08-27-11¹ **CAL-BRED REPORT**
Purse \$10,000. For California bred or California sired three year olds and upward, claiming price \$8,000 at a distance of six furlongs. Only four entries were received for the race and the race was called off.

08-27-11² **ALFREDO MARQUEZ HEARING**
Trainer **Alfredo Marquez**, subject of California Horse Racing Board complaint #11GG167, contacted this Board and requested to address the matter by phone. Mr. Marquez was cited after his horse, ANGEL OF MYSTERY, post race tested with a phenylbutazone level in excess of the permitted level (5.77 ug/ml) following the first race ran on May 22, 2011.

Mr. Marquez was at a loss as to the cause of the overage; however, his suspicions were leaning toward a mistake being made by the substitute trainer or the veterinarian who treated the horse. Decision to follow.

Purse \$12,500. For California bred or California sired fillies and mares, three years old and upward, claiming price \$12,500 at one mile and one sixteenth. The race failed to fill (one entry) and was called off.

08-28-11² **RULING NO. 2 – MARQUEZ**

Trainer **ALFREDO P. MARQUEZ**, who started the horse **ANGEL OF MYSTERY**, winner of the first race at Golden Gate Fields on May 22, 2011, is fined the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843 (a) & (d) (Medications, Drugs and Other Substances: Phenylbutazone – in excess of permitted level – 5.77 ug/ml [Class 4]).

The preceding ruling was issued after Mr. Marquez contacted the stewards, waived his right to a hearing and explained the circumstances which may have caused the overage.
