FILM REVIEW – RULING NO. 72

Jockey **William Antongeorgi** appeared to review the tapes of the finish of yesterday's ninth race with the stewards. Antongeorgi's mount, REGAN REPUBLICAN, was racing in fourth position when he relaxed and stood up approximately four strides before the finish line. A fast closing competitor caught Antongeorgi's mount just before the wire. The jockey's action, in the steward's opinion, cost REGAN REPUBLICAN fourth place which in turn affected the wagering public because superfecta wagering was offered on the race.

Antongeorgi admitted he stood up before the wire and explained that his frustration with the horse's effort during the race led to his lapse in judgment. The stewards have repeatedly warned and cautioned the jockey colony to stay down past the wire or consequences would result. The following ruling was issued:

Jockey **WILLIAM ANTONGEORGI, III**, who rode **REGAN REPUBLICAN** in the ninth race at Golden Gate Fields on Saturday, May 7, 2011, is

suspended three (3) racing days (May 15, 19 and 20, 2011) for failing to ride his mount out until the finish line is passed; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1692 (Requirements for Horse, Trainer and Jockey).

The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

05-12-11² **HALEY WARNING** (Case #11GG0124)
Trainer **Gloria Haley** was contacted by phone regarding a complaint for a high bute reading (6.06 mcg/ml) on one of her horses. Haley knows how the error occurred and will adjust her administration procedures accordingly. Since this case was Haley's first medication violation in 16 years an official warning was issued per California Horse Racing Board guidelines.

05-12-11³ **LOVING HEARING CONTINUED** (Case #11GG136)
A complaint filed against trainer **Theodore Loving** alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1874 (Disorderly Conduct) and #1902 (Conduct Detrimental to Horse Racing) was continued today in the interests of justice. Loving was to appear in court yesterday regarding the same allegations contained in this complaint but that hearing was postponed until later this month. All the parties agreed that the administrative hearing should be held in abeyance pending a determination in criminal court.

05-12-11⁴ **FILM REVIEW – RULING NO. 73**
Jockey **Julien Couton** appeared to review the fifth race from last Saturday's program.
Couton's mount was disqualified from seventh to eleventh for interference in the stretch run. Couton explained that the horse to his inside began drifting out, forcing his mount to the outside, thus causing the interference. The stewards disagreed with Couton's assessment as the films showed that his mounted started to drift out before the inside horse started his move to the outside. The following

ruling was issued with a five day suspension because Couton is just returning from a three day ban:

Jockey **JULIEN COUTON**, who rode **DRIVEN BY DOLLARS** in the fifth race at Golden Gate Fields on Saturday, May 7, 2011, is suspended five (5) racing days (May 15, 19, 20, 21 and 22, 2011) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from seventh to eleventh; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

05-12-11⁵ **BAZE EXCUSED**

During the on track warm up period for the first race, outrider Mike Wayte contacted the stewards via walkie talkie to say that jockey **Russell Baze** was suffering back pain and would not be able to complete his assignment on #2 EDDINGTONFORGIANNA. The horse was returned to the paddock where William Antongeorgi's tack was put on the horse. Dr. Seftel examined Baze and confirmed he was suffering from back spasms. Baze was removed from his remaining mounts.

DOUBLE OBJECTION – Sixth Race – NO CHANGE

The stewards posted the objection sign at the behest of two jockeys who took exception to the actions of the winner, #1 HALO DOLLY, ridden by Russell Baze. Jockey Rachel Goodgame, aboard the fifth place horse #8 QUIET ADVICE, lodged a claim of foul alleging interference at the ¼ while Aaron Gryder, who rode the place horse, #6 CARRIE ROSE, felt he was bothered at the 3/16. After a thorough review the stewards dismissed both objections.

Tapes showed minor contact between HALO DOLLY and QUIET ADVICE at the ¼ but the angles were inconclusive as to who initiated the bump. As the field turned for home Gryder's mount stepped in and brushed #7 MY SECRET WEAPON but the stewards could not hold HALO DOLLY responsible for the incident.

LATE SCRATCH – Ninth Race - REFUND

#3 VALLEY NEWS, trained by Bud Klokstad, unseated Kevin Krigger in the post parade and ran off. Before the outriders could corral the loose filly she went over the outside fence at the 7/8 gap and was subsequently scratched by the stewards. Neither horse nor rider suffered any ill effects from the incident. The refund amounted to \$5,433.06.
