**ENTRIES/ SCRATCHES**

Steward Kim Sawyer came into the office to monitor entries for Sunday and Friday's scratches. The Racing Office carded eleven (11) races for Sunday.

**CONFERENCE CALL**

We participated in a conference call to review new rule #1688 (Use of Riding Crop) which comes into effect on October 1, 2020. Participating in the conference call were all the Stewards working in California, in addition to Executive Director Scott Chaney and Chief Steward Darrel McHargue. The CHRB wanted to discuss the rule among all the stewards, as well as the process of regulating and imposing possible penalties. The meeting was informative, thus allowing us to monitor and exhibit consistency throughout the state.

**FILM REVIEW**

Jockey UMBERTO RISPOLI came to our office to review Monday's first race, in which he was disqualified from second and placed last for interference in the stretch. Mr. Rispoli's horse shifted out when using his riding crop with his left hand, causing the horse just outside to steady. There was unanimous decision not to sanction him, as we felt that he quickly corrected his horse. Therefore, a warning was issued.

Jockey RICARDO GONZALEZ was in our office to review Monday's sixth race, in which he was disqualified from seventh and placed eighth. The incident occurred at the 3/8'ths pole (turf). After reviewing the video, it was determined that Mr. Gonzalez did all that he could to protect the inside horse who was in a compromising spot going into the turn. The Stewards felt that he didn't deserve a penalty.

**DESORMEAUX FORMAL HEARING (case #20DM0028)**

Jockey KENT DESORMEAUX answered to the complaint telephonically which was filed by the CHRB for rule violation #1874 (Disorderly Conduct). The incident occurred on July 28, 2020 in the RV lot at Del Mar Race Track. Present in the hearing were the Stewards, Investigator Greg Icamen, Vendor Guy Stuttley, and recording the proceeding was Court Reporter Michelle Derieg. The CHRB filed a complaint alleging that Mr. Desormeaux used racial slurs towards Mr. Stuttley that ignited an altercation. The altercation occurred during a barbeque when they both were consuming alcohol. Mr. Stuttley grew angry with Desormeaux who kept using racial slurs, thus frustrating Mr. Stuttley and causing him to hit Mr. Desormeaux. Del Mar Management did remove Mr. Desormeaux from the premises. After hearing all the facts and entering exhibits into the record, the hearing came to a close. Decision to follow.

**STUTTLEY FORMAL HEARING (case #120DM0029)**

Vendor GUY STUTTLEY was in the office for a formal hearing to answer to a complaint filed by the CHRB for rule violation #1874 (Disorderly Conduct) for the same incident with Jockey Kent Desormeaux that occurred on July 28, 2020 in the RV lot at Del Mar Race Track. Present in the hearing were the Stewards, Investigator Greg Icamen, and recording the proceeding is Court Reporter Michelle Derieg. Mr. Stuttley stated that he became increasingly aggravated with Jockey Kent Desormeaux when he repeatedly used racial slurs towards him, and would not leave him alone. This provoked anger and frustration, which led to Mr. Stuttley punching Mr. Desormeaux in the jaw. Stuttley apologized for the incident. Decision to follow.

**LAWSON MEETING**

We met with Jockey Agent DEREK LAWSON, who represents Flavien Prat, regarding the Juvenile Turf Stake Race on Monday September 7, 2020 with Trainer Jeff Mullins. The agent elected to ride another horse just prior to the draw for the race, causing the trainer to seek another rider. Mr. Lawson stated he gave the call in the beginning of the meet, yet hadn't spoken to Mr. Mullins recently regarding Prat riding the horse. We felt the incident needed to be investigated, therefore, we referred the matter to the CHRB.

**STEWARDS' INQUIRY/NO CHANGE/ACCIDENT**

We posted the inquiry sign after the running of the ninth race (5 fur.turf) to review the accident at the ½ mile in which the #2 "Queen Stormborn" (M. Gutierrez) ducked into the rail unseating her jockey. After speaking to the patrol judges and reviewing the video, we unanimously voted to make no change. The video shows that the #2 shied away from the outside horses causing her to jump into the inside rail. We placed no blame on the other participants, therefore, there was no change to the order of finish. Accident report attached.

