Mr. Robbins informed Mr. Beach of the Covid 19 Operational Plan and that Victor would have to provide management with a negative Covid test before he would be permitted on the premises. Replacement riders were announced.

FILM REVIEW

Jockey Abel Cedillo met with the Stewards for a review of the second race from Friday, July 10, 2020. Mr. Cedillo was reminded that safety is the major concern and although he was not responsible for any interference, he was advised to be alert for other riders who may be in trouble.

The video of this five-furlong turf race showed #1 Seaside Dancer racing on the inside lacked room around the turn came off the rail and made contact with his outside rival without costing anyone a better placing. Mr. Cedillo in a majority decision was issued a warning, Steward Jauregui voted for a suspension.

JEFF MULLINS RULING

The ruling was issued after Trainer Jeff Mullins phoned the Stewards and accepted responsibility for failing to follow the procedure for racing a horse on the turf course with toe grabs on the hind shoes.

DMTD RULING #001

Trainer JEFF MULLINS, who started the horse KP ALL SYSTEMS GO in the ninth race at Del Mar Race Track on July 10, 2020 is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1853 (Examination Required – improperly shod).

JERICK ELLO RULING

The ruling was issued after Mr. Ello and the Stewards reviewed the third race from July 10, 2020, as the young rider was observed striking his mount four times with the crop without letting his mount respond. He acknowledged his error and stated he would be more careful going forward.

DMTD RULING #002

Apprentice Jockey JERICK ELLO, is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense in last 60 days), during the third race at Del Mar Racetrack on July 10, 2020.

AARON GRYDER RULING

The ruling was issued after Mr. Gryder accepted responsibility for being late to the paddock for the tenth race.

DMTD RULING #003

Jockey AARON GRYDER is fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1530 (Cases not Covered by Rules and Regulations – late to paddock) prior to the tenth race at Del Mar Park on July 10, 2020.

FILM REVIEW – EVIN ROMAN

Jockey Evin Roman met with the Stewards for a review of the fifth race from July 10, 2020. Mr. Roman's mount was involved in an inquiry for interference when his mount came out into the stretch, then drifted in and bumped his rival late, the Stewards were satisfied with the riders effort to control his mount from drifting in during the incident. Mr. Roman was not penalized.

FILM REVIEW – MARIO GUTIERREZ

Jockey Gutierrez met with the Stewards for a review of the ninth race from July 10, 2020. Mr. Gutierrez was cautioned about allowing his mount to drift out in the stretch and was issued a warning.

07/11/20⁷

ALFRED MARQUEZ – COMPLAINT (20SA0123)

The CHRB filed a complaint against trainer Alfredo Marquez for violation of CHRB rule #1843 (a) (b) (d) (Medications, Drugs and Other Substances) #1843.1 (a) (Prohibited Drug Substances) and #1887 (a) (Trainer or Owner to Insure Condition of Horse). Mr. Marquez's runner Storming Lady who ran in the fifth race at Santa Anita Park on March 1, 2020 finishing (1st first) was post-race tested and the official blood sample #SA31410 contained Phenylbutazone which is a prohibited Class 4 drug.

Present at the hearing were Trainer Alfredo Marquez, Board of Stewards Kim Sawyer, Luis Jauregui and Ron Church, Court reporter Michelle Derieg recorded the proceeding. Mr. Marquez waived his right to representation. Mr. Marquez was sworn in and testified that all of his medications are administered by his barn veterinarian and could offer no other explanation for the positive. The complaint was entered into evidence and the hearing was closed. Decision to follow.

INQUIRY – NO CHANGE – 5th RACE

The Stewards posted the inquiry sign following the fifth race for a review of two separate incidents involving #3 GIRTHER (Jockey - Ricardo Gonzalez) first and #1 CROSS INDIAN (Jockey – Eswan Flores) second. After considering the patrol judges report, interviewing the riders involved and reviewing the video, the Stewards in a unanimous decision made no change in the original order of finish.

The video shows #3 GIRTHER shifts in during the stretch run nearing the three-sixteenths pole and makes contact with #1 CROSS INDIAN, the second incident took place when #1 CROSS INDIAN, shifted out and made contact with #3 GIRTHER nearing the wire. After reviewing the incidents between both rivals the Stewards’ decision was that both horses contributed to their problems and the race was made official.

INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION – 9th RACE

The Stewards conducted an inquiry following the ninth race to review an incident going into the first turn of the one-mile event.

