11-16-12<sup>3</sup> **ANTHONY AYALA** (12GG163) (Refer 10-28-12<sup>4</sup>)

A formal hearing was held this morning for jockey **Anthony Ayala**, who has been charged with alleged violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1874 (Disorderly Conduct) and #1890 (a) (Possession of Contraband).

This hearing was originally scheduled for October 28, 2012; however Mr. Ayala requested a postponement so he could consult with counsel and review the governing procedures for hearing before the Board of Stewards.

Present for today's hearing were Mr. Ayala, Supervising Investigator Dan Dailey, Senior Investigator Gabe Palomar, Nora Lee (Winners Foundation) and C.S.R. Janine Gamble who transcribed the proceedings.

Mr. Ayala appeared without counsel and indicated he was prepared to go forward without counsel.

Supervising Investigator Dailey presented the case involving Mr. Ayala who, according to the charges, had in his possession on October 7, 2012, in his mobile home in the stable area inclosure of the Fresno County Fair, over one pound of marijuana and two syringes with six monoject needles. Mr. Ayala subsequently submitted to urine testing on October 10, 2012 that was positive for cocaine and marijuana. Mr. Ayala submitted another urine sample on October 11, 2012 that was also positive for cocaine and marijuana.

Mr. Dailey explained the search conducted on October 7, 2012 was a joint effort between the CHRB and the Fresno Police Department and that there are criminal charges pending against Mr. Ayala for the possession of marijuana.

Decision forthcoming.

11-17-12<sup>3</sup>**RULING NO. 17 – BARAJAS**

Pony Person **JOSE P. BARAJAS**, having failed to respond to written notice to appear before the Board of Stewards at Golden Gate Fields on or before Friday, November 16, 2012, to answer charges alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rules (#1890 (c) (Possession of Contraband), is hereby suspended pending an appearance for a hearing before the Board of Stewards for violation of CHRB rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of JOSE P. BARAJAS are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The above ruling was issued as Mr. Barajas failed to appear for a scheduled hearing. Mr. Barajas has been charged with an alleged violation of CHRB rule #1890 (c) (Possession of Contraband).

During a barn area inspection in accordance with CHRB rule #1929 (Examination of Personal Affects) CHRB investigators and Fresno (CA) police officers discovered a "Power Mite Shocker" electronic shocking device inside Mr. Barajas' tack room.

Jockey **Kerwin John** met with the stewards for a review of two races from November 16, 2012.

Neither incident warranted a penalty but Mr. John was advised to have better control of his mounts leaving the starting gate (third race) and in the stretch (sixth race).

11-18-12<sup>3</sup> **INQUIRY/OBJECTION – NO CHANGE – Seventh Race**

The stewards posted the objection sign following the seventh race at the request of jockey Anisete Leon, who finished third on #2 TORNADO RED. Jockey Leon lodged a claim of foul against #3 PICK SIX JOE (Kyle Frey), the winner.

After a thorough review of all video angles, interviewing the riders involved and taking into consideration the patrol judge's report, the Board of Stewards decided unanimously to disallow the objection and declared the original order of finish official.

The video shows #2 TORNADO RED steady briefly in the first turn of this one mile event. The Board of Stewards determined that both horses contributed to this minor incident and it had no bearing on the outcome of the race.
