Wednesday04-18-12 **DUTY STEWARD**

Steward John Herbuveaux was in attendance for entries for Saturday, April 21 and declarations for tomorrow (4/19). Mr. Herbuveaux will attend to those duties for the remainder of the week.

Thursday04-19-12¹ **CAL-BRED REPORT**

Purse \$10,400. For California bred or California sired fillies and mares, four years old and upward, claiming price \$6,250 at five and one half furlongs. There were no entries for the race.

04-19-12³ **RULING NO. 59 – HENDERSON**

Trainer **FRANCES HENDERSON** is fined the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration) for failure to secure Worker's Compensation Insurance necessitating late declarations; a violation of CHRB rule #1501 (Worker's Compensation Insurance Required).

The preceding ruling was issued after Ms. Henderson met with the stewards and pled guilty with an explanation of her failing to resolve the insurance issues prior to the races.

04-19-12⁴ **OROZCO FILM REVIEW**

Apprentice jockey Irving Orozco met with the stewards and reviewed the stretch run of Sunday's fifth race. Mr. Orozco rode third place finisher #1 ANCIENT ARTIFACT

and placed himself in a dangerous location when he attempted to go through an opening along the rail where there was insufficient room. Mr. Orozco was also riding with his head down and failed to notice his mount was racing in heel clipping stages throughout the stretch.

After reviewing the recorded views and listening to his explanation he was instructed to learn from his mistakes, make better decisions when attempting to go in questionable openings and look forward instead of down to make sure he doesn't run up on another rival's heels.

04-19-12⁵ **LATE DECLARATION – REFUND – First Race**
 #3 EGYPTIAN FEMME (Tr. Ellen Jackson) injured in gate
 Track Veterinarian Sara Sporer REFUND: \$33,747.99

The declaration of #3 reduced the field to four wagering interests which resulted in the cancellation of show wagering and a refund of that pool per CHRB rule 1954 (Parimutuel Pools). The additional refund totaled \$3,204.74.

04-19-12⁶ **TOTE PROBLEMS**
 There were tote problems for the first and second races. The issues were locking the tote machines, posting numbers and making the race official. The backup manual procedures that are in place came into play and the machines were locked on time by tote personnel in addition to the posting of numbers and making the race official. Phone communication was initiated with tote prior to the starts of the second race and throughout the remainder of the day to insure the system was performing correctly. We were informed the problem was a statewide problem that was fixed at the Sacramento hub and all systems were up and running by the start of the third race. See letter of explanation.

04-21-12³ **RULING NO. 61 – DOUTRICH**

Owner **DAVID K. DOUTRICH**, having failed to respond to written notice to appear before the Board of Stewards at Golden Gate Fields on or before Friday, April 20, 2012, to answer charges alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility), is hereby suspended pending an appearance for a hearing before the Board of Stewards for violation of CHRB rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of DAVID K. DOUTRICH are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Doutrich failed to appear to address an alleged debt of \$604.50 owed to San Francisco Equine, Inc. for veterinary services.

04-21-12⁴ **TRAINER OBJECTION – Fifth Race – NO CHANGE**

Following the running of the fifth race trainer Monty Meier (4th place, #2 TAHOE BLUES) lodged a claim of foul against #1 SAMMY CHOI (1st place, jockey Julien Couton) for alleged interference at the head of the stretch.

After reviewing all the recorded views no change was made to the order of finish. The recording failed to show any interference that supported the claim of foul.
