**RULING #41 – JEFFREY P. CHAPMAN (07BM143)**

Having satisfied the outstanding financial obligation to San Francisco Equine, Inc. the license privileges of Jeffrey P. Chapman are restored to good standing and subject is deemed eligible to apply for a license. Further, Pacific Racing Association ruling #8, dated November 18, 2007, suspending Mr. Chapman for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear) is hereby set aside.

The above ruling was issued after San Francisco Equine Inc. notified the Stewards that Mr. Chapman has satisfied his debt (\$118.00).

**FILM REVIEW**

Jockey Christian Santiago Reyes met with the Stewards for a review of the eighth race from Sunday, March 17, 2013. Mr. Reyes' mount TRIBAL CUSTOM, was the subject of an inquiry for ducking in at the start of that six furlong event. Mr. Reyes was not penalized as he made a good effort to correct his mount.

3-21-13<sup>4</sup> **OBJECTION – NO CHANGE – 3<sup>rd</sup> RACE**

The Stewards conducted an inquiry following the running of the third race at the request of trainer Steve Miyadi, who lodged a claim of foul against the winner #6 TRIBAL BET (jockey – Dennis Carr). Mr. Miyadi alleged the winner interfered with his horse #3 SKY FOX (jockey – Russell Baze) who finished second.

After considering the patrol judges report, interviewing the riders involved and reviewing the video, the stewards decided unanimously to make the original order of finish official.

The video shows the two horses brush slightly down the stretch; however the minor contact had no bearing on the outcome.

The Stewards conducted a formal hearing to address a complaint and counter complaint regarding financial issues.

Mr. Mathis filed a financial complaint alleging Mr. Scott owes an overdue training bill totaling \$488.00.

Mr. Scott filed a counter complaint alleging he paid \$2371.00 in training and shipping fees he desires to recoup.

Mr. Mathis, Mr. Scott and veterinarian William Grantham, DVM testified. CSR Christine Niccoli recorded the proceedings.

3-23-13<sup>4</sup> **INQUIRY – NO CHANGE – 5<sup>th</sup> RACE**

The Stewards posted the inquiry sign following the fifth race for a review of an incident in the stretch involving #3 UNMATCHED FORCE (jockey – Alejandro Gomez) third and #4 AIMING FLUID (jockey – Dennis Carr) the winner.

After a thorough review of the video, the stewards decided, unanimously, to make no change to the original order of finish.

The video shows #3 UNMATCHED FORCE attempting to drive through a tight hole along the rail inside #4 AIMING FLUID. The lack of racing room forced jockey Gomez to take up and lose ground. #4 AIMING FLUID was not responsible for the incident.

The Stewards conducted an inquiry following the fourth race at the request of jockey Christian Santiago Reyes, who finished third on #2 ASSURE. Mr. Reyes lodged a claim of foul against #5 RUBY PUMPS (jockey – Frank Alvarado), who finished second. Mr. Reyes alleged interference near the 5/16 pole.

After considering the patrol judges report, interviewing the riders involved and reviewing the video, the Stewards decided, unanimously, to make the original order of finish official. The video failed to substantiate the claim of foul.
