Report for the period Sunday, November 21, 2010 through Saturday, November 27, 2010.

**Sunday**

11-21-10<sup>1</sup> **STEWARD HERBUVEAUX ABSENT**

Steward John Herbuveaux was absent today for personal reasons. Steward Paul Nicolo filled the position.

11-21-10<sup>2</sup> **CAL-BRED REPORT**

Purse \$9,200. For California bred or California sired fillies and mares, three years old and upward, claiming price \$5,000 at six furlongs. The race was called off with one entry.

11-21-10<sup>3</sup> **RULING NO. 16 – HANSEN**

Trainer **ROGER W. HANSEN**, who started the horse **SNOWFLAKE OBSIDIAN**, winner of the eighth race at Golden Gate Fields on September 26, 2010, is fined the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843 (a) & (d) (Medications, Drugs and Other Substances: Unapproved Substance – Dexamethasone – Class 4).

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Hansen met with the stewards, waived his rights to a hearing and explained how the medication got into the horse's system. Mr. Hansen stated he uses the medication in his barn and in this instance the feed tubs were accidentally switched with another horse in the barn.

11-21-10<sup>4</sup> **RULING NO. 17 – HERNANDEZ**

Jockey **JUAN HERNANDEZ** is hereby fined the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for failing to dismount from the unsound filly **CUTTING FAME** in a timely fashion following the running of the second

race on November 20, 2010; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1902.5 (Animal Welfare).

The preceding ruling was issued after Mr. Hernandez and his agent, Ramon Silva, met with the stewards and watched a recording of CUTTING FAME being jogged back toward the winner circle while showing signs of unsoundness.

11-21-10<sup>6</sup> **GUERRERO vs. BUCKRIDGE FINANCIAL**

After three rescheduled hearing dates the record was opened today to address CHRB complaint 10GG210 filed by former assistant trainer **Leonardo Guerrero** against trainer **GLORIA BUCKRIDGE** for wages in the amount of \$4,550.00.

Present, in addition to stewards Nevin, McHargue and Nicolo, was Mr. Guerrero who was ready to present his case as he has been at two previous scheduled hearing dates. Ms. Buckridge called once again on the day of the hearing and informed the stewards she would not have anyone present to represent her and she would not be able to attend due to health reasons. A conversation between Ms. Buckridge and the stewards at the previous hearing date of 11-12-10 addressed the issue of having someone present to represent her if she was unable to be at the hearing.

Ms. Buckridge was informed a ruling would be issued against her for failing to appear today on November 25, 2010, after which she requested a continuance to that date. Her request was granted with the caveat that if she did not appear a ruling would be issued.

Purse \$13,000. For California bred or California sired maidens, two years old, claiming price \$20,000 at five and one half furlongs. The race was called off with four entries.

11-25-10<sup>2</sup> **GUERRERO vs. BUCKRIDGE FINANCIAL** (Refer 11-21-10<sup>6</sup>)  
Prior to going on the record to address the alleged debt, Ms. Buckridge and Mr. Guerrero discussed the matter between themselves and returned with an agreement which was memorialized in written form and placed on the record. A copy of the signed pay agreement is attached to the original complaint.

11-25-10<sup>4</sup> **INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION – Second Race**  
Following the running of the second race, the inquiry sign was posted for a review of observed interference in the final 1/16 involving #5 PERFECT FASHION (1<sup>st</sup>, Leslie Mawing) and #2 TRAPPERS STAR (2<sup>nd</sup>, Frank Alvarado).

After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the recorded views of the race, #5 was disqualified from first and placed second.

The recording shows #5 drift out and make contact with #2, forcing that rival off its path and cost it a chance of a better placing. The decision was unanimous.

Purse \$10,200. For California bred or California sired three years old and upward, claiming price \$6,250 at six furlongs. The race was called off with one entry.

11-26-10<sup>2</sup> **RULING NO. 18 – MAWING**  
Jockey **LESLIE MAWING**, who rode **PERFECT FASHION** in the second race at Golden Gate Fields on Thursday, November 25, 2010, is suspended three (3) racing days (December 3, 4 and 5, 2010) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from first to second; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Mawing reviewed the race and offered a brief explanation that failed to absolve him of a sanction.
