Thursday10-28-10¹ **RULING NO. 5 – YOUNG**

Owner/Trainer **STACY L. YOUNG** having failed to respond to written notice to appear before the Board of Stewards at Golden Gate Fields on or before Wednesday, October 27, 2010, to answer charges alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1489(g) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License), #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations), #1902 (Conduct Detrimental to Horse Racing) and #1900 (Grounds for Suspension or Revocation), is hereby suspended pending appearance before the Board of Stewards for violation of CHRB rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of STACY L. YOUNG are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The above ruling was issued after Young failed to appear at a hearing to address complaint #09GG382. The allegations contend that Young violated CHRB rules #1489(g) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License), #1900 (Grounds for Suspension or Revocation), #1902 (Conduct Detrimental to Horse Racing) and #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations).

The complaint asserts that Young attempted to convey title to horses in her care which she did not have the authority to sell.

10-28-10³ **STEWARDS' INQUIRY / JOCKEY OBJECTION – First Race – NO CHANGE**
The stewards posted the inquiry sign to evaluate an incident at the 1/16 involving the winner, #5 CUTTING FAME, ridden by Juan Hernandez and the show horse, #3 TIZ BLUSHED with Catalino Martinez in the irons. Martinez also lodged an objection. After a thorough review the stewards let the original order of finish stand.

The tapes of the race showed that CUTTING FAME, while racing on the lead, stepped in near the 1/16 while TIZ BLUSHING, who was running second at the time a length back, stepped out. The racing room between the two narrowed which resulted in Martinez steadying his mount momentarily. Since both horses contributed to the incident the stewards could not hold CUTTING FAME solely responsible and affirmed the order of finish on the tote board.
