04-21-10⁴ **INQUIRY – NO CHANGE – Fifth Race**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign following the fifth race for a review of the start.

The films show #1 UKNOWTHEROUTINE (Abel Cedillo) ducked in shortly after the start and bumped the inside rail extension entering the main track.

No other horses were involved and the race was declared official.

04-24-10³ **RULING NO. 65 – DIXON** (09GG320)

Security Guard **STEPHEN DIXON**, having failed to respond to written notice to appear before the Board of Stewards at Golden Gate Fields on or before Friday, April 23, 2010, to answer charges of alleged violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1489(a) (h) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License) and #1900 (Grounds for Suspension or Revocation), is hereby suspended pending appearance before the Board of Stewards for violation of CHRB rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of Stephen Dixon are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The foregoing ruling was issued as Mr. Dixon failed to appear for a scheduled hearing. The complaint alleged Mr. Dixon was arrested and pled guilty to possession of a controlled substance (cocaine) in Los Angeles.

04-24-10⁴ **RULING NO. 66 – LEWIS** (09GG312)

Security Guard **KEITH MARTIN LEWIS**, having failed to respond to written notice to appear before the Board of Stewards at Golden Gate Fields on or before Friday, April 23, 2010, to answer charges of alleged violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1489 (h) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License), is hereby suspended pending appearance before the Board of Stewards for violation of CHRB rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of Keith Martin Lewis are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The foregoing ruling was issued as Mr. Lewis failed to appear for a scheduled hearing. The complaint alleges Mr. Lewis was arrested and pled guilty to possession of a controlled substance without a prescription.

04-24-10⁵ **INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION – Fifth Race**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign following the fifth race for a review of an incident in the stretch involving #2 LATIN SCHOLAR (Barrington Harvey) fourth, #1 MINISTERFROMMIAMI (Alex Gonzalez) ninth and #5 MADERIA (Juan Hernandez) sixth.

After interviewing the riders involved, considering the patrol judge's report and reviewing the tapes, the stewards decided unanimously to disqualify #2 LATIN SCHOLAR from fourth to ninth for causing interference in the stretch.

The tapes show #2 LATIN SCHOLAR drifts in steadily near the 1/8 pole and impedes #1 MINISTERFROMMIAMI and #5 MADERIA, forcing the riders of both horses to take back, lose ground and the opportunity of better placing.
