Sunday05-15-11¹**CAL-BRED REPORT**

Purse \$16,000. For California bred or California sired, four year olds and upward, claiming price \$16,000 at a distance of one mile, was called off with no entries.

05-15-11³**RULING NO. 74 – DEMOSLEY**

Owner **JOHN DEMOSLEY**, having failed to respond to written notice to appear before the Board of Stewards at Golden Gate Fields on or before Saturday, May 14, 2011, to answer charges of alleged violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1489 (a) (b) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License) and #1902 (Conduct Detrimental to Horse Racing), is hereby suspended pending appearance before the Board of Stewards for violation of CHRB rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of JOHN DEMOSLEY are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The ruling listed above was issued after Mr. Demosley failed to appear to address complaint #11GG138. Mr. Demosley was cited after a CII positive was received reporting he had an outstanding felony warrant for 487 P.C. – Grand Theft issued in Polk County, Florida. Demosley also has a 2009 Grand Theft, Identity Theft and violation of felony probation conviction.

In the future horses that fall into this category will be placed on the 'Horse Identifier's List' until the process is complete.

A hearing was held to address California Horse Racing Board complaint #11GG130 filed against trainer **Frances Henderson** for violation of CHRB rule 1843(a) (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances), 1844 (c) (1) (Authorized Medication) and 1887 (a) (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse).

Ms. Henderson was cited after her horse **SPEED FOR GLORY**, which raced in the second race at Golden Gate Fields on March 20, 2011, post race tested with an overage of Phenylbutazone at a level of 11.60 ug/ml.

Ms. Henderson placed blame on her assistant trainer **Ruben Ramirez**. She stated he injured his arm prior to the horse's race and failed to oversee the administration of medication given to the horse...Decision forthcoming.
