) of the horse #7 “Ya Gotta Wanna” (F. Prat) lodged an objection concerning an incident at the 1/16<sup>th</sup> pole (turf) against the winner #8 Chicago Style (D. VanDyke). #7 Ya Gotta Wanna had to steady when the #8 Chicago Style shifted in slightly and the inside horse #5 Ashleyluvssugar (Tyler Baze) contributed to the incident when he shifted out. After speaking to both riders involved and reviewing the film we unanimously voted to make no change to the order of finish. In our opinion the incident did not warrant a disqualification, therefore, no change was made to the original order of finish.
