During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of SHIRLEY ANN KIMBALL are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The foregoing ruling was issued after Ms. Kimball failed to appear for the hearing (see reference).
