Wednesday

02-01-12¹ **DUTY STEWARD**

Steward Darrel McHargue was on duty to oversee the entry process and declarations.

02-01-12² **ROY LUMM** (12GG003)

The stewards conducted a formal hearing for owner-trainer, who has been charged with violating California Horse Racing Board rules #1887 (a) (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) and #1843(a) (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances).

Mr. Lumm waived his right to counsel. CHRB Investigator Barbara Chimero presented the case for the CHRB and the proceedings were recorded by Certified Court Reporter Christine Niccoli.

The complaint alleges Mr. Lumm's filly, WINGS OF PEGASUS, who finished fourth in the seventh race at Golden Gate Fields on December 30, 2011, showed the presence of cyclobenzaprine (Flexeril), a class '4' drug substance subject to a class 'B' penalty, in post race urine sample (GG13237).

The Board of Stewards heard telephonic testimony from CHRB Equine Medical Director Rick Arthur, D.V.M., regarding the substance cyclobenzaprine. Dr. Arthur explained the substance is intended for human use and not equine, which moves the class 4 drug to a class B penalty.

Mr. Lumm testified candidly that he gave his filly the medication four days before it ran on December 30, 2011, following a morning workout. He stated he did so as the horse was in distress and there was no veterinarian available.

RULING NO. 30 – LUMM (12GG003)

Owner/Trainer **ROY G. LUMM**, who started the horse **WINGS OF PEGASUS**, fourth place finisher in the seventh race at Golden Gate Fields on December 30, 2011, is suspended thirty (30) days, February 4 through March 4, 2012 and fined the sum of one thousand dollars pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing rule #1843 (a) & (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances: Prohibited substance–cyclobenzaprine [Class 4]).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of ROY G. LUMM are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The above ruling was issued after the Board of Stewards considered the evidence and testimony presented during the formal hearing held on February 1, 2012.

HORSE GOES WRONG – Eighth Race

During the running of the eighth race #3 BRICKYARDTRADITION (Tr. W. L. McDaniel) went wrong near the 3/8 pole and was pulled up by jockey Pedro Terrero.

The track vet, Sara Sporer, D.V.M., was on the scene immediately and reported a right front distal sesamoid ligament ruptured and euthanized the five year old horse.

02-03-12³ **RULING NO. 31 – PIMENTEL**

In the Matter of:
Owner/Trainer **MARTIN RAMIREZ PIMENTEL**

An informal hearing having been held, owner/trainer MARTIN RAMIREZ PIMENTEL is hereby fined the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1489 (c) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License – misrepresentation on license application). Further, Pacific Racing Association ruling #76, dated May 26, 2011 suspending subject for violation of CHRB rule #1547 (Failure to Appear) is hereby set aside and the license privileges of Martin Ramirez Pimentel are restored to good standing.

The foregoing ruling was issued following a telephonic hearing with Mr. Pimentel.

Mr. Pimentel, who is participating at Emerald Downs racetrack in Washington, failed to list a 2001 felony conviction (cocaine) on his October 29, 2010, California owner's license application. Mr. Pimentel's three year probation was completed in 2004 and had he noted the conviction he would be eligible for a license.

Mr. Pimentel was directed to file an amended application, sign a testing agreement and pay the fine imposed.

02-03-12⁴ **OFFICIAL REPLACED**

Horse Identifier Patrick Kealy has announced his retirement and has been replaced by licensed Identifier Darrell Sparks.

Mr. Kealy is the subject of an ongoing California Horse Racing Board investigation regarding his job performance.

02-03-12⁵ **LATE DECLARATIONS – Second Race**

The Board of Stewards scratched #1 COME NEXT MONDAY (David Essman) on the recommendation of the track veterinarian, Sara Sporer, D.V.M. The three year old filly injured herself while being loaded into the starting gate.

The late declaration in the third race reduced the field to four wagering interests and in compliance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1954 (Pari-mutuel Pools) show wagering was canceled and the additional refund amounted to \$61.00.

02-05-12³ **RULING NO. 32 – KLOKSTAD**

Trainer **BUD KOKSTAD** is fined the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1870 (Conditions of Meeting Binding Upon Licensees) for failure to satisfy the workout requirements for the meeting for the horse OFFLEE WILD BOY necessitating a declaration from the third race on Sunday, February 5, 2012.

The above ruling was issued as Mr. Klokstad's horse OFFLEE WILD BOY was declared from the third race on Sunday, February 5, 2012 for insufficient works.

02-05-12⁴ **INQUIRY – Claim of Foul – DISQUALIFICATION – Fifth Race**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign following the fifth race for a review of an incident in the stretch involving #2 OH FRANKIE OH (Juan Hernandez), first, and #1 LADY'S PLAN (Leonel Camacho-Flores), third. In addition, Mr. Camacho-Flores lodged a claim of foul regarding the same incident.

After considering the patrol judges report, interviewing the riders involved and reviewing the video, the stewards decided unanimously to disqualify #2 OH FRANKIE OH from first to third for interference.

The video shows #2 OH FRANKIE OH drifts in on #1 LADY'S PLAN inside the sixteenth pole, forcing the latter to take up, lose ground and the opportunity of better placing.

Original order of finish: **(2)** – 3 – 1 – 9 – 4 – 6 – 8 – 7 – 5

Official order of finish: 3 – 1 – **(2)** – 9 – 4 – 6 – 8 – 7 – 5

02-05-12⁵ **INQUIRY – NO CHANGE – Sixth Race**

The stewards conducted an inquiry following the sixth race for a review of an incident near the sixteenth pole involving #3 FEISTY WAGER (David Lopez), fourth, and #1 CHARMING BESS (Leslie Mowing), fifth.

After interviewing the riders involved, the patrol judges and reviewing the video, the Board of Stewards decided unanimously to make no change in the original order of finish.

The video shows the minor incident in the stretch had no bearing on the outcome of the race.
