04-12-12² **MIYADI HEARING** (Case #12GG006) (Refer: 03-24-12²; 03-31-12³)

A formal hearing was convened to conclude the hearing process in a complaint alleging a high bute test result for the horse MOVE OVER MARINO, winner of the fifth race on January 8, 2012, trained by **Steve Miyadi**. The trainer had raised concerns over proper notification of the test results and alleged his due process was compromised because he was not able to obtain test results from a split sample analysis.

At a formal hearing on March 31, Miyadi was afforded the opportunity to obtain a split sample for testing in order to quell the due process concerns that had been raised. Today's hearing was held to confirm, on the record that Miyadi has since opted not to request that split sample be analyzed and will now rest his case on the test results from the Maddy Laboratory.

The record was closed. The stewards will consider the evidence and testimony collected and render a decision in the morning.

04-13-12² **RULING NO. 55 – ROBBINS**
In the Matter of:
Owner **STEVEN L. ROBBINS**
Having satisfied the outstanding financial obligation to Equine Sports Medicine, Inc., the license privileges of Steven L. Robbins are restored to good standing and Pacific Racing Association ruling #38, dated February 24, 2012 suspending Mr. Robbins for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear), is hereby set aside.

The above ruling was issued after we received written confirmation from Equine Sports Medicine that the account had been satisfied.

04-13-12³ **RULING NO. 56 – MIYADI** (Case #12GG006)
Trainer **STEVE MIYADI**, who started the horse **MOVE OVER MARINO**, winner of the fifth race at Golden Gate Fields on January 8, 2012, is fined the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843 (a) & (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances: Phenylbutazone – in excess of permitted level – 7.34 ug/ml [Class 4]).

The above ruling was published after three sessions in a formal setting. Miyadi explored various options in mounting his defense but ultimately understood, as the trainer of record, the responsibility for the high level of bute rested with him.

04-13-12⁴ **STEWARDS' INQUIRY – First Race – NO CHANGE**
The stewards posted the inquiry sign to review an incident in the stretch involving #6 FIRE IN THE WIND (3rd, Abel Cedillo) and #3 CLOSE PURSUIT (5th, Ronald Richard) inside the 1/8. After a thorough review the stewards left the original standings intact. Tapes showed minor contact between the two in mid-stretch as FIRE IN THE WIND drifted in slightly but the placings were not affected. Jockey Cedillo will review the tapes of the race with the stewards in the morning.

04-14-12²**RULING NO. 57 – FRANKO**

Trainer **DANIEL FRANKO** is fined the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration) for entering a horse whose owner was not properly licensed necessitating a late scratch for the horse DIANA'S AVENUE in the fourth race on Sunday, April 8, 2012; a violation of CHRB rule #1588 (h) (Horse Ineligible to Start in a Race).

The above ruling was issued after Franko accepted responsibility for entering a horse while the owner's license privileges were under suspension.

04-14-12³**RULING NO. 58 – WOOLSEY** (Case #12GG253) (Refer: 04-07-12³)

Owner **LYNN R. WOOLSEY**, having failed to abide by the terms of a payment agreement with trainer William Delia, is suspended pending satisfaction of the outstanding financial obligation; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of LYNN R. WOOLSEY are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The above ruling was released after we received written notice from trainer Bill Delia that Ms. Woolsey had not fulfilled her obligations pursuant to a negotiated payment agreement.

04-14-12⁴**FILM REVIEWS**

Jockey **Abel Cedillo** reviewed the tapes of yesterday's first race where his mount stepped in and made slight contact with a rival. The transgression was minor so a warning was appropriate.

Jockey **Pablo Flores** appeared and was lectured about proper whip management in the stretch.

Jockey **Irving Orozco** viewed the start of yesterday's final race where his horse broke in at the start. He was cautioned to make quicker effort to correct a horse who veers off course leaving the gate.

04-14-12⁵**STEWARDS' INQUIRY – Eighth Race – NO CHANGE**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign to review an incident inside the 1/8 involving #8 DIXICO (3rd, Kerwin John) and #2 LODI RED (5th, Abel Cedillo) when Cedillo checked his mount in mid-stretch. After a thorough review the stewards affirmed the original

order of finish. Tapes showed contact between the two horses when DIXICO bore out a bit and LODI RED stepped in. The stewards concluded both horses contributed to the incident and affirmed the original order of finish.

04-14-12⁶ **STEWARDS' INQUIRY – Ninth Race – NO CHANGE**

The stewards lit the inquiry lamp to investigate the cause of close quarters shortly after the start of the six furlong event. Tapes showed #3 MR RONALD V. CLOUD (6th, Kerwin John) drifted out after the start and impeded horses to his outside. Since MR RONALD V. CLOUD finished last no action was warranted by the stewards regarding the placings but Mr. John will explain his actions, or lack there of, to the stewards at tomorrow's film review.

04-15-12³ **STEWARDS' INQUIRY – Sixth Race – NO CHANGE**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign to review an incident at the 3/16 when #5 MR. SATISFACTION (5th, Kerwin John) clipped heels. Tapes showed that John had positioned MR. SATISFACTION behind a wall of horses for the stretch run and was probing for an opening where none existed. While waiting for a hole to materialize John had his mount in very tight quarters which resulted in MR. SATISFACTION ticking the heels of a leading competitor. Since John caused his own problem no action by the stewards was necessary.