After interviewing the riders involved, the patrol judges and reviewing the video, the Stewards decided unanimously to disqualify #2 WHITE VELVET from fifth to sixth for shifting in, bumping and impeding #1 PAIGE RUNNER, preventing the later the opportunity for a better placing.

The ruling was issued subsequent to the formal hearing held on Saturday, July 11, 2020. Mr. Marquez was informed of the ruling and he accepted the penalty imposed.

DMTD RULING #004

Trainer ALFREDO MARQUEZ, who started the horse STORMING LADY, the first place finisher in the fifth race at Santa Anita Park on March 1, 2020, is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)* pursuant of California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer or Owner to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843 (a)(b)(d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances), #1843.1 (Prohibited Drug Substance – Phenylbutazone [Class 4]).

DRAYDEN VAN DYKE RULING

DMTD RULING #005

Jockey DRAYDEN VAN DYKE is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – second offense in the last 60 days), during the ninth race at Del Mar Race Track on July 11, 2020.

AHMED ZAYAT (DBA ZAYAT STABLES LLC.)

The ruling was issued after owner Ahmed Zayat failed to appear for a scheduled hearing regarding the financial complaint filed against him by Brian Strong (dba B and S Equine Enterprises) alleging a delinquent account for horse transportation services totaling \$600.00.

DMTD RULING #006

Owner Ahmed Zayat (dba Zayat Stables LLC,) in violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility) is suspended for failure to pay his debt owed to Brian Strong (dba B and S Equine Enterprises) in the amount of SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$600.00)*. The suspension shall commence on July 20, 2020.

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of Ahmed Zayat (dba Zayat Stables LLC,) are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine). Subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

JOSEPH HERRICK COMPLAINTS (#20SLRDTC0005 - #19SLRDTC0044 #19DM0080 and #20SLRDTC0001)

The marathon session was held consecutively to address the above cases.

CASE #20SLRDTC0005

The informal hearing for Joseph Herrick regarding a voice mail left by Mr. Herrick regarding Mr. Miller's character, was concluded today. Testimony from Mr. Miller and Mr. Herrick were entered into the record and CHRB complaint #20SLRDTC0005 was entered as exhibit #1 and the hearing was closed. Decision Warning.

CASE #19SLRDTC0044

This complaint was more of the same verbal altercation, between Mr. Miller and Mr. Herrick, both parties were given the opportunity to be heard and call witnesses after everyone completed their testimony and questioned the witness the hearing was closed. Decision Warning.

CASE #19DM0080

This case involves Mr. Herrick and Mr. Millers assistant trainer Jeobany Catalan. This is another verbal altercation taking place at San Luis Rey Training Center, both parties were given the opportunity to be heard and assistant trainer Catalan called a witness, Mr. Victor Gonzalez who is employed by San Luis Rey Downs Training Center as a Security Officer. Mr. Catalan questioned the witness and Mr. Herrick was given the opportunity to cross-examine the witness, after all testimony was given and the witness questioned the hearing was closed. Decision forthcoming.

CASE #20SLRDTC 0001

The case was more of the same involving Mr. Miller's groom and Mr. Herrick, however this case was dismissed without prejudice when the complainant failed to appear. All of the above cases were heard with Mr. Herrick testifying telephonically.

JOCKEYS FILM REVIEW - 5th RACE

Jockeys Eswan Flores and Ricardo Gonzalez were invited in to review the stretch run of Saturday's fifth race. Both sides were involved in an inquiry where they let their mounts drift into each other. After reviewing the race Jockey Ricardo Gonzalez was warned to make a better effort to maintain a straight course, in a unanimous decision, Jockey Eswan Flores was also warned to maintain a straight course in a majority decision with Steward Jauregui voting for a three day suspension.

FILM REVIEW - 9th RACE

Jockey Ruben Fuentes, who was involved in yesterday's ninth race inquiry was absolved of blame as the video of the incident shows the incident was caused by the actions of the horse and not the rider. The video replays show Mr. Fuentes react quickly to straighten his mount with the horse continuing inward in spite of his corrective measures. A warning was issued.

The Stewards met separately with jockeys Jose Valdivia Jr. and Drayden Van Dyke for a review of the video of the tenth race from Saturday, July 11, 2020. Both riders were advised to use better judgement placing their mounts and reminded that safety for riders and horses are everyone's concern.
