06-07-12<sup>3</sup> **TRAINER DOWNGRADE**

Veteran trainer **Ray Thomas** met with the stewards regarding his license status. Mr. Thomas' insurance was recently cancelled (04-16-12) and thus his trainer's license was automatically suspended.

Mr. Thomas requested and was granted a downgrade to assistant trainer and will be working for his son Jamey Thomas.

06-07-12<sup>4</sup> **FILM REVIEW**

Jockey **Catalino Martinez** met with the stewards for a review of the sixth race from Saturday, June 2, 2012, where Mr. Martinez' mount, THE DOLL ROOM (Tr. Sergio Ledezma), finished in a dead heat for the win.

At issue was Mr. Martinez' excessive use of the whip during the stretch drive. Mr. Martinez was admonished for both the frequency and aggressiveness he displayed in using the whip. The experienced rider was warned that any further incidents of this nature would result in a penalty. Steward Nevin was of the opinion a penalty was warranted on this occasion.

06-07-12<sup>5</sup> **OBJECTION – No Change – Fourth Race**

The stewards posted the objection sign following the fourth race at the request of jockey Victor Carrero (#6 MR. DAY TRIPPER, 3<sup>rd</sup>) who lodged a claim of foul against #2 STORMY FRANK (Juan Sanchez), second.

After interviewing the riders, the patrol judges and reviewing the video, the stewards made no change to the original order of finish.

The video shows #6 MR. DAY TRIPPER steady slightly off the heels of #2 STORMY FRANK, however the incident did not affect the outcome.

06-08-12<sup>4</sup> **INQUIRY – NO CHANGE – Second Race**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign following the second race for a review of an incident in the stretch involving #1 SPEED ROUSER (Juan Hernandez) second and #4 CLASSICAL BARTOK (Abel Cedillo), who finished fourth.

After interviewing the riders involved, the patrol judges and reviewing the video, the stewards declared the original order of finish official.

The video shows #4 CLASSICAL BARTOK steady briefly near the 1/16 pole, however, the incident had no bearing on the outcome.

**06-09-12<sup>3</sup> RULING NO. 82 – PALDANIUS (12GG075)**

Trainer **SHELDON PALDANIUS**, who started the horse **RED DELICIOUS**, second place finisher in the fourth race at Golden Gate Fields on April 13, 2012, is fined the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843 (a) & (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances: Flunixin – in excess of permitted level – 46.08 ng/ml [Class 4] ).

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Paldanius appeared, waived his right to a hearing and accepted the penalty imposed.

**06-09-12<sup>4</sup> RULING NO. 83 – VELAZQUEZ**

Jockey **JESUS VELAZQUEZ**, who rode **LITTLEMISSGOGO** in the eighth race at Golden Gate Fields on Friday, June 8, 2012, is suspended three (3) racing days (June 16, 17 and 21, 2012) for failure to make the proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The terms of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

The Board of Stewards issued the above ruling following a film review with jockey Jesus Velazquez. Mr. Velazquez acknowledged he drifted off course and vowed to be more attentive in the future.

The Board of Stewards met with the riders in the Jockeys' Room to remind, and warn, against excessive use of the whip. The riders were advised that penalties will be imposed in accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (Use of Whips).

06-10-12<sup>4</sup> **HORSE GOES WRONG – Second Race – Main Track**

#5 KING'S RED JOURNEY (Tr. Mike Chambers), who finished third in the second race, was pulled up past the wire by jockey Frank Alvarado.

Track veterinarian Sara Sporer, D.V.M., reported the three year old gelding bowed a tendon in the left foreleg and was given a ride home in the horse ambulance.

06-10-12<sup>5</sup> **HORSE GOES WRONG – Fourth Race – TURF COURSE**

#8 CHEERS TO BOOGIE (Tr. Patrick Gallagher), who finished third in the fourth race, was vanned off after pulling up following the race.

Track veterinarian Sara Sporer, D.V.M., reported the five year old gelding was later euthanized (left front fetlock).

06-10-12<sup>6</sup> **LATE DECLARATION – Ninth Race**

The stewards were forced to scratch #6 TOWN BELLE (Tr. Neil Drysdale) from the ninth race as a suitable rider could not be found to replace Aaron Gryder, who was excused after complaining about an injured wrist.