**FILM REVIEW**

Jockey ABEL CEDILLO came to our office to review yesterday's sixth race in which he crossed over slightly on the backside causing the horse behind him to clip his heels. Mr. Cedillo stated his horse was running green from the dirt in his face. After reviewing the video several times, we felt that Mr. Cedillo made the effort to correct his horse and placed the blame on the horse.

Jockey UMBERTO RISPOLI was in this morning to review yesterday's seventh race for a possible riding crop violation. The video clearly exhibited that Mr. Rispoli violated the Riding Crop rule and he took full responsibility of his actions. The following ruling was issued:

We also reviewed yesterday's ninth race in which he could have possibly violated the riding crop rule. We felt the incident did not warrant a penalty, we just wanted to review the race with him.

**DMTD Ruling #088**

Jockey UMBERTO RISPOLI is fined THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – Excessive) during the seventh race at Del Mar Racetrack on September 4, 2020.

**TRAINING CITATION**

Exercise Rider NESTOR CAPITANE was called in to respond to a training citation dated on August 28, 2020. Mr. Capitane was cited when galloping on the rail after a workout. After hearing his side of the story, it was determined that he was just past the finish line after the work, and he was not at fault. We did caution him to gallop slightly off the rail when galloping out after a workout to allow workers to pass by. He was issued a warning.

**BLACKER HEARING (case#20DM0035)**

Trainer DAN BLACKER was in to answer to a complaint filed by the CHRB for violation of CHRB rule #1845 (Authorized Bleeder Medication) on August 8, 2020. Mr. Blacker's foreman was not present during Lasix time for the 11<sup>th</sup> race at Del Mar Race Track. Mr. Blacker stated that he has implemented protocols to make sure this doesn't happen again. Lasix Veterinarian Michelle Griffin stated that the barn is usually there during Lasix times and she recommended a warning. So, Blacker was issued a warning.

**STEWARDS' INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION**

We posted the inquiry sign immediately after the running of the fourth race (One-mile turf) to review the actions of the #11 "Silver Summer" (H. Figueroa) who crossed over on the #2 "Bench Judge" (U. Rispoli) going in to the first turn. After speaking to the patrol judges and reviewing

the video, we unanimously voted to disqualify the #11 and place him behind the #2. The video shows the #11 was not clear of the #2, causing him to steady, thus costing him a better placing.

**FILM REVIEW**

Jockey HERBERTO FIGUEROA was in our office to review yesterday's fourth race, in which he was disqualified from ninth to tenth place for crossing over without sufficient clearance, going into the first turn. The video shows that he did indeed cross over a bit prematurely, however it appeared the inside horse was driving into a spot that was closing. Mr. Figueroa was warned.

Jockey FLAVIEN PRAT was summoned to our office to review yesterday's sixth race (turf), where he drifted in and caused the horse on the inside to steady slightly in the stretch. Mr. Prat stated his horse runs a little erratic and has been involved in other inquiries in the past. After reviewing the horses past performances and analyzing the video, we issued Mr. Prat a warning.

**STEWARDS' INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION 8<sup>TH</sup> RACE**

We posted the inquiry sign after the seventh race to examine the actions of the second-place horse #7 Nimbostratus (FR) (R. Gonzalez), and the third-place horse #11 Ivy League (U. Rispoli) approaching the finish line. After speaking to the riders involved, Patrol Judges, and reviewing the video, we unanimously voted to disqualify the #7 and place him behind the #11. In our opinion, the #7 shifted out causing the #11 to alter course and ultimately costing him the opportunity for a better placing.

Kent Desormeaux is ordered to be evaluated by the Winners Foundation and abide by the recommendations of that organization.

During the term of suspension all licenses and license privileges of KENT DESORMEAUX are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend and Fine) KENT DESORMEAUX is denied to all premises in jurisdiction.

**FILM REVIEW**

Jockey RICARDO GONZALEZ was in to review yesterday's eighth race in which he was disqualified from second to third place for interference in the stretch. Mr. Gonzalez stated his horse was a two-year-old and was green. We felt Mr. Gonzalez could have done a better job maintaining a straight course and consequently, he was issued a three-day suspension listed in the ruling below.

**DMTD Ruling #093**

Jockey RICARDO GONZALEZ, who rode NIMBOSTRATUS (FR) in the eighth race at Del Mar Race Track on September 6, 2020, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (September 19, 20 and 25, 2020) for failure to make the proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch, causing interference which resulted in the disqualification of his mount from second to third position. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules – Careless Riding).
