12-14-11<sup>1</sup> **DUTY STEWARD**

Steward Darrel McHargue will oversee entries and declarations for this week.

12-14-11<sup>2</sup> **MEIER vs. MARTIN** (11GG227)

The stewards conducted a formal hearing to address a financial complaint filed by trainer **Monty Meier** against owner **Perry Martin**, alleging non-payment (\$660.00) of training and transportation fees. Neither Mr. Martin nor Mr. Meier were represented by counsel. C.S.R. Christine Niccoli recorded the proceedings.

The Board of Stewards heard testimony from Mr. Meier, his wife Donna Perrone and Mr. Martin. In addition a number of documents were submitted.

The hearing was adjourned and the Board of Stewards will render their decision shortly.

12-15-11<sup>3</sup> **RULING NO. 43 – JESUS VELAZQUEZ**

Jockey **JESUS VELAZQUEZ**, who rode **SUMART TIZZY** in the fourth race at Golden Gate Fields on Sunday, December 11, 2011, is suspended five (5) racing days (December 26, 29, 30, 31, 2011 and January 1, 2012) for failure to make the proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from second to fifth; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Velazquez, accompanied by trainer A. L. Diaz, met with the Board of Stewards for a review of the fourth race on Sunday, December 11, 2011.

Mr. Velazquez' mount, SUMART TIZZY, was disqualified from first and placed fourth for interference in the stretch.

The young rider acknowledged he erred, stating he was just trying too hard to win the race.

The term of the suspension was escalated to five days as Mr. Velazquez was recently suspended (11-13-11) for three days for a similar riding infraction.

12-15-11<sup>4</sup> **RULING NO. 44 – JOHN W. LUBOW** (09GG200)

In the matter of:

Owner **JOHN W. LUBOW**

Having resolved the outstanding financial obligation to San Francisco Equine in the amount of \$1,334.38, JOHN W. LUBOW is hereby deemed eligible to be re-licensed and Pacific Racing Association ruling #99, dated June 7, 2009, suspending him for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear) is hereby set aside.

The foregoing ruling was issued upon notification by San Francisco Equine that Mr. Lubow has satisfied his debt (\$1,334.38).

12-15-11<sup>5</sup> **INQUIRY – Sixth Race – NO CHANGE**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign following the sixth race for a review of an incident near the 3/16 pole where #5 PERFECT FLIGHT (Chris Russell) fifth, took back sharply.

After talking with the riders involved, considering the patrol judge's report and reviewing the video of the race, the stewards, in a majority decision (Nevin dissenting), made no change in the original order of finish.

The video shows #5 PERFECT FLIGHT, the second horse from the rail in a four horse spread, take up and lose position.

Steward Herbuveaux opined there was interference by #6 SISTERMARYELEPHANT, however he did not believe it prevented PERFECT FLIGHT the opportunity of better placing.

Steward McHargue was of the opinion the video replays were inconclusive as to who was to blame for the interference.

Steward Nevin voted to disqualify #6 SISTERMARYELEPHANT from second to fifth, believing that horse was responsible for the interference and it did prevent #5 PERFECT FLIGHT from a better placing.

Meier the sum of Six Hundred and Sixty Dollars (\$660.00) on or before December 25, 2011 for services rendered. Failure to make the payment will result in the suspension of Mr. Perry's license privileges for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility) pending payment to Mr. Meier.

The stewards issued the foregoing ruling following the formal hearing held on December 14, 2011.

12-16-11<sup>4</sup> **FILM REVIEW – JULIEN COUTON**

Jockey **Julien Couton** met with the stewards for a review of the sixth race from December 15, 2011.

Mr. Couton's mount was involved in an inquiry and the stewards wanted to review the veteran rider's effort. (Refer 12-15-11<sup>5</sup>)

In a majority decision (Nevin dissenting) no suspension days were issued.
