3-13-13¹ **ENTRIES AND DECLARATIONS**

3-15-13³**3rd Race – JOCKEY OBJECTION**

Following the running of the 3rd race jockey Christian Santiago Reyes, rider of #3 HANDSOME HARVEY JR (4th place), lodged a claim of foul against #4 HUDSON LANDING (3rd place – jockey Frank Alvarado) for alleged interference through the stretch. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the recorded views the order of finish, as posted, was made official. The decision was unanimous.

The recordings failed to show any interference that would rise to the level of costing a horse a placing as the two rivals raced head and head with light contact between them.

3-17-13³**8th RACE – INQUIRY/OBJECTION**

The inquiry sign was lit following the running of the 8th race for a review of the start involving #5 TRIBAL CUSTOM (4th place – jockey Christian Santiago Reyes) and #3 TEXT (5th place – jockey William Antongeorgi III). Jockey Antongeorgi also lodged a claim of foul against #5 for interference at the start. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the recorded views of the incident, the posted order of finish was made official.

The recordings show that #3 TEXT bobbles, after breaking slow, as the #5 TRIBAL CUSTOM crosses over into its path. No change was made to the order of finish as the Stewards were of the unanimous opinion placings were not affected.
