05-28-09<sup>1</sup> **ANGEL B. SANCHEZ** (Case 09GG097)

A formal hearing was held for jockey **ANGEL B. SANCHEZ** on this non-race day as it was scheduled prior to the cancellation of today's racing program.

Present, in addition to the Board of Stewards, were Mr. Sanchez, his counsel **Lorrie Anthony-Wanger, Esq.**, and CHRB Senior Investigator Gabriel Palomar. CSR Christine Niccoli transcribed the proceedings.

Mr. Sanchez is accused of being under the influence of alcohol (beer) and sleeping in his car in the secured owner/trainer/jockey parking lot on June 13, 2008 and September 5, 2008. The accusation by the CHRB is based on a Golden Gate Fields security report.

The CHRB also noted Mr. Sanchez was arrested by the California Highway Patrol on February 28, 2009 for driving under the influence.

Mr. Sanchez has signed a testing agreement with the CHRB and the latter has withdrawn the complaint.

05-29-09<sup>3</sup> **MARK INGEBRITSON** (09GG195, 09GG196)

A formal hearing was held for trainer **MARK INGEBRITSON**, who has been charged with alleged violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct).

Present, in addition to Mr. Ingebritson and the stewards, were CHRB Senior Investigator Gabe Palomar, witnesses **Sherrie Monroe, Rene Badel Paz** and **Pedro Muniz**. CSR Christine Niccoli transcribed the proceedings.

At issue is Mr. Ingebritson's argumentative demeanor when advised he could not wash horse gear in the recreation hall laundry room by Director Pedro Muniz. Mr. Ingebritson subsequently confronted groom Rene Paz, whom he believed turned him in to Mr. Muniz for washing saddle blankets, etc., and was abusive and threatening.

Mr. Ingebritson acknowledged there was a confrontation, but noted there was no physical contact.

Decision forthcoming.

05-30-09<sup>3</sup> **ROBERT B. HESS, SR.** (09GG177)

Trainer **R. B. Hess** appeared in response to a complaint filed against him by the California Horse Racing Board alleging a violation of CHRB rules 1843(a) & (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances) and 1887(a) (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse).

According to the complaint, U.C. Davis reported that blood sample #GG06360 taken from SHAWNIE ORA, who finished sixth in the third race on April 19, 2009, showed a Phenylbutazone level of 6.70 ug/ml, which exceeds the regulatory level of 5.0 ug/ml.

Mr. Hess has not had a bute violation for over four years and was issued a warning.

05-30-09<sup>4</sup> **RULING NO. 93 – INGBRITSON** (Refer 05-29-09<sup>3</sup>)

Trainer **MARK INGBRITSON** is fined the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – threatening and abusive behavior) on April 23 and April 29, 2009.

The above ruling was issued after considering evidence and testimony presented at the formal hearing held on May 29, 2009.

05-30-09<sup>5</sup> **RIDER EXCUSED**

Jockey **Adan Landeros** reported he has a stress fracture in his right foot and will be unable to ride for six to eight weeks.

He was once again excused from his mounts and replacement riders were selected by the trainers of the five horses he was scheduled to ride.

05-30-09<sup>6</sup> **INQUIRY – NO CHANGE – Fifth Race**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign following the fifth race for a review of the stretch run.

The tapes show #1 LENNY G (Frank Alvarado) (1<sup>st</sup>) drifted out slightly near the finish and brushed #5 SUPERSECRETDEVICE (Luis Martinez) (4<sup>th</sup>).

The incident was minor and did not affect the outcome. The stewards decided unanimously to make no change in the original order of finish.
