02-11-11³ **THEODORE LOVING** (11GG008)
 The stewards conducted an informal hearing to address a financial complaint filed against trainer **Theodore Loving** by groom **Gabriela Solomon-Gaede**, alleging an overdue payment for wages.
 Ms. Gaede acknowledges Mr. Loving paid her regularly for the horses she was grooming for him, with the exception of one horse that was new to the barn.

 Mr. Loving had an extra stall at Pleasanton and owner Louis Rios asked if he could leave his horse there for a short period during the 2010 Fresno Fair.
 Mr. Rios made arrangements with Ms. Gaede to groom the horse. The owner was contacted by the Board of Stewards and has agreed to pay Ms. Gaede the \$292.00 she has coming.

The complaint against Mr. Loving was dismissed.

02-11-11⁴ **ARCADIO RIVERA CAMACHO** (Security Case #10-187)
 The stewards met with Golden Gate Fields security and exercise rider **Arcadio Camacho Rivera**, who admittedly was intoxicated in the grandstand on December 2, 2010.
 Trainer Efrain Miranda assisted Mr. Rivera and also interpreted for him. CHRB investigator Gabe Palomar was present for the meeting.
 It appears Mr. Rivera may have violated the terms of his CHRB probation and Investigator Palomar will research the license history and security report to determine how to proceed with a CHRB complaint.

02-11-10⁵ **TRAINER ED MOGER**
 Trainer **Ed Moger** met with the stewards regarding the veterinarian recommended scratch of his horse MARK IN MONTEREY from the fifth race on February 5, 2011.
 Mr. Moger was presented with a written statement from State Veterinarian Forrest Franklin explaining that a mass/abscess on the ventrum between the forelimbs was open, painful and draining.

Mr. Moger asked how to proceed as his horse has run five or six times with the condition.

Dr. Franklin's recommendation is to have the abscess surgically explored, resected and biopsied. Dr. Franklin went on to write that "in lieu of surgical excision, this horse could possibly race if the mass is not painful to palpation, open or draining, or a pocket of exudate developing within the mass/abscess."

Mr. Moger now understands the reason for the scratch and his options going forward.
